In addition, please answer the questions on the back of the form. Please return this form as soon as possible. Do it NOW!

CLEANING OPENERS (as submitted by Ed Kaye)

Each opener (if not mint) I get from whatever source, is first wire brushed, then dipped in Naval Jelly, then rinsed in cold water, transferred to extremely hot water, hand dried, and finally buffed. From this I then grade them as to condition: M = Mint, E = Excellent - no rust, VG = Very good - Minimum rust, G = Good - average use with rust spots. This extra effort on my part determines my final price for evaluation of the collection - usually 25 cents over what I paid for the item.
