"Opener Trivia"

Since the last issue Bonnie Tegattz and Ed Kaye both had or now own the 1933 Kerr's World's Fair opener. In fact Bonnie had found a second recently for \$1.25. During the month of November Ebay computer auction had two offered and each time the opener brought around \$10.00. I would assume it is not too hard to come by. The bent "C" Double-Cola wall mount brought several responses. Both Bob Stahly and Henry Smith have advertising Seven-Up and both Harold Queen and Hale Milano have one advertising "Hazel Club". Once again the opener is tough but not exceedingly rare. Both the Coca-Cola and Chicken Ranch spinners as well as both listings of the Jack Daniels opener have been offered numerous times on Ebay. In fact one person offered 500 of the Chicken Ranch opener for \$6.95 each. I sent the seller an email telling his piece was a fantasy item because he claimed it was 19 years old. He responded by asking, "who are you the Chicken?" It never pays to question a seller especially a crooked one. No other responses were received.

In a November auction I picked up a second A-13-6 Lemp's St. Louis Beer from a distributor in Salt Lake City from an Ebay auction in November. Bill McKenzie had shown the opener in "Opener Trivia" in the April, 1987 newsletter. When I received the opener I just assumed it was a duplicate and ended up trading it to Don Whelan. Just before sending it to him I finally compared it to the one I already owned and much to my surprise it was a different stamping. Not wanting to be a "baby trader" I went ahead and sent it to Don. I then remembered Bill's article and compared it to the one he had shown. Bill's was a third variety. It is really hard to believe that a distributor, C.H. Reilley of Salt Lake City, would have made three different stampings of the same opener. Lemp beer must of have been a big seller in that area.

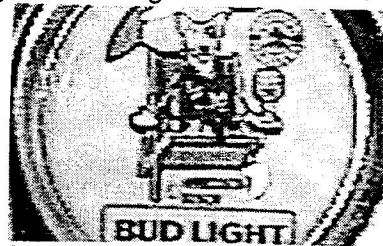
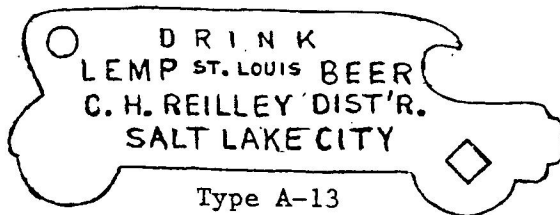

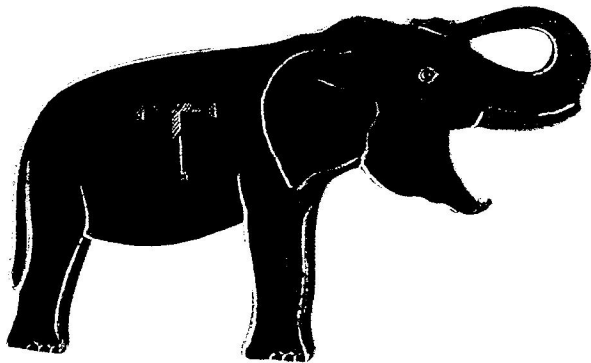
Another recent Ebay item was this B-58-9 Spuds McKenzie. Insert only shown above right was advertised as a rare opener because of the A-B logo above the glass. Opener brought \$20.50. Those old pre-pro openers better move over, the plastic is catching up. Can anyone verify the "rarity" of this plastic insert opener.

Ebay is really becoming hot and even though a lot of junk is sold many good openers and corkscrews are offered for sale. Corkscrews are extremely competitive while openers are becoming increasingly tough also. For some reason Starr X are going for large sums (\$50-\$150) and in most cases are common examples. When you do decide to enter the Ebay sweepstakes take some time to study auction results if you are not sure what you are bidding. Past results are kept for one month and might save you some good money.

"Opener Trivia" (Continued)

Next topic is "grading" and I just want to make a few short comments. It is certainly subjective and if you have very many openers or corkscrews in your collection you know grading is not always easy. I use 5 grades for my collection. Poor (PO) is basically a filler, pitted and usually hard to read. Good (G) has noticeable wear but is displayable and may have a minor pit mark or two. Very Good (VG) has wear but is usually very clean or has a lot of chrome with only a couple of minor spots. Excellent (EX) can also be described as near mint with only the slightest wear. Mint (M) is as issued by the maker, brand spanking new. I will try to have picture examples in a future issue.

Through an Ebay contact I picked up the following two openers. Neither one was formerly known to me and though they are not beer advertising they are very nice flat figurals. The elephant has only a large "T" on it. I believe the "T" stands for "Trommer's Beer" (just kidding). It is a cousin to the more commonly seen donkey. The fish with a gas key advertises "Morgan Spring Co Worcester, Mass. / Wire Forming and Specialties". Has anyone seen these two pieces before and wouldn't it be nice to find them with beer or soda advertising.



Finally Glen Sorrell won the advertising piece below in a spirited battle with yours truly. The spinner opener is from Roundup, Mont. A very unusual way to advertise "A-21"s. The piece folds up and the left edge is shown on the following page.

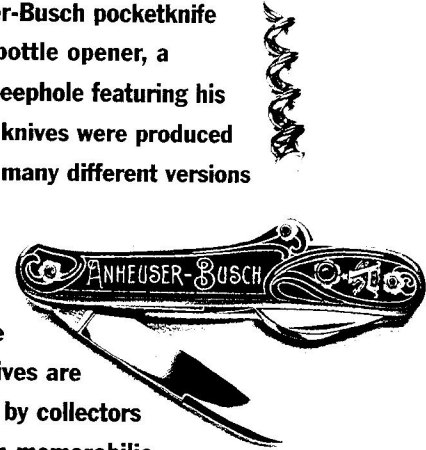

Through the years, Anheuser-Busch has produced countless promotional items. But one of the most unusual—and most famous—was actually one of the first: the Adolphus Busch pocketknife. In keeping with his image as a flamboyant marketer, company-founder Adolphus wasn't about to settle for ordinary business cards. Instead, he gave important business associates an elaborate Anheuser-Busch pocketknife that contained a bottle opener, a corkscrew and a peephole featuring his portrait. The first knives were produced in the 1880s, and many different versions were distributed during the three decades that followed. Today these original pocket knives are much sought after by collectors of Anheuser-Busch memorabilia.

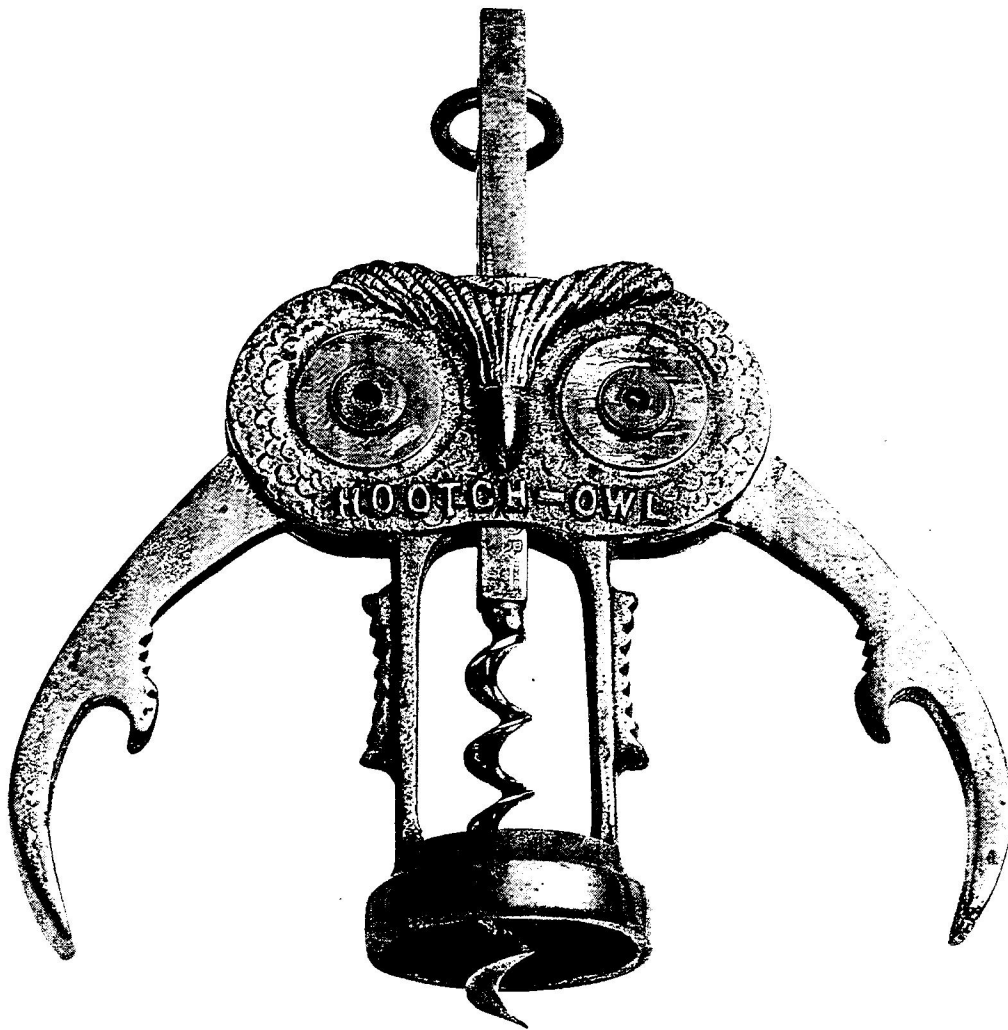

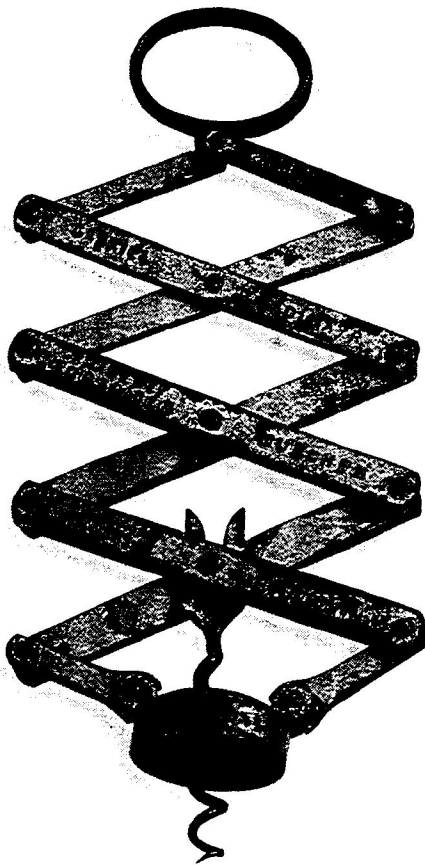
Collecting With a Twist

Donald Bull's corkscrew collection may strike some as "screwy," but he's pulled together a formidable showstopper BY ELIZABETH EILENDER

Bull's assortment of traveling funnels with corkscrews, cap lifters, cups and a carrying case. The one shown lying on its case has a hammered finish and was made in Germany in 1925. Many of these examples are valued at \$100 to \$150.

One corkscrew is enough for most people, but for Donald Bull, there's no such thing as too many. Step into Bull's lakeside home near Roanoke, Va., and everything from his comfortable country-style furniture to his sleepy brown-and-white cat appears ordinary. But a glance at his glass-topped coffee table suggests otherwise. There on display are dozens of corkscrews lined up row after row, each one a tribute to its owner—each has a top shaped like a bull.

Bull, 54, may laugh at this display, but he is intensely serious about his collection of more than 4,000 corkscrews, most of which are antique. While Bull won't give a specific figure, his collection is clearly worth tens of thousands of dollars. Moreover, a walk through his cozy den reveals the enormity of his hobby. The room is filled corner to corner with every imaginable type of corkscrew, many of them stored on top of bookshelves, piled into baskets or neatly arranged inside filing cabinets. It took Bull 20 years to amass this collection, which inspired him to write a 320-page book on the subject. *The Ultimate Corkscrew Book* (Schiffer

Publishing), due out in January.

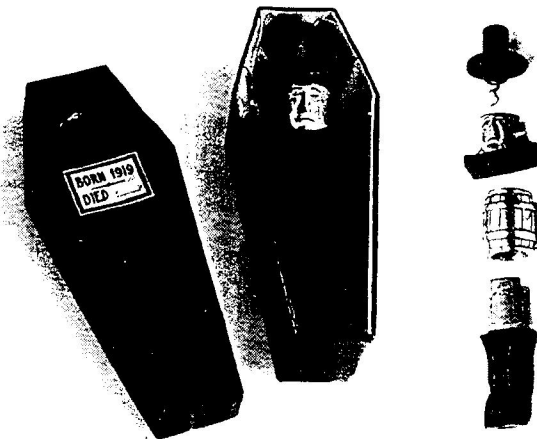
Bull started by collecting bottle openers in the 1970s. Some of these were also corkscrews, and he eventually shifted his focus to those alone. He says that the sheer diversity of design is what inspired him most. "The corkscrew was invented once and reinvented thousands of times since," says Bull, "often with just a slight change."

The first patent for a corkscrew was issued in 1795 to an English minister named Samuel Henshall. For the next two centuries, hundreds upon hundreds of corkscrew patents were issued

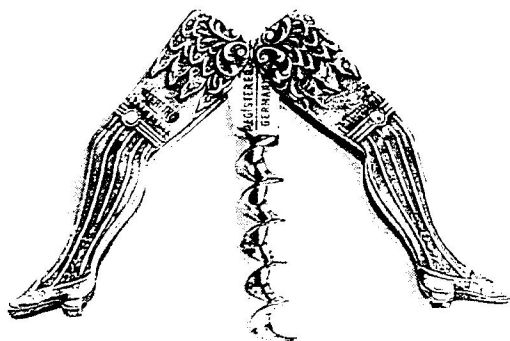

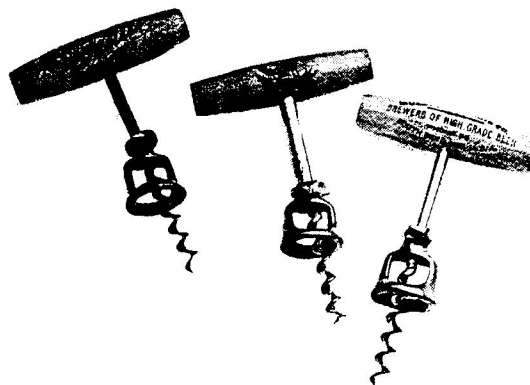
One of Bull's most prized acquisitions, this rare 19th century English-style corkscrew depicts two cherubs at the top and two more at the bottom. Made from brass, Bull estimates its worth at \$15,000 to \$20,000.



Prohibition is symbolically laid to rest with this 6.5-inch coffin carrying a figure that is a combination bottle opener, corkscrew, jigger and bottle stopper. Patented in 1932, it is valued at \$300 to \$400.



Bull's silver "mini-legs," made in Germany in the late 19th century, could bring \$1,000 to \$1,200. Much more common celluloid "legs" in various colors and sizes range from \$200 to \$600.



Examples of Bull's wood-handled advertising corkscrews manufactured by the Williamson Co. of Newark, N.J. They date from 1890 to 1910 and are worth \$15 to \$50, depending on the advertiser.

to inventors and would-be entrepreneurs in Europe and America. Ideas ranged from the brilliant to the absurd, and throughout the 18th and 19th centuries, corkscrew designs reflected their time, place and history, as well as their inventors' imaginations.

Before its purpose evolved solely into uncorking a bottle of wine, the corkscrew was used to uncork almost any type of bottle, including those carrying medicine, ink or perfume. As a result, the corkscrew appeared in countless forms and was often combined with other commonly used items, such as knives, funnels, medicine cups and bottle-cap lifters. The corkscrew was also made in a variety of materials, from common metals, as in the simple wire corkscrews made in the United States, to highly ornate works in silver and gold, which were more often produced in Europe.

"When people think of corkscrews, they think of something with a shank, a worm and a handle," says Bull. "And many people struggle to pull a cork out. But you don't need to struggle, because there are all kinds of mechanisms to make it easier."

In fact, a tour of Bull's collection reveals the many attempts by

inventors over the centuries to make extracting a cork simple. His collection includes European- and American-made corkscrews, the values of which range from 50 cents to several thousand dollars, depending on the corkscrew's origin, condition, age, design and material.

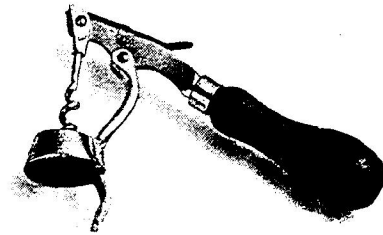
Opening drawer after drawer of an architect's filing cabinet, Bull reveals the eclectic nature of his collection: single-lever corkscrews, double-lever corkscrews, lazy tongs, French two-finger pulls, German "Can-Can Legs," German spring barrels, 19th century English split-frame corkscrews, American wood-handled advertising corkscrews, English folding bows, roundlets, peg-and-worms and traveling funnels with corkscrews. Most were designed to improve on one of two tasks: removing the cork from the bottle or removing the cork from the worm.

One of Bull's cabinet drawers is filled with nothing but antique bottle openers in various sizes with a corkscrew hidden by a sheath. "When you go to an antiques show, you'll frequently see these cap lifters with silver handles," says Bull. "And if you're a corkscrew collector, you'll pick up every one and give the handle

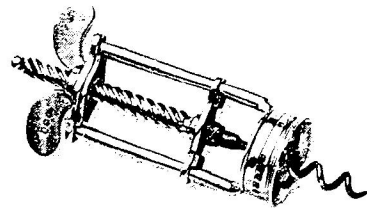

a twist to see if there's a corkscrew inside."

Figural corkscrews also make up a significant portion of Bull's collection. One of his most famous is the Syroco model, made by the Syracuse Ornamental Company, which in the 1940s and '50s produced a series of corkscrews shaped like dogs, monks and clowns, among other designs, some of which sell for \$200 to \$500 each. The "Indian" design sells for about \$1,000, and a "Golden Knight" can fetch \$1,300.

One figural corkscrew that Bull deals with extensively is a Prohibition-era corkscrew thought to be a parody of Andrew Volstead, author of the Volstead Act of 1919, which enforced the 18th Amendment. Fascinated by this connection to American political history, Bull began to research the so-called Volstead corkscrews, hoping to confirm that they were indeed inspired by the congressman.

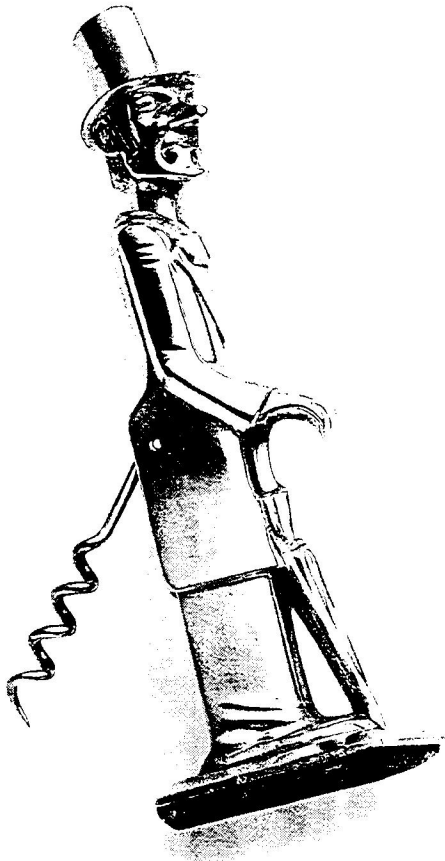
"I set out to prove that it was Volstead, but in the course of

doing so I proved just the opposite," says Bull. The figure takes after a character invented by a 1930s cartoonist named Rollin Kirby, who referred to his creation by several names, including "Mr. Dry" and "Old Snifter." Bull proved himself a thorough researcher, however: He went so far as to talk with the nanny of Volstead's children.

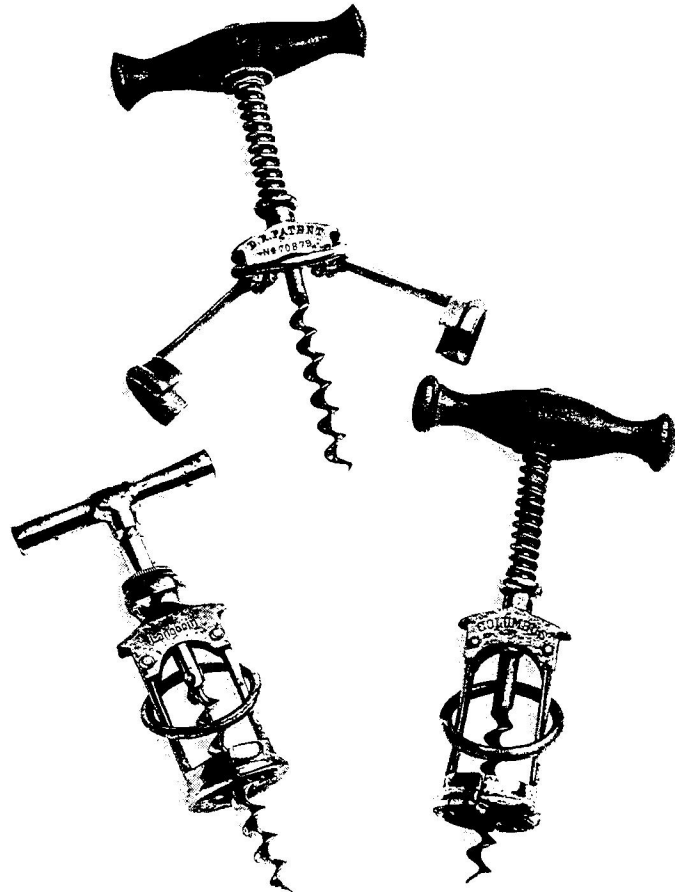
Bull is not a corkscrew collector by profession. Now retired, he was formerly president of a manufacturing company in Stamford, Conn., that produced specialty tube cleaners and high-powered vacuums. Since serious collecting requires a tremendous amount of time, Bull would often hire "pickers" to search flea markets and garage sales throughout the country.

But searching for yourself has special rewards. Bull recalls a small consignment shop in Connecticut where he spotted a corkscrew priced at \$4. He suspected that he had found a rare 19th century single-lever corkscrew that was patented by a man

named Alfred Sperry. "The last one like this I heard of sold for \$3,000," says Bull.

In 1982, Bull became a member of a quirky club known as the International Correspondence of Corkscrew Addicts (*Wine Spectator*, Oct. 31, 1996). He was the club's president, called the "Right" ("because anyone would rather be right than president"), from 1993 to '95. Founded in 1974, the group meets once a year in either Europe or the United States and limits its membership to 50 "addicts" to ensure that members are serious and committed.

The annual meetings present an opportunity to trade information—and, of course, corkscrews by the hundreds. Another major venue is the semiannual corkscrew auction held at Christie's London. The latest sale, held Sept. 22, featured a single-owner collection of about 300 corkscrews. One of the most sought-after pieces, a Lunds 1838 bottle-grip corkscrew, sold for \$8,200. During a sale of pieces from various other collections, the auction also offered an example of pioneer Reverend Samuel Henshall's corkscrew, which fetched \$2,052. The auction also brought one of the highest prices ever paid for a single corkscrew at Christie's: \$31,280 for

a rare 19th century Robert Jones II corkscrew designed in 1842, matching the price paid in May 1997 for an English 18th century silver corkscrew.

While there's a lot to be said for the thrill of attending an auction, bidders can be just as cutthroat on the Internet. Bull, like so many other passionate collectors, has discovered the benefits of bidding online. The eBay Web site (www.ebay.com), in particular, has become a collector's paradise, offering for sale virtually anything worth collecting, from old postcards and toys to antique furniture and even corkscrews. Bull logs on to the site daily to keep track of what's out there and the prices people are paying. "[eBay is] really going to hurt antique shows in the future," he predicts.

With more time on his hands, Bull runs his own Web site (members.aol.com/corkscrew) from his house along Smith Mountain Lake in Wirtz, Va., 20 miles outside of Roanoke. The Web site serves as a clearinghouse for corkscrew addicts and curiosity seekers alike. Despite his obsession, Bull has not yet tried every corkscrew in his collection. Still, he says, he loves them all. "The next one I want," he adds, "is the one I haven't heard of yet." □

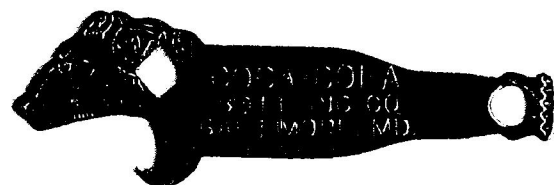
