CLEANING OPENERS (as submitted by Ed Kaye)

Each opener (if not mint) I get from whatever source, is first wire brushed, then dipped in Naval Jelly, then rinsed in cold water, transferred to extremely hot water, hand dried, and finally buffed. From this I then grade them as to condition:

M = Mint, E = Excellent - no rust, VG = Very good - Minimum rust, G = Good - average use with rust spots. This extra effort on my part determines my final price for evaluation of the collection - usually 25 cents over what I paid for the item.






