Regretfully I must report the passing of one of JFO's original members. Jerry Schele passed away in July at the age of 75. He was member #16 and an ardent collector of Indiana openers and types. Jerry attended several of the early conventions but due to poor health had not been able to do so in recent years.

On August 14th Peg Nugent, wife of former member Bob Nugent, passed away. Bob and Peg were ardent collectors of many things with her passion being figural tape measures.

**2000 ECBA Convention Somerset NJ (July 12-15 2000)**

For the first time since I started coming to major beer conventions, I am the only serious opener collector in attendance. Doesn't really matter if there aren't any good openers for sale. With 60 members in attendance I figured some good openers would turn up. Ken Ostrow had a wire opener and a soda opener; a few other miscellaneous openers turned up but nothing great. I did spend Friday hiking up to the top of the Statue of Liberty and the highlight of the show was Tom and Phyllis Gormally having me over for supper on Thursday night. Tom specializes in "C"s and "E"s and "G-1"s and has a very nice collection. And don't let me forget his extra nice collection of "I-7"s. Thank you Phyllis and Tom for a special evening. Saturday's show had a nice walk-in crowd with the highlight of the show seeing Harold and Boots Queen. It was still a fun convention with lots of hospitality. Next year's convention is slated for Lowell, Mass.

**2000 NABA Convention Naperville IL (August 2-6 2000)**

If the ECBA Convention was slow, the NABA Convention was the exact opposite. Lots of great breweriana was available. Not necessarily cheap but if you wanted some good beer items and didn't mind spending money, Naperville was the place to be the first week of August. With over 200 members in attendance, many collectors were crying about running out of money. Regardless of what anyone ever tells you, if you go home from a show broke it was a good show. I didn't come home broke, but close to it. My best purchase was a P-64-UL G. Heileman barmount corkscrew from La Crosse, Wis. It cost \$300 but I was very glad to obtain it.

Unlike ECBA there were quiet a few opener collectors in attendance. Don Whelan, Dave Lendy, Larry Moter, Norm Jay, Pat Stambaugh and of course my roommate for the show, John Bitterman. Overall Dave Lendy seemed to get the best openers at this show, with a real jewel being an O-5-UL Monarch Beer (a brass ad plate was attached to the O-5). With Larry Moter in attendance it would not be a successful show unless we did complete a big trade. One of the openers I received was the new O-20 Hamms and another nice opener I got from Larry was an O-8 Coca-Cola in great shape. Dave Lendy was kind enough to take me to his house to see his collection. Contrary to my previous beliefs, Dave has a lot of fine openers and nicely displayed also. For someone who has only collected four years he has amassed an enviable collection. Thursday night I met Joe and Jackie Young for supper. The place we chose even had an opener display case (just new and foreign openers).

Supper with Joe and Jackie followed an all afternoon Chicago bus tour. We were able to see a lot of the old Chicago brewery sites. The action was fast and furious at the hotel. I did not hear of anyone going home disappointed. The Friday NABA auction set a record for total sales and the Saturday public show was very well attended and most everyone seem to sell a lot of breweriana. The Chicago Tribune ran an article on the show and our own Don Whelan was quoted in the article (see below). Next year's NABA Convention is in Detroit, Mi.

(Chicago Tribune) This 29<sup>th</sup> annual event also seemed like a family affair to the dealers and collectors in attendance. According to NABA President Norm Jay, a resident of Wheaton, participants traveled from 28 states, two Canadian provinces and Germany.

Don Whelan of Savannah, Mo., sat at tables lined with his specialty, beer openers and corkscrews. Occasionally referring to a handbook listing more than 13,000 known openers, Whelan said values of the openers today range from \$5 to \$50, with the more expensive ones dating before Prohibition.

"I started 10 years ago," Whelan explained of his collecting. "My wife is a Campbell's Soup (can) collector, and it was fun for me to just pick up openers when we went to flea markets. Then one thing led to another." Whelan estimates his collection includes 4,000 items.



# Spouse's Corner

When I wrote my July contribution to the JFO newsletter, I had been spending an excessive amount of time writing at work. Well, that continues. My usual mix of meetings, working with campus staff and writing is way out of balance. But, I know that the JFO members look forward to Spouse's Corner, so here it is!!

The 1983 articles are reviewed this time. In 1983, a certain red-headed collector was taking programming classes during the day at a technical college in Winston-Salem, N.C. I was taking the same classes at night, probably passing him in the computer lab sometime, completely unaware that we would meet a few years later in another town, marry and publish JFO every quarter.

On November 29, 1983, Art Santen had 10,074 openers in his collection. Can you imagine counting those? I have been involved in verifying physical inventories and I thought the day I had to check fishing tackle in a bin was bad. Try counting to 100, 100 times today!

Cardone's 7th auction brought an average of \$6.97 per opener, then the 8th auction dropped to \$6.52.

Some neat cartoons were included in the January '83 issue. I better start reading the funnies for some new humor.

Members did send in some business cards, as requested. In the July issue, Vic Keown's was hilarious. "My wife will not pay the ransom....return me unharmed." Can any other spouses relate to this? Ollie Hibbeler lived on Country Life Drive. Doesn't that sound relaxing! Other than worrying about getting all the openers you want, you wouldn't have a worry in the world.

In January '83 Ed Kaye had 7,725 openers listed. His breakdown by type is compared to the current numbers, totaling 13,917:

My thanks to John for accumulating the current numbers. He did not have the information at hand and had to do a lot of counting to answer my inquiry. I cleaned up the kitchen tonight in return!

Bull included a picture and article on a corkscrew that does not have a beer advertisement, but certainly had some interesting history connected. The corkscrew belonged to a brewer, Gottfried Piel. He left his home in Dusseldorf, Germany in 1882 at the age of 29. The next year he convinced his brothers Michael and Wilhelm to join him in the purchase of the Landser Brewery. Piel Bros. grew and grew and became a Brooklyn tradition. Although the brewery closed after some rough years in the '60's and '70's, the Piel name is still in use, after Schaefer Brewing Company purchased it in 1973.

Gotfried died in 1935, which means that Piel beer helped him live into his 80's...wish I liked beer! Anyways, his personal corkscrew was left to his daughter. She remarried after the death of her first husband, and the second husband left the corkscrew to his nephew. The nephew treasured the piece for two years before selling it to Don Bull.

I think the cartoon of someone with a corkscrew out of their head in the April '83 issue might have been the motivation for the famous Captain Corkscrew at the 1989 convention, our one and only, Art Santen.

In 1902, Sears featured the Champion Cork Puller in their catalog. Life was probably better back in those days.

Grammes & Sons, Inc. from Allentown, Pa. produced sales promotion materials in metal, for signs, trays, bottle openers or what not. No wonder John always liked to go to Pennsylvania on the "hunt".

In the April '83 issue, you can see a B-19 marked, "Compliments Becker Brewing & Malting Co., Ogden, Utah" that has the Prestolite key in a different position on the opener than usual. Seems like it would weaken the tool.

Ed Kay ran a puzzle in the Jan. '83 issue. The April issue announced the winner, a young girl, not quite 11 years old. Does anyone know if Amy Rice is still collecting? She had already run out of space for her collection, but said, "I'll just keep buying openers if I have to keep them in a shoebox."

The July '83 issue told how the Walker wood handle corkscrew is put together. That is good to know, especially if you happen to use one to open wine one night when your spouse is sleeping and you break it!

Bull had been investigating patents again and provided information on several in the July issue. Patent # 1,124,288 issued January 12, 1915 to Elvah Bulman of Grand Rapids, Michigan (where I first lived after leaving Canada) was for the cigar cutter part of this type B-28 opener. Patent # 2,493,438 was issued January 3, 1950 to Emile Boucher of Baltimore, Maryland for "Jar and Tumbler Cap Lifting and removing tool". The N-26 is a variation of this patent. Manuel Avillar of NYC designed both the R-10 dog and the R-11 parrot in 1929.

According to some Erie, Pennsylvania newspapers, the "Week of April 30 to May 8, 1954 declared 'Can Opener Week' by the Can Manufacturers Institute said Marketing Director Harold H. Jaeger." Funny that our annual JFO convention is very close to that time of year.

A copy of a 1925 Vaughan catalog was included in the July newsletter. If you compared it to the 1922 catalog, only the wood handle ice pick and bottle opener were added. Prices had been reduced substantially in the later catalog.

Of course, all July issues are fun to read, as the convention pictures are included! Amy Young was shown drawing tickets for door prizes. It's hard to believe that she is now the mother of three little boys, ages 4, 2 and a new infant.

The October '83 issue was Bull's retirement issue. Ed Kaye would take the "bull" by the horns and continue the publication.

For this special issue, Bull included photographs of some of his favorite openers, M-3 retractables and beer advertising corkscrews. He encouraged more "collection" and personal interest photographs in future issues. Tell a story about how you acquired an opener! His words still fit.

He set a good example by sharing the story about his acquisition of a K-10. Read it to find out what might happen when you show interest in the history of a can opener.

Bull would not fade out of the collector's world at all. His goal after turning over the editorship was to publish an expanded version of the Register of United States Breweries that he published in 1976. He wanted this done by the first half of 1984 and did just that.

The three varieties of Electro-Chemical's "PrestOpener" are pictured in this issue, the regular cap opener, the over the top type and the cap lifter with corkscrew.

The issue concluded with pictures of a small portion of Bull's fabulous collection, ending the first five years of JFO!

And so Spouse's Corner ends this issue, with a tearful tissue.

### Canadian Breweriana on the Antique's Road Show 9/11/2000

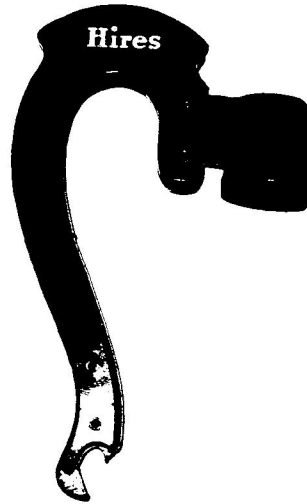
Commenting on some of the higher priced items; the A-9-34 White Eagle was in fair condition; the A-15 and A-17 Leisy openers were bid up by bidders with a last name of Leisy; A-42-UL Pfeiffer was apparently a very desirable Detroit, Mi. opener; B-7 Coca-Cola is a very tough style in Coca-Cola; B-18 Dr. Pepper was highly desired by several Dr. Pepper collectors; E-5 Pepsi-Cola was mint and had a nice Pepsi bottle embossed on the handle; M-3 Sliders continue bringing good money especially when the condition is excellent; M-63-1 Hamms had several high bids by Hamms collectors; M-73 Budweiser ended up in the Pinney collection (see want ads); M-80 Kingsbury was found in large numbers (at least 10-15) and the seller is still listing one every so often on eBay; N-4-2 Star with the Wooden Shoe logo is highly desired by area collectors in that part of the country; the best buy this past quarter was the N-62-1 Schlitz and Coca-Cola for \$14; two different N-80-1 Jax knives were offered and brought almost the identical price; P-25 A-B are doing well when condition is nice and extremely well when in the original box; and last but not least is the R-8-1 Kaiers which was in great condition and the final price reflected this more than rarity (I need one but it does turn up from time to time).

The following E-9-1 Anheuser-Busch (on the left) had it's handle reshaped to form a heart. It might be a good idea to do it to yours if you have one, as this one brought \$42.99 on eBay. This took some doing and was probably done years ago but be careful (please note NOT a new discovery). On the right is a new fantasy opener. Please note it is not old. It is basically a political type “button” with an opener added to the back. The breweries advertised are mostly from upstate New York. Maybe pay a \$1 or \$2 apiece but not more than that. Not a bad idea, just 80 years too late.

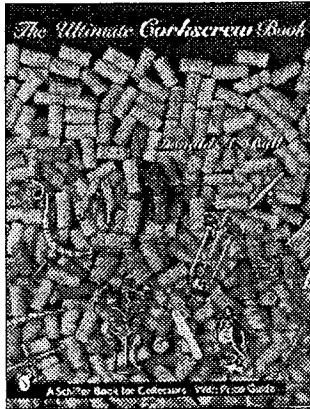

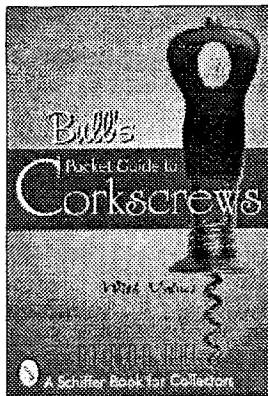
