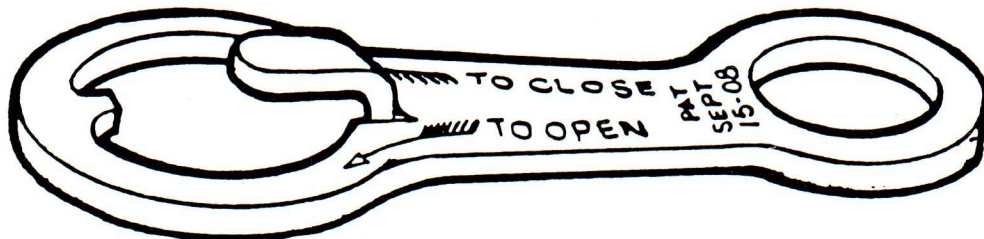

THE STEEL STOCK IS QUITE HEFTY WHICH TO ME INDICATES THE OPENING OF A PRESSURE VALVE SUCH AS A CO-2 TANK ETC. BUT I STILL DON'T KNOW ANYMORE THAN JOE DOES. DICK BRITTON

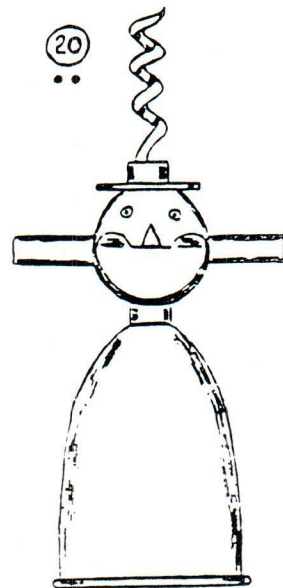
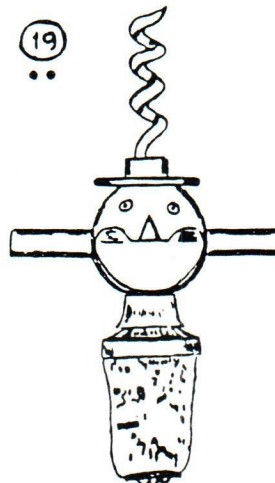
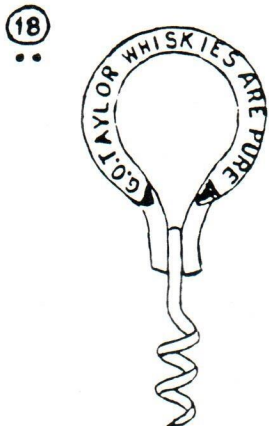
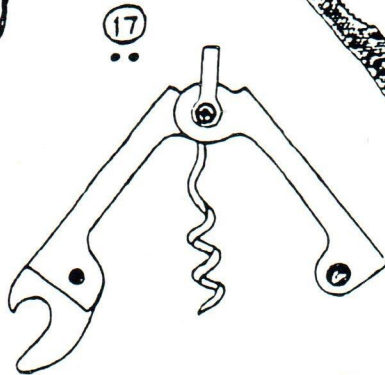
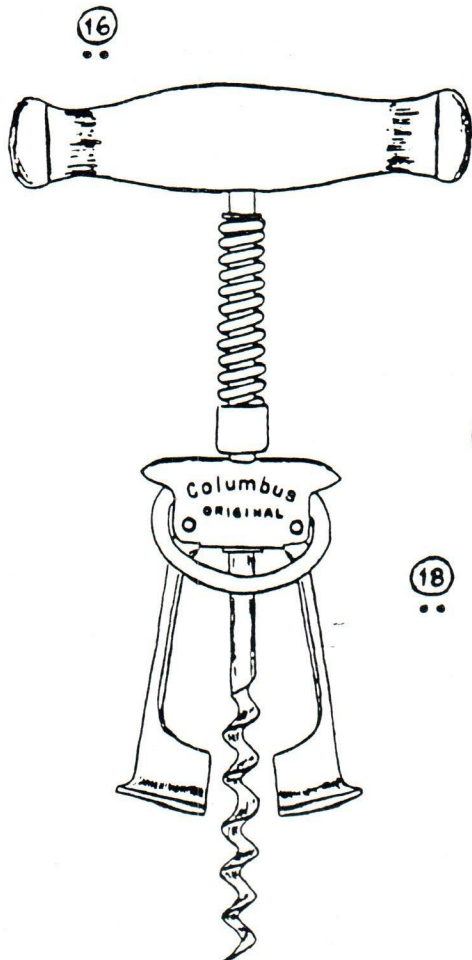
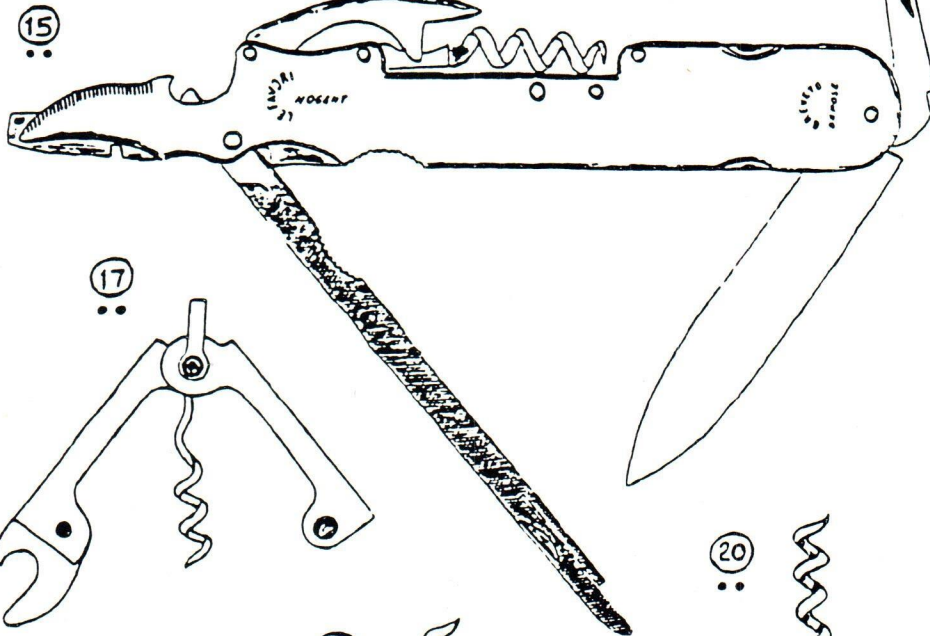
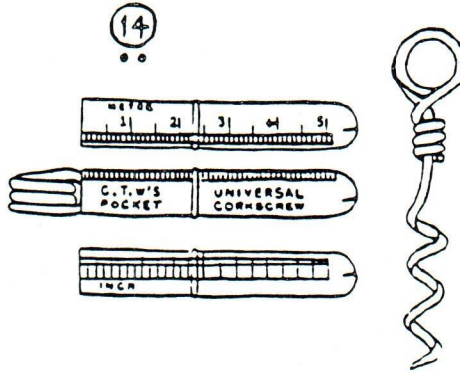
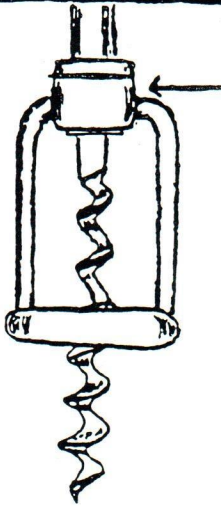
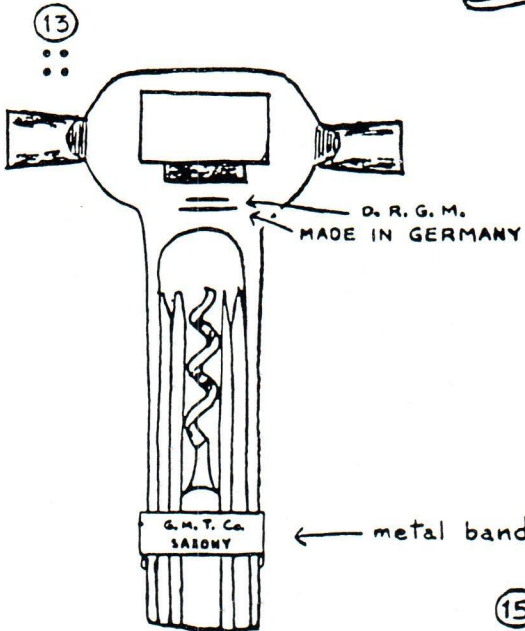
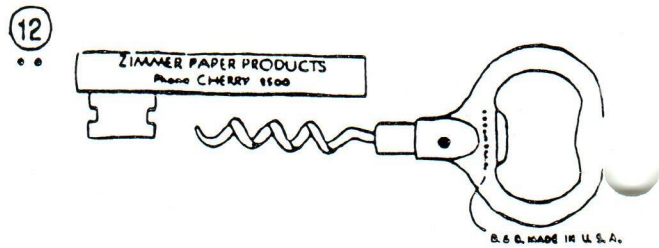
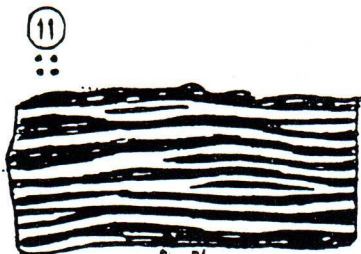
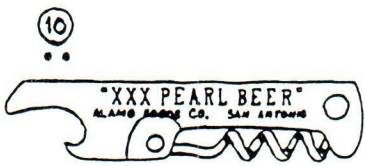
The drawings in this issue were made over a period of years. Although I never have been an avid collector of corkscrews I've always picked up those that seemed interesting or unusual. Most of them I either traded or sold, but before I let them go I usually made a drawing to remember what they looked like. Some of my early drawings were not very accurate. I usually quickly traced around the corkscrew and then drew in any wording that appeared on it without regard to the exact spacing or shape of the letters. For this reason I cannot guarantee the accuracy of these drawings and have coded them with four dots :: under the number of the corkscrew. A full explanation of my coding system appears at the end of this issue.

Where I could I have touched up some of my older drawings adding details to them that I knew I had omitted. I have tried to put in a good variety of specimens so that it will be of interest to everyone. Note that all of the drawings have been reduced so that I could include more of them on each page. Actual measurements are noted in my comments. I in no way pretend to be an expert on corkscrews and I welcome any additional comments and/or corrections regarding any of them. I will include them in the next issue.

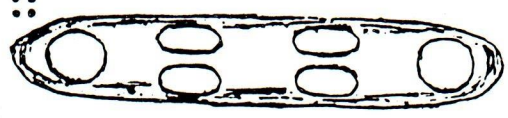
ABOUT THE OPENERS

- ① A pewter wine tasting spoon marked Joseph Copeland 1675 (?). Reverse is marked "STIEFF - PEWTER". Actual length = 7 13/16"
- ② An unlisted P-26 type knife from the Neef Bros. Brewing Co., Denver, Col. (1896 - 1915). Steel sides with engraved lettering. Actual length = 3 5/16"
- ③ A high quality brass deer's head corkscrew with black accents. Length (base to tip of corkscrew) = 3 1/4"
- ④ A humongous novelty corkscrew measuring 10 5/16" from the tip of the hat to the tip of the corkscrew. The word "Hici!" appears on the reverse side of the head. Made in Italy.
- ⑤ Olive green handle. Side of bell is marked "GERMANY". Have seen others of this type only without a spring. Actual length = 4 1/16"
- ⑥ Corkscrew made by the Haff Manufacturing Co. of New York, circa 1885. Metal band around handle is marked "PATENT APPLIED FOR". Actual length = 5 1/8"
- ⑦ Unusual corkscrew made of steel wire (Henry Bodnar collection). Actual length = 4 1/16"
- ⑧ B-13 type opener-corkscrew. No advertising on reverse. Actual length = 2 7/8"
- ⑨ An interesting little corkscrew. Actual length = 3"
- ⑩ B-13-35 Actual length = 2 7/8"
- ⑪ A very high quality corkscrew with a stag horn handle. Unusual because it has a ball bearing mechanism in the part where the shaft and frame join (see arrow). Plated. No markings. Actual length = 5 5/16"
- ⑫ A neat key type opener-corkscrew made by Brown & Bigelow, St. Paul, Minnesota. I have only seen one other of these which was marked "Your Key to Saint Paul 1933". Actual length (with corkscrew in sleeve) = 3 3/16"
- ⑬ A very nice nickel plated combination tool consisting of a cap lifter, 2 hammers, and 5 fold out tools (2 chisels, punch, screwdriver, and a corkscrew). Metal band (see arrow) slides upward to release tools. Actual length = 4 1/2"





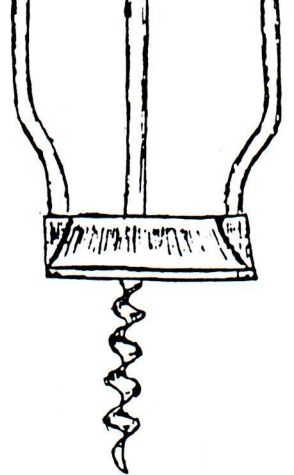

ABOUT THE OPENERS

- ⑭ Pocket corkscrew in metal sleeve. Shown are three views of the sleeve. C.T.W'S probably stands for C. T. Williamson of Newark, N.J. Actual length (with corkscrew in sleeve) = 2 13/16"
- ⑮ This is "The mother of all bartender's tools". It was designed by Saddam Hussein for his troops during the War in the Gulf. It has a 3 1/2" knife blade for hand to hand combat and a corkscrew to open the bottles during the post war celebration over the "capitalist scum". Illustrated here is the Junior Model for soldiers 18 years of age and under. Nine uses. Actual length = 7"
- ⑯ Early 20th century German patent by Becker. Split cage design with ring. Spring over shank. Black wooden handle. Actual length = 7 1/8"
- ⑰ A folding corkscrew with an A type bottle opener on one end of the handle. Profile of an Indian in full head dress with word "CHIEF" appears on reverse side. Marked "MADE IN USA". Actual length (not counting ring on top) = 2 7/8"
- ⑱ A small folding corkscrew. Reverse reads "DRINK HUB PUNCH". Actual length = 3 1/4"
- ⑲ A novelty bottle stopper with a bottle opener and corkscrew. Bottle opener is mouth. Black metal sleeve fits over corkscrew. Actual length = 3 15/16"
- ⑳ Companion piece to corkscrew ⑲. Bottom part is a cup for measuring liquor. Actual length = 4 11/16"
- ㉑ An unusual corkscrew whose handles remind me of some of the parts I have seen on old time stoves. Could it have been made by a stove company? No markings. Actual length (top of the handle to the tip of the corkscrew) = 6 3/16"
- ㉒ A wire formed corkscrew probably made by the same company that made beer advertising type F-16. This piece is from Colorado and it is the only one I have ever seen. Actual length = 5 5/8"
- ㉓ A nice old French corkscrew marked "LB PARIS DEPOSE". Actual length = 5 11/16"
- ㉔ A beautiful little corkscrew made in GERMANY. Fancy work appears on both sides of the handle. Shown are top view, side view, and bottom view with corkscrew folded inside handle. Actual length (tip of corkscrew to top of handle) = 2 3/4"
- ㉕ Early 20th Century French Mechanical corkscrew marked "JHP" (J. H. Perille). Actual length = 7"
- ㉖ P-90-UL A.Hupfel's Son's BREWERY NEW YORK U.S.A. / "OLD SETTER BRAND" Actual length = 4 1/2"
- ㉗ Type P-7 opener-corkscrew. Patented in 1901. Don't see many openers or corkscrews with saloon advertising. Actual length = 5 15/16"
- ㉘ One continuous piece of wire has been twisted around a second piece of wire which forms the handle. Definitely a manufactured piece. Wonder if it was ever patented (?). Actual length (top of handle to tip of corkscrew) = 3 7/8"
- ㉙ P-2-2 Minneapolis Brewing Co. Patented by D.W.Davis on July 14, 1891. Actual length = 4 1/8"
- ㉚ P-2-6 Minneapolis Brewing Co. Compare the corkscrew on this example with the corkscrew on P-2-2.
- ㉛ A monstrous corkscrew with an interesting circular handle. No markings. Actual length = 8 7/16"
- ㉜ An early American corkscrew patented by W.W.Tucker Hartford, Connecticut on Sept. 3, 1878. Actual length = 6 1/4"
- ㉝ A late 19th Century piece. Reverse is marked "PRISBELÄNT PHILADELPHIA 1876". Actual length = 4 11/16"
- ㉞ An unusual corkscrew with an interlocking mechanism at the top. No markings. Actual length (tip of corkscrew to top, not counting ring) = 6 1/2"
- ㉟ Haven't seen another wooden handled corkscrew constructed in quite this manner. A piece of steel wire runs through two holes in the handle to form the loop on the top of the corkscrew. This same piece of wire was then twisted around a second piece of wire to form the corkscrew. Actual length = 4 15/16"
