This issue of Opener Trivia features the varieties of the Type A-21 hand spinner. Upon surveying the examples I have in my collection I came up with five (5) easily recognizable varieties based upon the wording or lack of wording that appears on the index finger, and the absence of or positioning of a hole to place

the opener on a key chain or ring. The varieties are:

- A-21a YOU PAY on index finger/without a hole
- A-21b YOU PAY on index finger/hole in center of opener
- A-21c YOU PAY on index finger/hole at bottom of opener
- A-21d no wording on index finger/hole at bottom of opener
- A-21e SPIN-IT on index finger/hole in center of opener

I believe varieties a thru d were made by Brown & Bigelow (B & B) of St. Paul, Minnesota. They all are of similar design and in some cases are marked with a manufacturer's mark. On varieties A-21a & A-21d the manufacturer's mark B & B ST. PAUL, MINN. U.S.A. sometimes appears on the obverse side beneath the advertisement. On varieties A-21a & A-21b I have also seen the manufacturer's mark B.&B. MADE IN U.S.A. on the reverse side beneath the words SPIN TO SEE WHO PAYS.

Variety A-21e appears to be of a slightly different shape and not as finely struck. I suspect that it was made by a different manufacturer.

The varieties are illustrated below. If you have any additions please let me know and I will include them in a future issue.

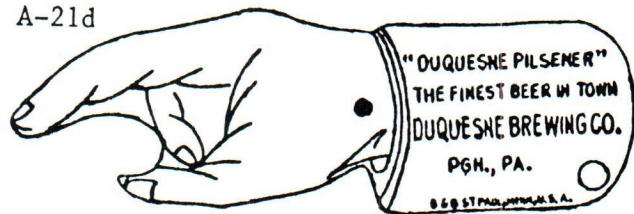

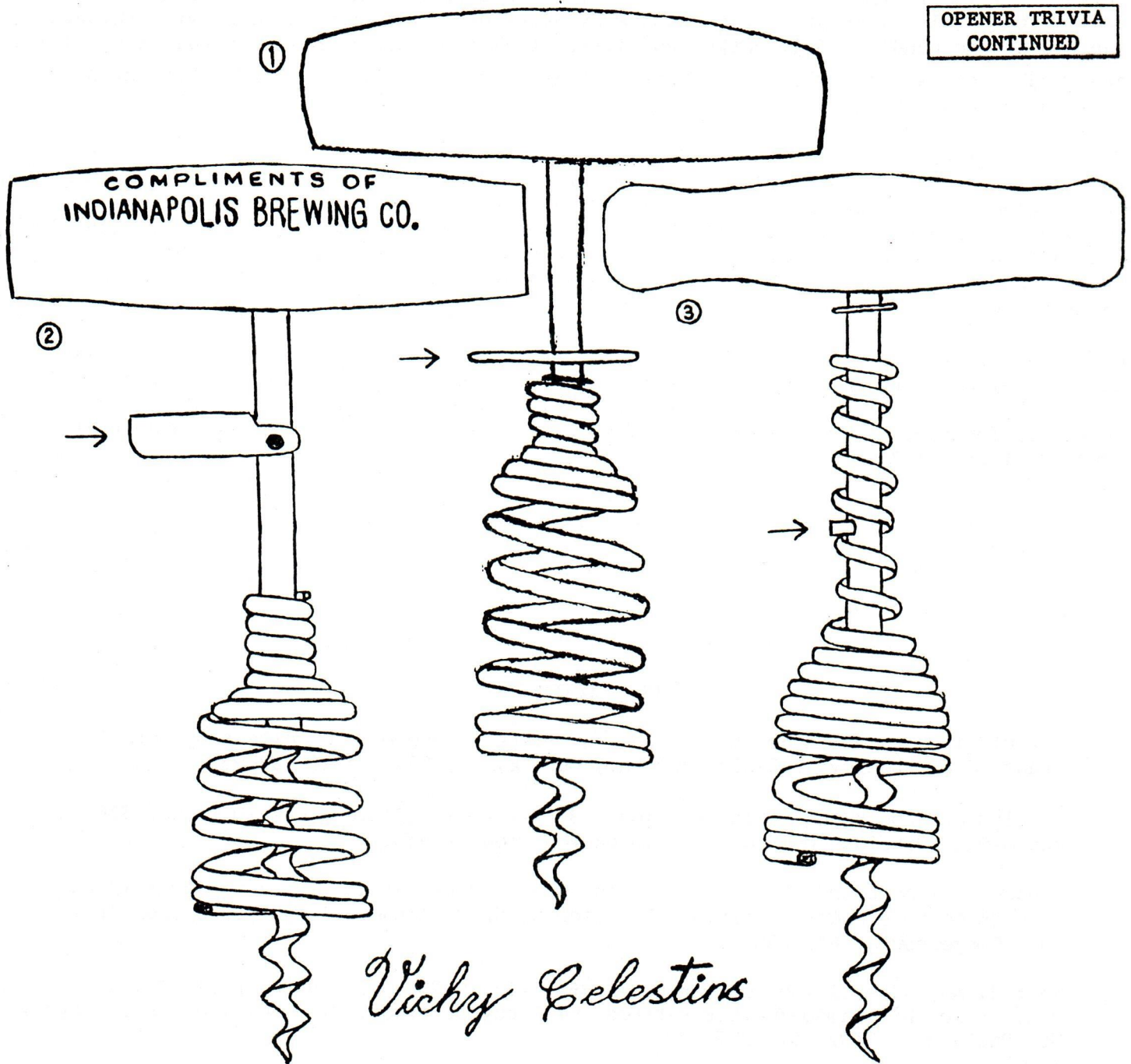


A-21-5 is the only opener I have seen of this variety. No wording on reverse.

A-21e



This is the hardest of all the A-21 varieties to find with beer advertising. No wording on reverse.



It is not very easy to find corkscrews that employ the use of a spring in the place of a metal bell or flange. Pictured above are examples of three such corkscrews, each in some way different from the others.

Corkscrew ① is marked "VICHY CELESTINS" on the top of the handle. I am not certain what kind of product it advertises, but I suspect it was either a wine or mineral water from France. Its mahogany colored handle does not appear to be made of wood, but some other material - possibly a type of bone. The handle is secured to the shank of the corkscrew by means of a nail driven lengthwise through the end of the handle. This corkscrew is different from the others in that it has a pin (see arrow) which goes through the shank and keeps the spring from moving upward.

Corkscrew ② is one of the hardest types of beer advertising corkscrews to find. As of this date only four (4) listings appear. This particular one is P-52-1, and is unusual because it has an error in the wording. The reverse side reads: DUESSELDORFER BEER GRAND PRICE-CROSS OF HONOR GOLD MEDALE. The word "PRICE" should be (con't. on pg. 4)

(OPENER TRIVIA from pg. 3) "PRIZE" (refer to P-52-2 also from the Indianapolis Brewing Co.). The handle is secured to the shank by means of a nail driven lengthwise through the end of the handle. This corkscrew differs from the others in that it has a specially designed piece (see arrow) which rotates outward from the shank and keeps the spring from moving upward.

Corkscrew ③ appears to be more modern than the others, but it is the most interesting. The handle is secured to the shank by a small nail driven widthwise through the middle of the handle. Embedded in the shank is a tiny pin (see arrow) which allows the shank to move up and down through the middle of the spring as the handle is rotated. The pin can move upward freely between the coils of the spring to the point where the spring narrows at the top, and can move downward until the spring contacts the handle - a very interesting concept.

Can anyone give us any more information on these corkscrews? I suspect Corkscrew ① has a foreign patent, but I'm certain the other two were made in the United States. The shanks of Corkscrews ② & ③ seem to be identical, and the gauge of metal used in the spring appears to be the same. I wonder if they couldn't have been made by the same manufacturer(?)

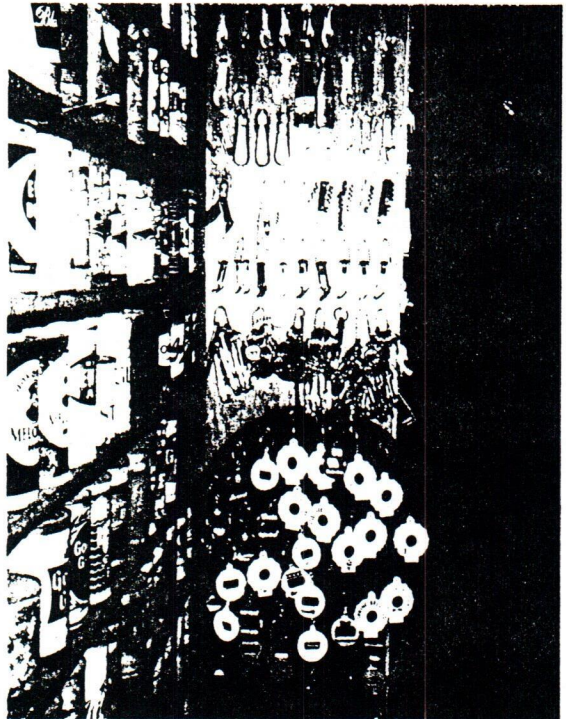
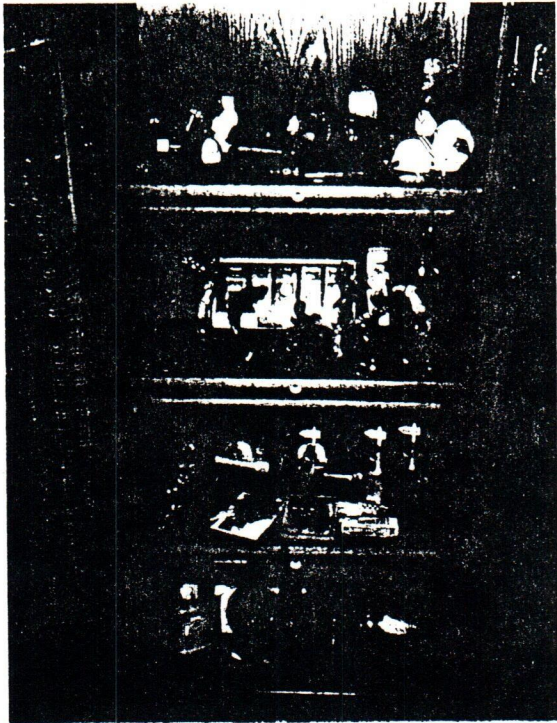
### OPENER COLLECTOR OF THE MONTH

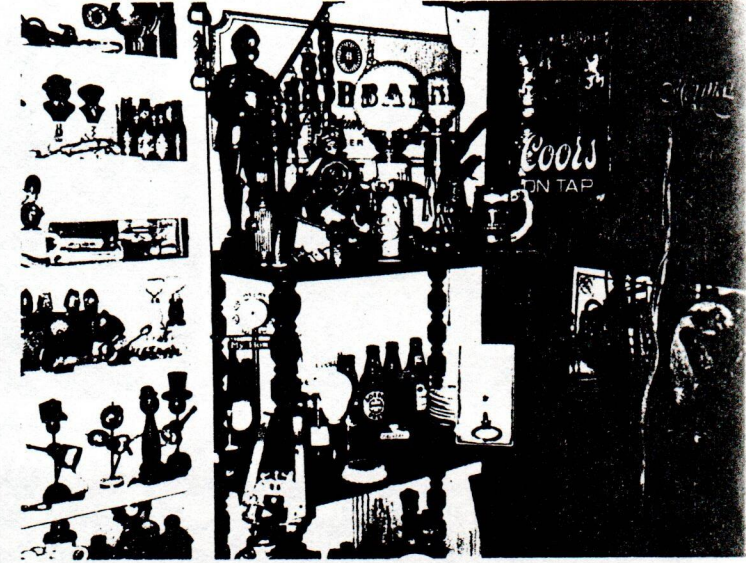
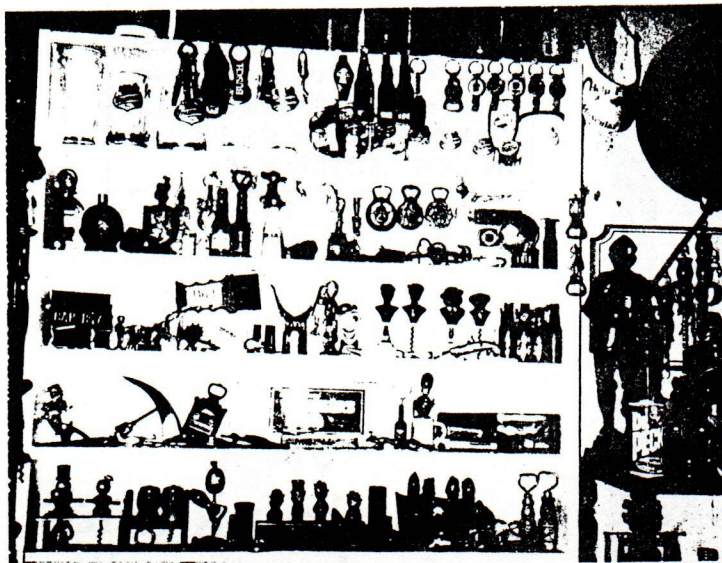
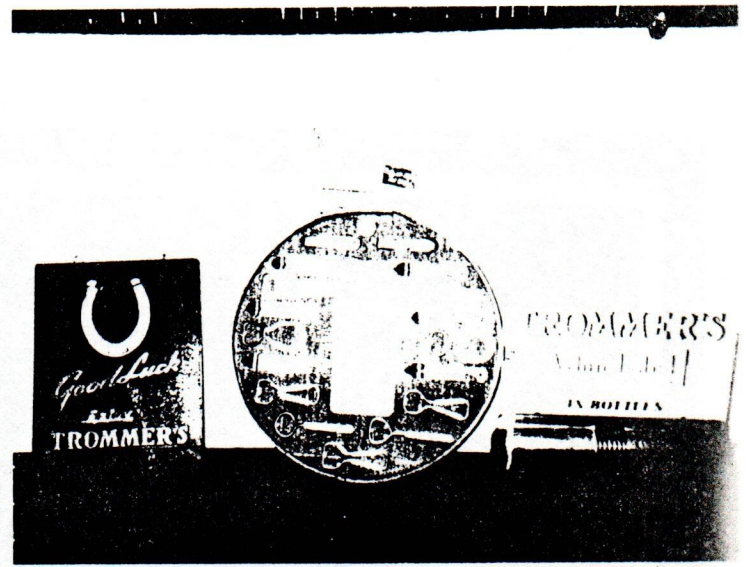
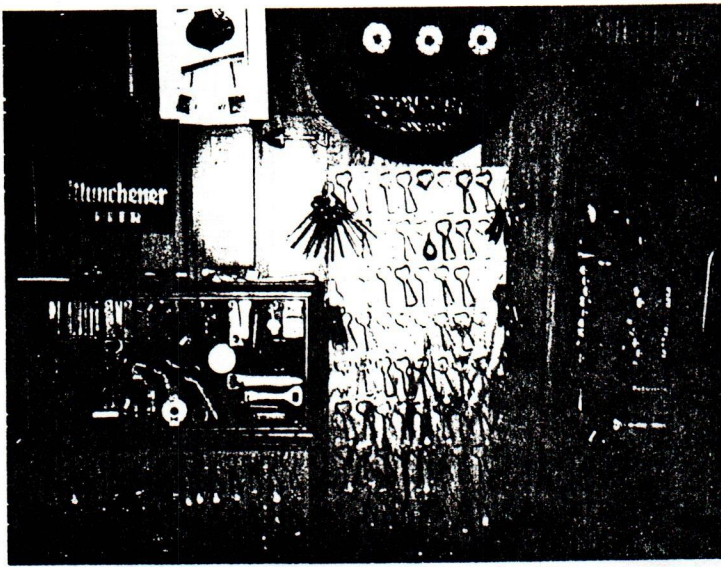

They are truly JFO members who look forward to future conventions and the friends they have met through the years. They feel like it is somewhat of a family reunion. Everyone knows each other, or soon does.





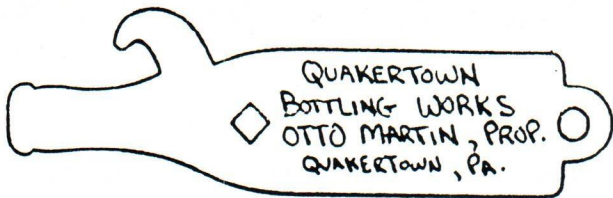

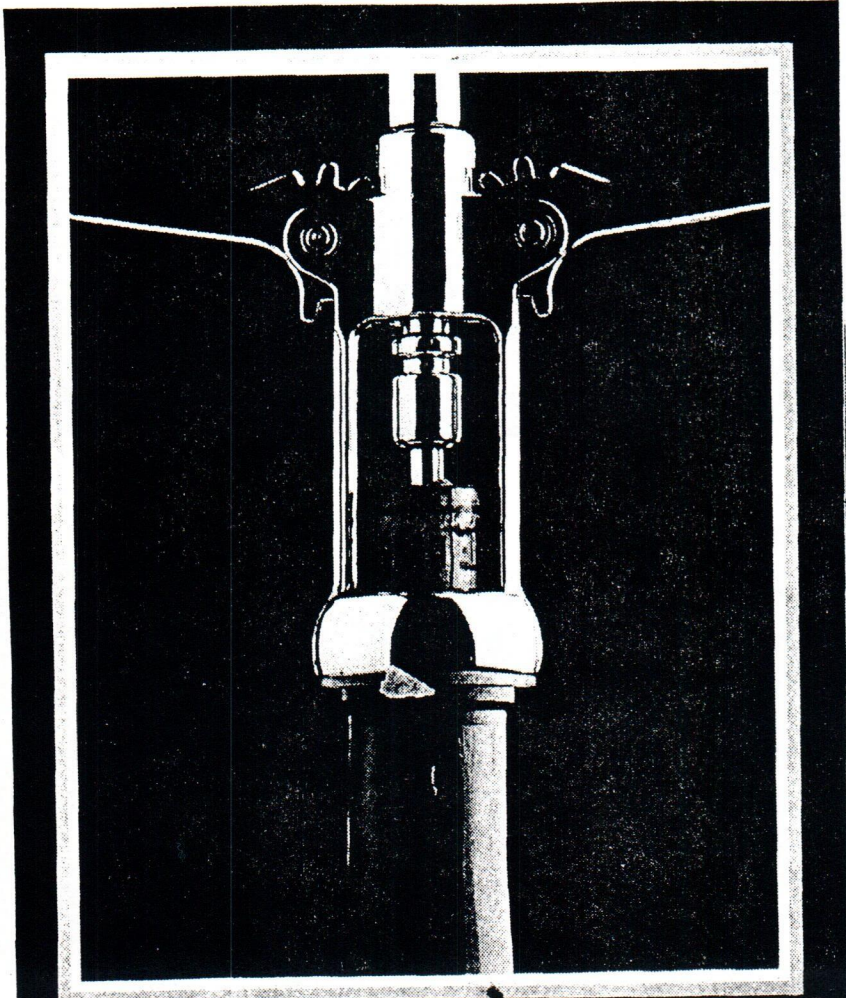
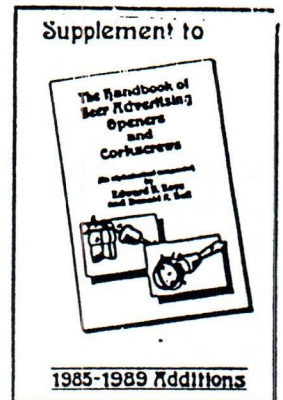
