C-13-UL Sportmen's Beer Galeton, PA.

As mentioned in the October issue Norm Jay turned up the C-13-UL "Sportmen's Beer" shown here. The Galeton Brewing Company was one of those small local breweries that has few pieces of breweriana known. C-12s and C-13s pictured with bottles are usually in higher demand than those not showing bottles, even if the opener is in mint condition.

Another JFO member John Hall has taken a special interest in any openers and breweriana from Schwarzenbach Brewing Company or Galeton Brewing Company of Galeton, PA. He sent me the following short history about the brewing industry in Galeton, PA.

In 1858, Joseph Schwarzenbach, a German immigrant from Bavaria, Germany, opened a brewery in Germania, PA. The brewery operated there until 1901. In 1902 it reopened in Galeton, PA to make better use of the railroad facilities.

A firemen's convention was held July 26th and 27th, 1907 in Galeton and was called the Mardi-Gras of the North. The Schwarzenbach Brewing Co. held open house showing parties of sight-seers through the plant and even putting out a special brew for the event called "Firemen's Brew" (bottled with the appropriate label). The affair was to be talked about all over Northern Pennsylvania and was considered one of the finest and most enjoyable events to ever take place in Galeton.

Prohibition (in 1920) forced the Schwarzenbach Brewing Co. to close for a short time. The brewery reopened in 1921 to manufacture soda-pop in the bottling plant and ice cream and ice in the main plant. This was a cover, though, as the brewery was still manufacturing beer (like many other plants all over the country) and shipping it out twice each week in boxcars identified as containing potatoes. Railroad crews were paid off ahead of time to move the barrels of beer out in the dark of night.

After being sold to a Mr. Richman in 1927, the brewery was raided a year later by Federal agents who proceeded to siphon the beer into Pine Creek through long hoses. While at the end of those hoses about half the population of Galeton had gathered with tubs, barrels, pots and bottles or anything that would hold beer. It was an infamous day.

The brewery was sold to a Mr. Savage upon the Repeal of Prohibition in 1933. The doors were finally closed in 1937 forced under by larger breweries who had a corner on the market. The opener shown is from the 1933-1937 period. Many thanks to Norm Jay and John Hall.



"OPENER/CORKSCREW ACQUISITIONS"

Your editor's biggest Antique Show of the year is at Hillsville, VA. on Labor Day weekend. Over the years I have turned up some pretty good openers and corkscrews at this show. Since getting Roger Jarrell interested in openers, he has accompanied me to this show. We usually leave Durham at 6AM and it takes about two and a half hours to get to Hillsville. This trip was somewhat anxious as Roger's wife Janice was expecting the first (and last) Jarrell baby. He carried a mobile phone in case we had to return to Durham in a hurry.

Another JFO member Lou Sutton (and his wife Rita) sets up at Hillsville as a dealer. Over the years Lou has had some real nice openers and corkscrews for sale, but this year I didn't see anything I really wanted (Lou had been looking hard for good openers, but hadn't found much the last few months). My best purchase of the day was made close to Lou's tent. A dealer had a B-18-500 Bluefield Brewing Co (WV) in good condition, but I had to pay \$25.00 for it. Roger already had one in his West Virginia collection so this one went into my collection. We spent close to six hours covering the show with at least half the dealers set up in very hilly terrain (hence the name of the town Hillsville). I bought a few miscellaneous openers, nothing too good, but I did get a P-103 corkscrew with whiskey advertisement for \$5.00.

We never did get a call from Janice and at 4:30 headed home. It was probably the least amount of openers I had ever bought at this show, but then again there is always next year. Roger didn't find a single opener for his collection and we both chalked it up pretty much as a dry run.

At the end of September a small Antique show was held in Liberty, NC. This town is 25 miles west of Chapel Hill and the show runs Friday and Saturday. I usually try to go on Friday but this year I went on Saturday. I arrived by myself at about 11AM and after a run of "dry" antique shows, the rain was starting to come down. About 200 dealers set up here, so I hurriedly went around checking them out.

I almost walked by one tent where an older and a younger man were sitting. At first glance they didn't seem to have much out but a few openers laying on a table caught my eye. I started looking through them and realized that beside them was a large hat box full of openers and corkscrews. This got the blood going pretty good and I asked the younger man how much the openers were. The older man said \$5 apiece. I realized that he probably didn't know much about them since he had a flat across the board price. The main problem was the openers were sitting halfway under the tent and there was no room to stand under the tent. The rain was coming down hard and I was getting soaked, but for the love of opener collecting I didn't mind.

Out of 100 openers, about 50 were pretty junky (non-beer and no-name). Out of the other 50 I first picked out 12. I asked him what his best price was for the 12. He said \$25. I paid him the \$25 and thought I better go through the pile again. I went through the pile again and came up with 18 more. He priced them \$35 and I paid him. My "soaked" brain then figured out he was selling them for \$2 apiece in quantity. Out of the 30 some were not so good. In the 30 was a keychain with 8 "B"s and I threw one away it was so rusty. Several of the openers were local, including an A-23 from China Grove, NC, an A-30 from Greensboro, NC, a B-19 from my hometown of Winston-Salem and a B-7 from Spencer, NC. These went into my NC collection.

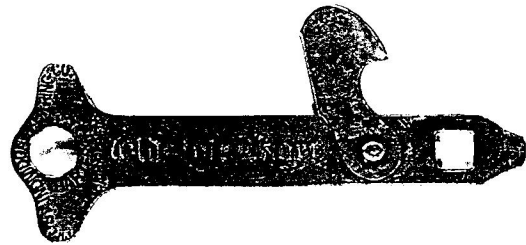
The best beer ones were a B-13-4 Finks, an E-8-83 Gipps, and an E-6-185 Fuhrmann & Schmidt. The most unusual was a Victor Can Punch "I-Type" similar to an I-25 from the "Animal Trap Co., Lititz, PA.". This was one of my best hauls ever at a small antique show. Certainly nothing outstanding, but considering the price and quantity, I was very happy. If you look hard enough something will turn up, even if there is a rusty one in the pile that you end up throwing away.

My last big show for this issue is the Semi-Annual Charlotte Antique Extravaganza held in April and November of each year. With 2000 dealers you would think some good openers and corkscrews would turn up. In short I spent four hours looking and turned up two "B" non-beer openers and just one good opener. The good one was an "F-13" (spatula is larger) Type Coca-Cola, "Gardner Bros. Ice Cream - Coca Cola" in VG condition. I had been looking for 15 years to find a Beer or Soda Kitchen Utensil Opener and I finally found one. The price was \$17.50 but the couple running the booth knocked off \$2. They didn't know how good it was but the lady said "Oh he found something he likes", and then started reading what was on the opener. She reads the inscription and her eyes lit up a little when she read "Coca Cola", but just handed back to me with my change.

As you can see not much has turned up in the South as far as Beer openers are concerned, but other folks have been doing pretty good. Ben Hoffman at a beer show in November, bought from one dealer, a Near Mint M-3 Ruppert Slide, a B-14-UL Freeland Brewing Co Freeland, PA and a H-1-UL Bob's Beer from Jenner Springs Brewing Co Boswell, PA. Harold Queen bought the R-6-2 Sprenger and R-8-1 Kaier's Wall Mounts along with a Mint A-18-3 Star Beer Lancaster, PA fish opener in the last few months. Believe me these two guys find the openers. Pennsylvania is still loaded with good material. Lastly from Pennsylvania Hale Milano turned up the New Discovery "B" type shown below. Its really a tremendous piece to find. He was at a big antique show in Carlisle, PA at the fairgrounds. There was a lot of everything BUT openers. Finally he chanced upon a guy who had two pre-pro openers. Not wanting to go home empty handed Hale spent about four times more than he had ever spent for an opener. The asking price was \$25.00 and he paid \$22.00.

And finally it was not an acquisition but Bob Stahly reported seeing an A-9 Baseball Player with Coca-Cola advertisement. It was in a Antique Mall in Illinois and was priced \$525.00. He could not get rid of Marge long enough to look at the opener closely, and like Bob told me, \$525.00 can still buy a lot of beer openers. Bob also reports he has been seeing a number of A-56-1 Miller openers at antique and beer shows lately. He figures \$2.50 is a fair price for one. They were supposedly limited edition but it looks like the floodgates have been opened.

Fakes, Frauds & Tomfoolery

New Member, Dean Walters, published this article in the last Canadian Corkscrew Collector's Club (CCCC) Newsletter. An ad for his latest Corkscrew Catalog follows.

Could you recognize a fake corkscrew if you were holding it in your hand? Experts and average collectors alike have difficulty discerning the fabulous from fakery but for some of the most obvious frauds. Fakes have plagued the entire art world, especially when large monetary gain is at stake. Corkscrews have been bringing high prices in private sales as well at auctions, such as Christie's. This has stirred up nests in which fakers have been as busy as bees producing corkscrews of amazing quality. Their focus is mostly toward the 18th and early 19th century designs -- some of the most desirable and valuable items of all.

Just how long fakes have been invading our field of interest is difficult to say, but I have been aware of their presence for about eight years -- about the time large amounts of money were starting to change hands for corkscrews in New York, London and Paris. Fakes originate mostly from centers where avid corkscrew collecting and quality metalsmithing are found. London has become infamous for its so-called 'good fairies', although I believe that the term is now a generic oxymoron, and fakery is likely produced in a number of shops, rather than from one source. Sources of production take second place to the fakes themselves, however, where many early patents, registered items and complex mechanicals seem to have escaped the fakers' efforts for obvious reasons. Regarding materials, forgeries are found in steel, silver, brass, bronze and gold, and possibly in other metals.

Roughly two and a half years ago a large group of fakes entered the U.S. via New York, originating in London. In this group of masterfully crafted fakery were items that we all love to find, if authentic: tinder boxes with corkscrews; French tire bouchons a cages; picnics; harps; some sheathed, and some with rotating 3-sided seals, and/or pipe prickers; open-caged corkscrews with wing nuts. Whatever you might dream of, it looked tasty and authentic. It wasn't, and fortunately the fraud was exposed. Nonetheless, a painful and embarrassing experience for many.

How do you protect yourself from items of dubious distinction? Knowledge and experience. Read books. Look at advanced collections, and if possible, take a close look at items. Attend meetings of the CCCC (or JFO), and talk to seasoned collectors and dealers. Develop a relationship of trust with dealers from whom you buy. Make sure that they will stand by their merchandise. Do they have a good track record?

Items which are faked in silver are often not marked at all, have illegible marks or bear marks that simply cannot be identified. Books on the subject of silver marks may prove to be invaluable. Two very practical ones to consider are The Book of Old Silver, by Wyler, and International Marks on Silver by Tardy. Almost every country in the world which has produced objects of gold and silver, requires by law that the items be marked in a prescribed manner. Authentic silver and gold antiquities bear authentic and standardized marks, in most cases, pertaining to such things as metal purity, date of manufacture, origin, maker, etc. -- sometimes one or more of the above, sometimes all. Marks of England, France and Holland are important to us all.

Furthermore, faked silver items don't bear the same surface patina that authentic items have -- a very random, irregular pattern of fine and coarse nicks and scratches from polishing and wear. The same may be said for the patinas of other metals. Discerning these differences comes with experience, as well as observing many items under the magnification of a high-powered loop. Look closely at a few pieces of authentically old silver, and you will begin to recognize qualities of their patinas.

Many steel corkscrews have joints and seams found on sheaths or cages. Early 19th century or 18th century joining or brazing was done exclusively with soft metals such as brass or bronze. This characteristic may easily be observed with a loop. Seams with metals of other color may be regarded as suspect.

These are just a few reflections regarding an annoying problem. Try to arm yourself with knowledge and experience, not alarm and paranoia. Ask yourself a few questions when you find something that is almost too good to be true. Patina? Marks? Construction? With whom am I dealing? 'Caveat emptor' (Buyer Beware) is as valuable an ancient adage as is the value of any quality antique.

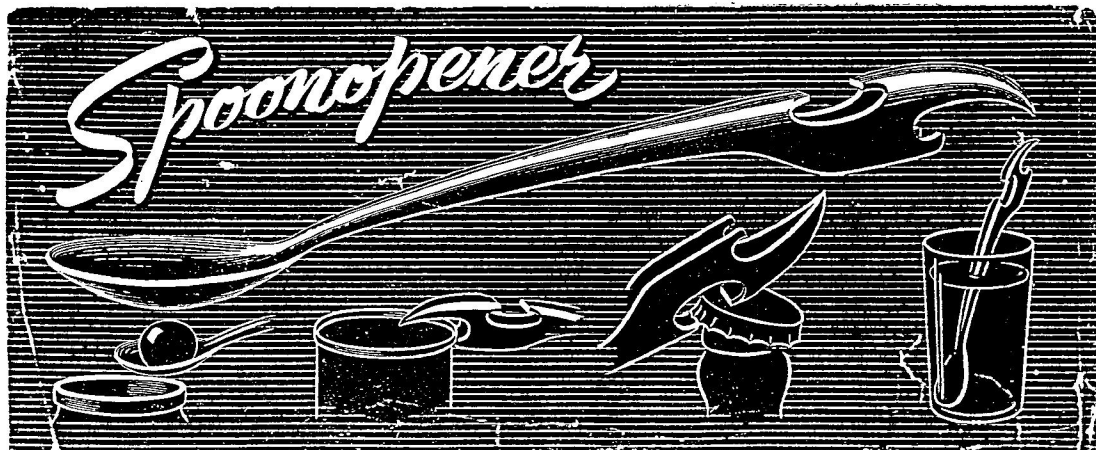

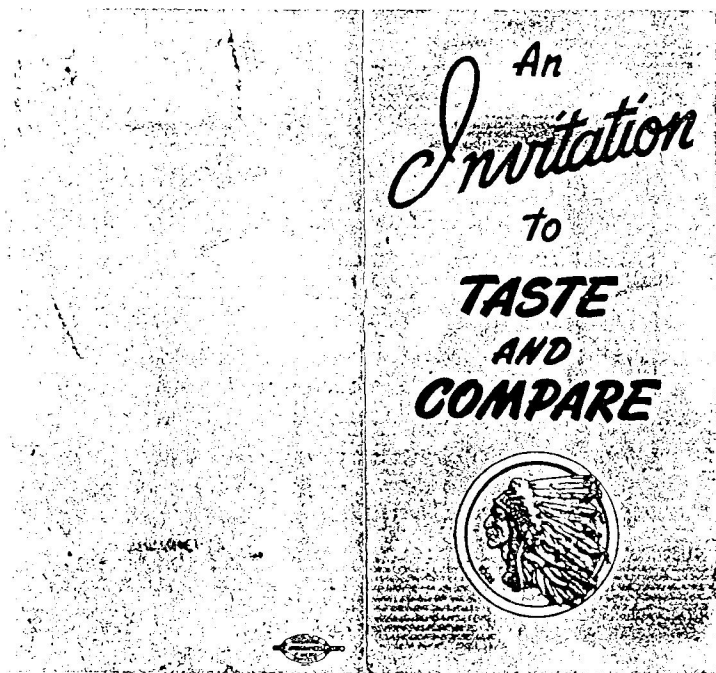

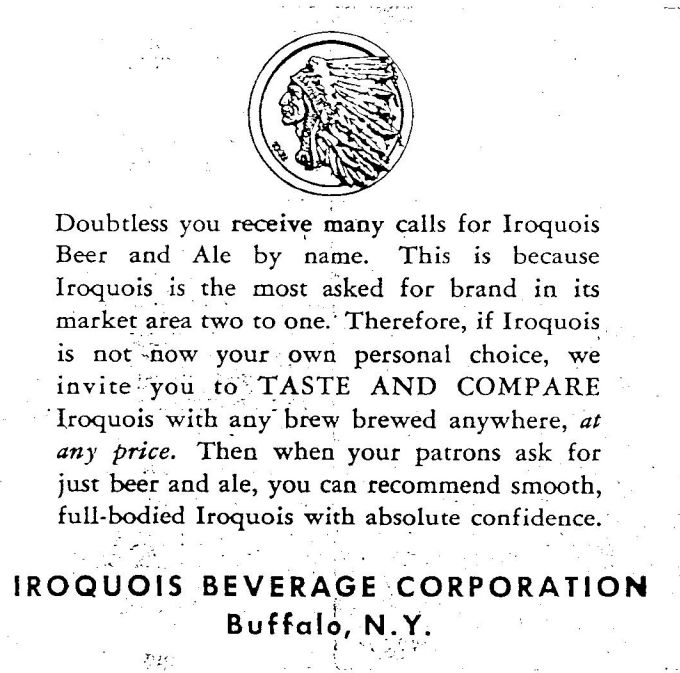

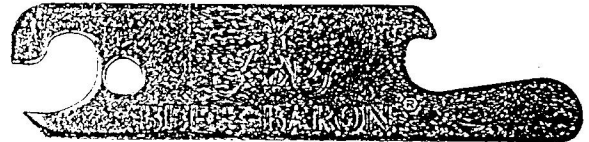

"E-9" & "E-14" Types

Bill McKenzie sent in the following drawings of different types of "E-9"s and "E-14"s. Back in 1988 Bill did a super "Opener Trivia" article on "E-14" openers. When I was working on the new 1994 Handbook I realized Bill's "E-14-a" type was creating a lot of confusion. Bill's logic was that this type was a Post-Pro "E" opener as all other "E-14"s are. The problem was Don Bull originally classified this as a "E-9-b" type (see Oct-1980 JFO). In attempt to make classifying these types easier, I combined the old "E-10"s and "E-12"s with the other "E-14"s. Bill's "E-14-a" was changed back to an "E-9-e".

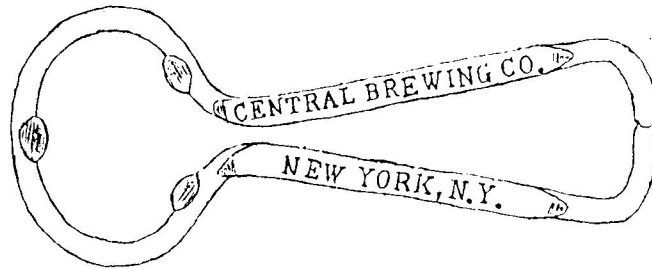
To categorize "E-9"s and "E-14"s, use the following guidelines. Lengths are given to help define sub-categories. In Bill's July 1988 JFO Opener Trivia article he refers to several "E-14"s as having rounded heads. These are really "Square Heads" with "Rounded Shoulders". Type "E-9" has the true "Rounded Head". I will use 9 of Bill's 10 categories from this article. His "E-14-a" is now an "E-9-e" and his "E-14-j" will become an "E-14-a". If anyone has any questions or a better solution please let me know.

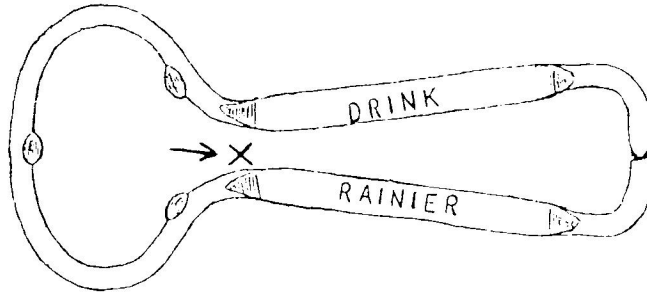

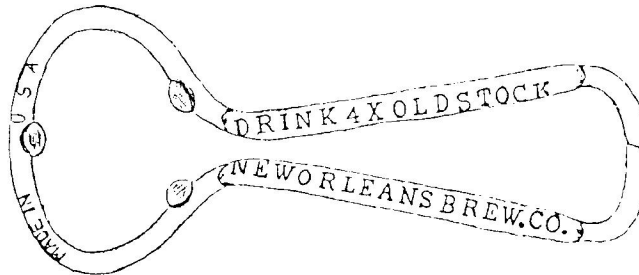

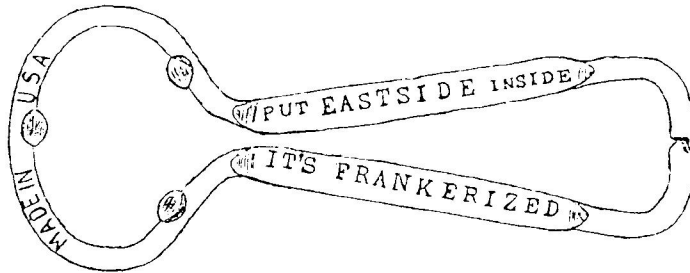
E-9-b Pre-Pro or Post-Pro

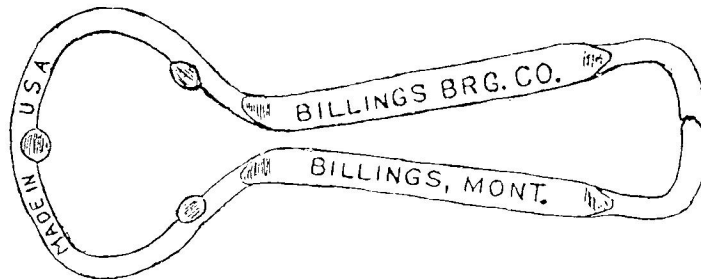

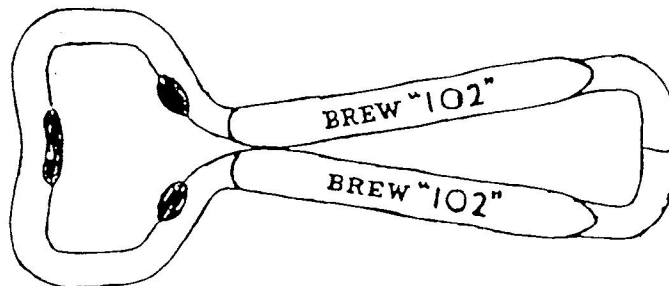

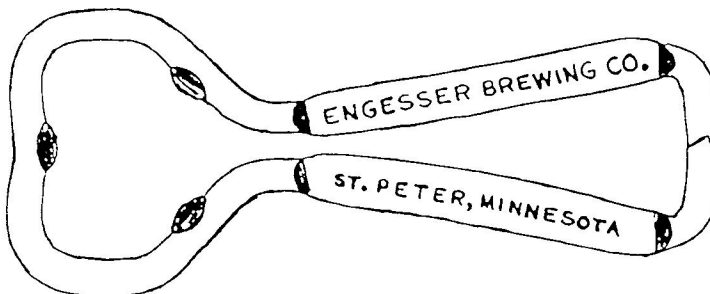
E-14-a Dipped Head, 87 mm Long,

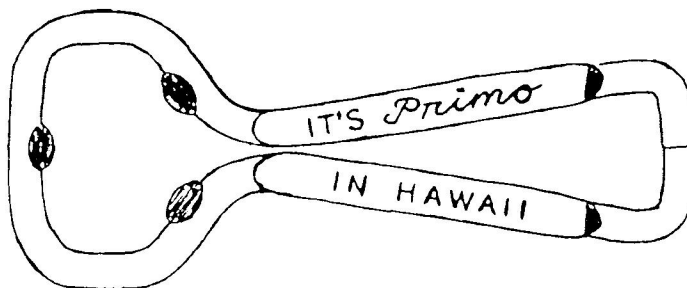
E-14-b Squared Head, 89 mm Long,

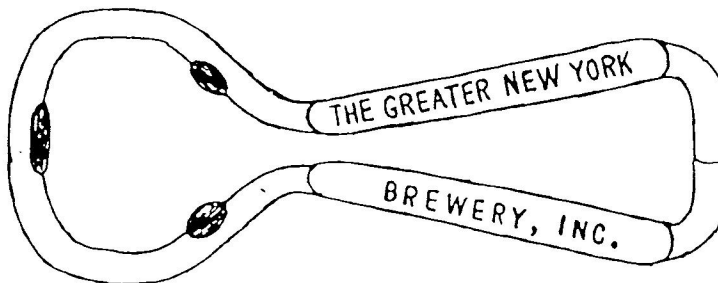
E-14-c Dipped Head, 92 mm Long,

(Rounded Shoulders)

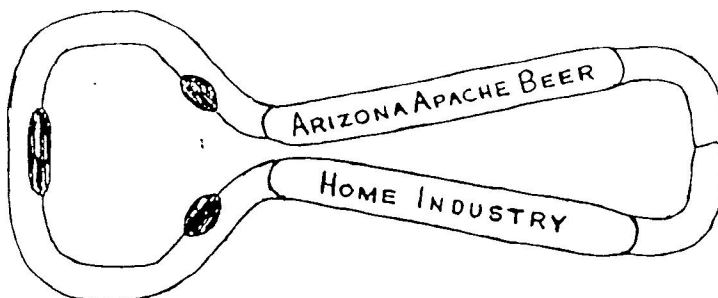


E-14-e Squared Head, 92 mm Long,

(Rounded Shoulders)

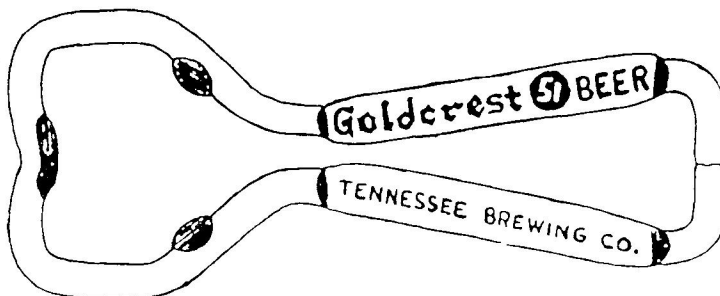

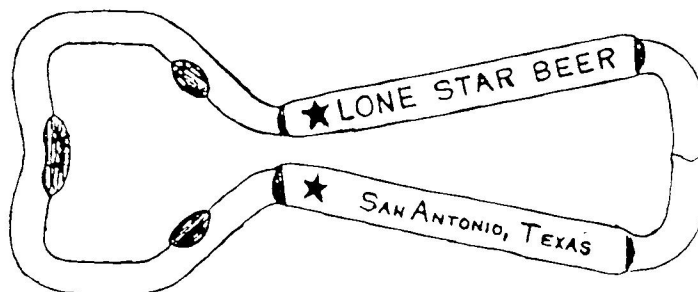
E-14-f Squared Head, 93 mm Long,

(Rounded Shoulders)



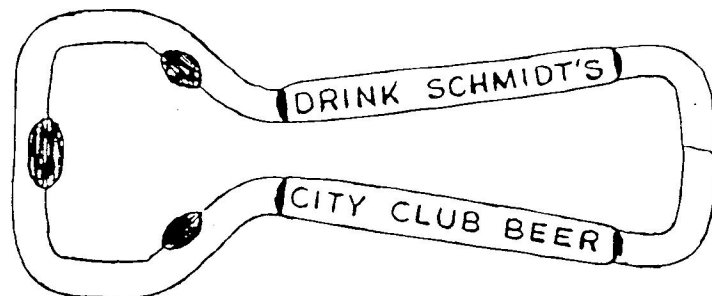
E-14-g Dipped Head, 93 mm Long,
Large Fret at Top



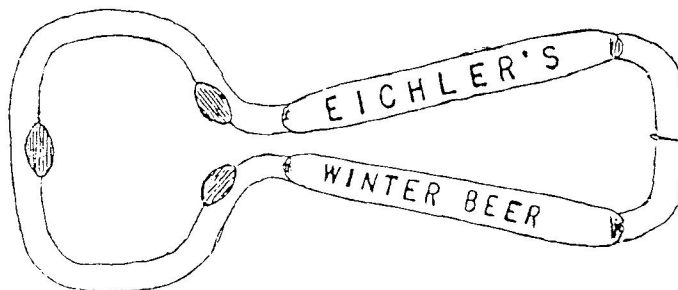
E-14-h Dipped Head, 90 mm Long,

Large Fret at Top

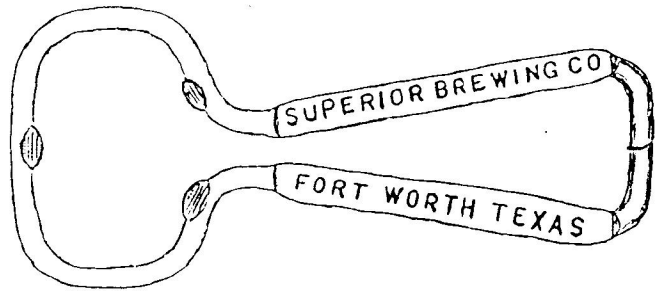


E-14-j Squared Head, 87 mm Long,

(Old Type "E-10")

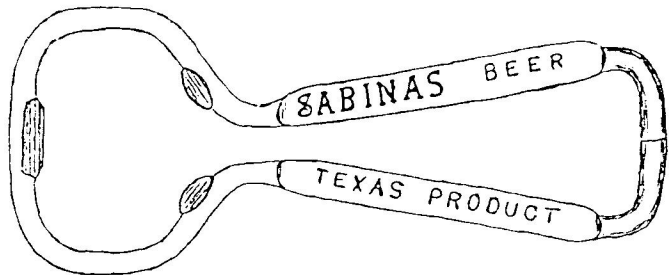

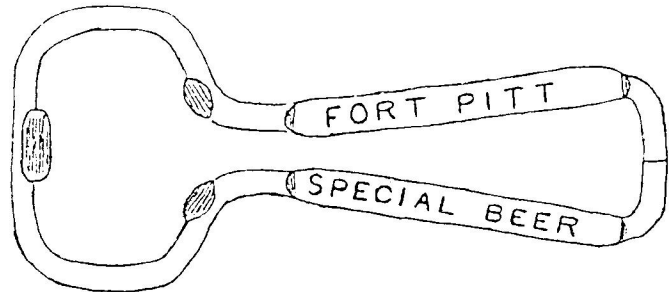
E-14-k Squared Head, 85 mm Long,

(Old Type "E-10")



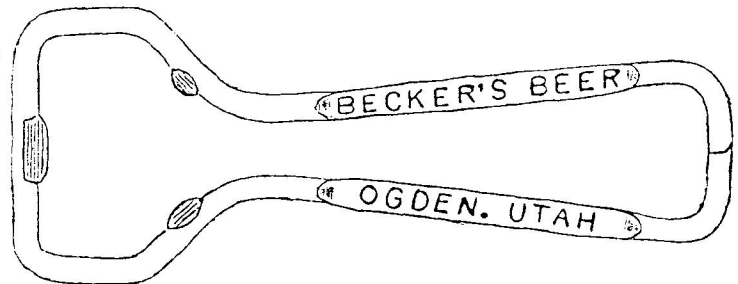
E-14-l Squared Head, 86 mm Long,

(Old Type "E-10")



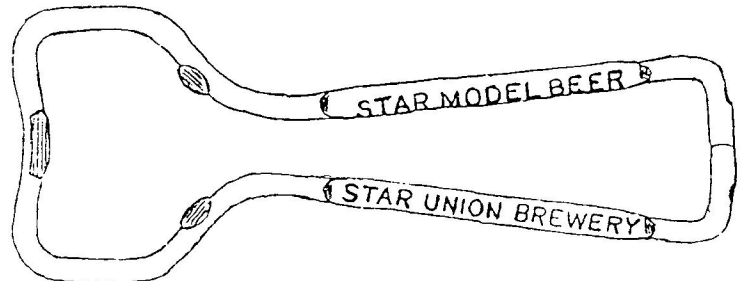
E-14-m Squared Head, 86 mm Long,

CLEANING OPENERS

Since taking over as Editor, several members have written me wanting to know how to clean openers. This topic has been covered several times in past issues. I will present old and new methods of cleaning and let you experiment with any methods you wish to attempt. Since I do a lot of mail trading, I know that many members do not even attempt to clean their openers. For the ones who wish to do so here are several methods.

In the 1st JFO (April, 1979) issue Ed Kaye writes the following. Each opener (if not mint) I get from whatever source, is first wire brushed, then dipped in Naval Jelly, then rinsed in cold water, transferred to extremely hot water, hand dried, and finally buffed. Ed adds a grading system and that he priced his openers (1979) at 25 cents above what he paid for the item.

In the July, 1984 JFO issue Jack Lennon reported that he cleaned openers with fine steel wool and car polish compound. He would then clear spray them.

In the July, 1986 JFO issue Jim Hollinger's letter contained the following explanation on how he cleaned openers. I use various methods for cleaning my openers depending on the original condition. the various steps used in cleaning include:

| 1) Naval Jelly | For very poor condition openers. Openers such as this usually are not worth the effort due to excess pitting. |
| 2) Fine Wire Brush | Fine wire brush is used in a drill press for removing spotty rust areas. A fine wire brush does not scratch the opener finish. |
| 3) Polishing Compound | Automobile paint scratch and blemish remover is used with a soft cloth to buff all openers. This removes dirt and discoloration. |
| 4) Paste Car Wax | All my openers receive a coat of car wax as the final step. This returns the original sheen of the plating as well as it leaves a protective coating against further corrosion. |

Finally in the July, 1990 JFO issue I sent in the following article on how I cleaned openers. At this year's convention several members asked how I clean my openers. The following steps are how I clean most of my openers. Please remember that if an opener is pitted about the only way to remove pitting is by wire brushing (and this does not always work). Also I do not try to clean any openers with enameling using the acid solution.

- 1) Prepare a solution of oxalic acid (can collectors use this) using about 3 tablespoons of crystals for 2 pints of water. I also use a narrow lidded glass container so the opener will not lay flat in the bottom of the jar. The oxalic acid can be purchased at your local drug store (they may have to special order) and the cost is about \$6 for 16 ounces.

CLEANING OPENERS (Continued)

2) Depending upon the condition I will soak an opener in the solution from 30 minutes to 4 hours (for one with a lot of rust). I cleaned an A-13 Car for Gary Deachman at the convention soaking it for about 4 hours. It came out so nice he didn't want to trade the opener to me.

3) At the end of the soaking time remove the opener from the solution using an old screwdriver or coat hanger. ***** Please use rubber gloves ***** when working with the acid as it is harmful to your skin. If you do spill acid on your skin rinse thoroughly with water.

4) I then scrub the opener with a soapy "SOS" pad. I dry the opener thoroughly with paper towels. If the opener has a moving part I will add some machine oil.

Hopefully this method will help make your openers look better. But remember do it after you have traded for the opener!!!

Since the above article came out I have continued to use Oxalic Acid. If an opener is pitted I use a Dremel (small electric drill). The Dremel is used by Jewelers and anyone needing a small drill but it can leave brush marks. The wire brush attachment is very handy for cleaning pitted openers. You cannot remove the pit marks but the discoloration can be cleaned off. The Dremel is especially useful in cleaning the back side of types "G-1", "H-2", and "H-3".

An alternative to the Dremel is using a regular drill with a "Copper" wire brush. Fil Graff has used this before and reports excellent results. Other members use a fine steel brush. With both methods the original finish is supposedly not damaged.

I constantly experiment with Oxalic Acid and have found that many times now I "soak" openers overnight if they are especially rusty. Even if the opener only has a bad spot or two, the overnight soaking will do a good job.

Cleaning openers with "Celluloid" parts (so as type "E-5") is very tough. All I ever do is use warm soapy water to clean the celluloid part. A soapy SOS or just a piece of fine steel wool is used to clean the metal opener. Celluloid is very tough because if the lettering is worn you are just plain out of luck.

Enameled Openers present a real challenge because any rubbing of the enamel will take it right off. Gary Deachman tells me he uses Lemon-Juice (a milder form of Oxalic acid) and lets the opener sit in the solution for up to ten minutes. Close attention must be paid when using this method. If the enamel starts to come off remove the opener from the solution and rinse with water immediately. Bob Stahly uses a "600" Grade Emery cloth and lays the opener flat down on the cloth and rubs both sides of the opener. This method is very helpful with either steel or brass types such as "B-1"s and "B-2"s. The enamel on these openers is in a recess area and will not come off when the opener is rubbed on a flat surface. Other members simply repaint these type of openers if the enamel is gone. I personally use "Brasso". All back sides are cleaned but I only clean the front side if little or no enamel remains, or the edges if a lot of enamel remains.

CLEANING OPENERS (Continued)

Copper plated openers are another tough type to clean. Acid or any rubbing will remove the copper. I usually just use a damp cloth and then dry thoroughly.

With steel openers I usually will buff the opener if any of the original finish remains when I am finished cleaning. Buffing is considered a "No-No" by some collectors but I believe it certainly helps the overall appearance of the opener.

Jack Ford like Bob Stahly uses Emery Cloth. Jack's is a 4/0 grade Emery Cloth that he gets for his Art Class (Jack is a college professor). Using a small piece of the Emery Cloth with a little kerosene, mineral spirits or turpentine, sand a rusted opener and it will clean up the opener very nicely. Any JFO member can write Jack (**Please enclose a self addressed stamped envelope**) and he will send the member some free samples.

Please be careful. Experience is very helpful using the acid method. So use some junk openers when you start out. See the results and go from there. Finally I am sorry for all of the methods for cleaning openers but try one out and see what happens. Remember "rust" is an opener's worst enemy. If you live near salt water, read this article again and get busy.

Please use the following guidelines when using these prices:

- 1) **Condition** Prices are for openers in at least excellent condition.
- 2) **Scarcity** Openers with the highest prices are generally the hardest to find openers especially in nice condition. Several types have few examples known and this is reflected in the price.
- 3) **Demand** Malt companies or the more common brewery names are at the low end. Small breweries or breweries in business for a short time bring the highest value. Also certain areas of the country have more collectors looking for openers from that area (Ex: Missouri or Pennsylvania).

Several members have voiced minor complaints over the prices. Older members have complained about price increases over Don Bull's price guide while newer members have complained about the wide price range given for many opener types. My response to the first complaint is that after 13 years a collector should hope that prices go up. I really believe compared to other collectible fields that opener prices are very cheap especially when one considers the rarity of many items. The second complaint is warranted but the situation cannot really be avoided. Like many things only time and experience will give a member the knowledge to know when a certain B-21 is only worth \$2.00 and when one is worth \$30.00.

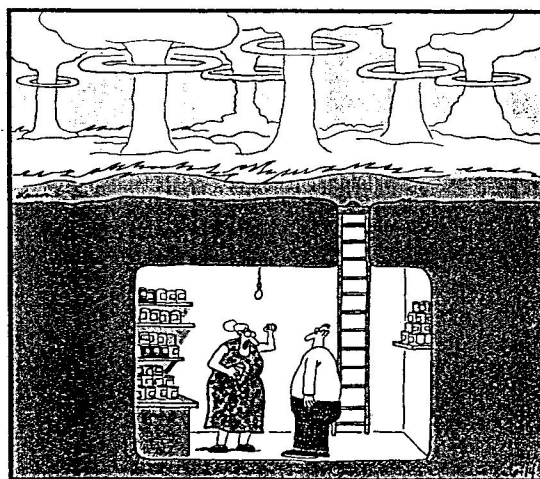
