## Bringing Openers and Corkscrews to San Francisco

My NABA Fall Meeting was in Mishawaka IN the first of October and I took about 10 openers (mainly "A"s, "B"s, and "E"s) in my carry-on bag on the flight. In Raleigh they did open my bag to check them out. Coming back from Chicago, they were not checked by the screeners. Just remember, no corkscrews, knives or ice picks will pass inspection. If you want to bring any items in these categories, either plan on putting them in a bag that you will check into unlocked cargo or plan on shipping the items to John Cartwright. If you mail items to Cartwright you may just want to ship everything opener or corkscrew wise that you are planning on bringing to the convention.

## JFO Editor Buys Jerry Schele Collection

While Dave Lendy and I attended the Hooiser Breweriana Show for the NABA board meeting, I had time to drive to FT Wayne IN and check out the collection of former JFO member, Jerry Schele. Thanks to Dave, he hooked me up with Doug Farmer (a Ft Wayne beer collector) who was trying to help the Schele family sale Jerry's collection. Dave had a short list of good openers supposedly in the collection and knew the price was around \$2,000 for the collection. I had four and a half hours to pull this off and it was a little over two hours driving each way from Mishawaka.

Jerry's widow, Kathy, was out of town and her son agreed to meet me outside of Ft Wayne and lead me to the house. I only spent 20 minutes viewing the collection. It was in a basement and it had flooded a couple of years before. As all opener collectors know, openers and water are not a good combination. Fortunately most of the good openers were high off the floor and had not gotten wet. I quickly scanned and figured there several very good styles as this was Jerry's specialty. A lot of common openers were available. In any event I felt any price \$2,000 or less would be fair. On the down side, the son would not deal on the collection. He said I would have to wait until his mother was back in town. It was two hours back to Mishawaka and I made it just in time for the NABA board meeting.

The following Monday back in Durham, I called and reached Kathy. She was pretty firm on the \$2,000 price as she claimed there were 2,000 openers in the collection. I agreed after she said this would include shipping to Durham. I sent her a check and about 10 days later the collection arrived. Instead of 2,000 there was really only about 500 to 600. But I was very happy with the better styles which included the following; A-11-1 Wooden Shoe, A-22-1 Ballantine (rough), B-5-17 Parkersburg, B-31-1 Menks, E-1-34 Monarch, E-4-84 Schultz, E-27-1 Kamm & Schellinger, P-1-1 Anthony & Kuhn and a R-6-Brass Sprenger. There were also a lot of nice "A"s and "B"s. The only bad note was I just threw out 30 to 40 openers and some good \$5-10 ones that were very rusty. You never know when the opportunity will come knocking. This was not a big money maker collection, but nice types found a home in my collection.

## Software Upgrade Causes This Issue to Be Late

In January of 2001, the JFO newsletter switched from Microsoft Word to Microsoft Desktop Publisher. I had a pretty big learning curve then, but adding pictures and several other features of Publisher allowed me much more flexibility with doing the newsletter. Probably the biggest benefit was no more paste-up pictures and having the newsletter photocopied from my printout, the newsletter could be printed straight from the publisher file. Things went very well until this summer when I would receive the proof back, 2-3 pages would not line up right. It happened again and I was informed by Kinko's (they produce the 300 copies each time) that I was using a 2000 version of Publisher and they use a 2002 version.

In any event I broke down and upgraded to the 2002 version of Publisher. As you might guess another learning curve. Not as bad as it was in 2001, but as usual Microsoft is notorious moving buttons and just everything needed to use the software around to different locations than in the previous version. Anyway it is working well and you will notice some layout changes (front page and the banner section at the top). Table processing is a little more cumbersome than before but everything seems to work as well if not better. As usual comments are always welcomed and hopefully I can be more timely in the future. I do like to mail the newsletter the first few days of the month, not the middle of the month as when this one will be mailed. Oh did I mention, Microsoft now has a 2003 version of Publisher on the market. The fun never ends.

These corkscrews are actually based on a figure invented by Rollin Kirby, a political cartoonist who developed the figure upon which they could hang their displeasure with Prohibition.

Nick started out in St. Charles, Missouri, but later opened up a business at a St. Louis address that is now under the St. Louis Gateway Arch. A fire destroyed the business and Nick lost everything including his home. Then he moved about 24 miles away and made cigars by hand, slipping a special one to Ollie when grandma wasn't looking. Of course, Ollie didn't say no thanks!

John just checked in to see how many pages this article is, so better move on to the final newsletter for 1996, October. (During this composition the weather has turned from being in the 70's to snow).

John did some research, rather scholarly research, on a P-71 that had a stanhope that read "BUDWEISER/C.C. & CO. MOSS ROSE." He was interested in the origins of C. Conrad & Co. and received some information from the historical department of Anheuser-Busch Companies. Carl Conrad was born in Germany in 1842, immigrated to St. Louis in 1861 and died in 1922. In 1875 he and Adolphus Busch collaborated to develop a new brand of beer that would be acceptable to all tastes and capable of being shipped great distances without loss of quality. The beer they developed was BUDWEISER.

This issue had a great article on the Origin of the K-5 Barmount written by the daughter of Andrew Peter Wadoz. Andy's Speedy Beer Can Opener was invented to make sure beer was served cold and quickly at the state fair, races and football games.

Andrew worked for G.E. X-ray during the day but manufactured beer can openers in his basement at night, making it a family production. He also invented a jar for dispensing mustard, a bun slicer and box cutter. He never patented

any of the items, but did make enough to send his wife and her friends to Las Vegas every year, sent two daughters to college and gave the family security as the business grossed a little more than twice his wages at G.E.

At the ECBA Convention that year, our friends Art and Eileen Johnson attended the lobster feast at Ken Ostrow's and gave John pointers on eating them.

John rode back to Chicago from the NABA Convention held in Milwaukee with our friends Joe and Jackie Young (see there are lots of friends in JFO). ## “Opener and eBay Trivia”

In the last issue Art Santen asked about the spelling of Tannhauser? Ben Hoffman and Harold Queen both responded and agreed with Art's corrections.

The past quarter saw some really good openers on eBay but the junk ones continue to increase in number and the good ones offered for sale are slowly dwindling. Corkscrews were very active as Don Bull offered a collection of about 750 corkscrews for sale and at the same time many good corkscrews were placed for sale by a German collector. This was in addition to the normal run of good corkscrews offered on eBay.

Nothing too exciting in the “A” types was auctioned. The fake Coca-Cola baseball player saw at least two examples bring high prices even though the market has been glutted with these openers. As far as I know two A-30 Coca-Cola ballerina leg openers from Sapula and Bristow (OK) were offered. The first brought \$294.99, the second \$213.49 and the first of January I bought a third one offered for sale for \$65.00. It is a tough opener to find, just amazing that three were offered on eBay so close together. Beer “A”s did not see anything great offered, though the A-4-10 Star from Saginaw MI brought \$105.49 as a very serious Michigan collector mowed down the JFO bidders. The A-50-1 Arcadia is a very hard type to find and was bought at a very reasonable price of \$42.00.

Ebay saw the usual offering of “B” types with a few surprises. One being the B-21-61 Olt bringing \$118.49 (Dayton OH openers are very desirable) as this opener does turn up from time to time. The B-21-144 Auto City was bought by a woman related to the original owner. The real shocker was the first B-23 Dr Pepper I have seen for sale anywhere and did the Dr Pepper collectors ever go crazy as it finally sold for \$507.75. A very nice B-11 Seattle Potlatch brought a high end price of \$190.58 (it was in really nice condition). I was the lucky buyer on the two B-14 Budweiser openers. B-14-72 Anheuser-Busch rarely turns up and this one was near mint. I followed it up the B-14-UL Budweiser from Miles City MT. The last year has seen desirable Canadian beer openers go way up in price if it is somewhat rare. If Cam.Mac wants it, watch out because he will pay any price for it. He has beaten me several times for some of the tougher Canadian openers.

“C” and “D” saw limited action. A couple of crazy bidders ran a C-13-133 Glennons up to almost \$100.00. The

opener is pretty tough but not \$100 tough (more like \$20-30). Your editor did chase after the C-13-UL Eberle from Jackson MI, but those local Michigan collectors won out again. The D-1-9 Strohs brought a strong price as usual. Several “D-1” Stroh openers have been offered and the resulting price is almost always above \$50.00 for the “D-1s”. The D-3-14 Birk Bros is the first one I have seen offered for sale anywhere (Dave Lendy is now the proud owner).

“E” types were pretty hot this past quarter. Two good beer “Es” were sold on eBay, the first being the E-4-248 Cambria and the other being the E-6-212 Freeland. Once again the first time I have seen openers on the market. Grapette soda collectors were obviously very crazy about the E-5 which brought \$124.50. It seemed outrageous to me but then I had not heard of this example before this sale. “F” types were very active especially with the soda brands. The F-3 Barqs, F-4 Coca-Colas (2) and the F-6 Dr Pepper all did well. I really wanted the F-9 Coca-Cola from Leaksville NC but lost out by \$2.00. Thom Thompson has the only one of those that I had seen before. I was more fortunate on the F-30 Coca-Cola but I had to beat out new JFO member, Lee Duncan, for that one. Once again a style I had not seen with advertising Coca-Cola before this one turned up on eBay.

Figural cast iron openers saw several desirables ones sold including three Skulls but none brought really high prices. As with many areas of collectibles this seems to be an up and down area of the market. The FBOC is working hard to recruit new members and I am sure in time figurals will become very popular again.

“G” and “H” had some interesting examples offered. My only problem was that I was outbid on both G-5s, the H-2 Perry and the H-5 Dr Pepper. I got lucky on the H-5-UL Hamms. Before this I had all of the beer H-5s except #20 Cerveza Milwaukee, so I did not want to be missing two of the H-5s. Luckily the Hamms collectors were not that interested. Dave Lendy got beat on the I-7-54 Manhattan. With Todd Milano sparking the continued growth of collecting this style, prices remain high for the more desirable “I-7s” and the Manhattan is very desirable (either one listed in the Handbook).

“K” bar mounts had the usual suspects being sold but then a nice K-12 came on the market and lets just say several Texas Lone Star collectors were beat out by a JFO member at \$361.52. Hard to find this one with the Lone

Star logos in nice condition and with the Cap Pistol attached to the handle rod. The “L-2” and “L-4” markets were rather quiet this past quarter with no rarities (at least beer ones) being sold. One good beer “M-3” was sold, a M-3-40 Deer Park (Green), at \$223.50. The parade of fake M-19 Coca-Cola muddlers continued this quarter. Just a few weeks ago a new seller from the previous two cited the price from Allan Petretti’s Coca-Cola Price Guide (\$250) and sure enough got a \$250.00 bid. Using the picture of Thom Thomspon’s opener and his being an original, his inscription is “Drink Coca-Cola” in a rectangular recess versus all of the fakes which have “Coca-Cola” only in an oval recess area. Will those Coca-Cola collectors ever learn the difference?

Most of the good “N” types sold were soda with the top dog being an N-100 Coca-Cola knife. This is the knife with the changing logo window in the handle. I was fortunate enough to get the N-8-UL Hygeia for \$80.89. I beat out Mike Krejci. He finally got a flat tire trying to run me over. Note the N-11 Coca-Cola shoe horn opener did not meet reserve (I asked and the seller wanted \$250.00).

The “O” types had sales once again dominated by Starr X wall mounts. Prices seem to be stabilizing somewhat for most of these openers. The one that surprised me was the O-502 Coca-Cola only bringing \$405.00. A previous sell on eBay had seen this one go for more than \$800.00. JFO member and Brown Manufacturing owner, David Brimm, was the lucky buyer. “P” corkscrews with beer ads saw many good examples offered and the A-B knives had one really high result. It was a multi-colored handle (green and gold, not the usual red and black) knife in great condition and it brought a great price at \$1,710.00. Don Bull got a real nice P-152-1 Hamms in the original box and I just lost out on the “P” New Discovery Narragansett knife. It was similar to a P-15, but instead of metal handles had celluloid handles with large metal bolsters. It was in great shape also.

Not many times will I talk about my favorite category in this column but the sale of the Q-11 Stoneys was pretty amazing in that it sold for \$37.00. Not so amazing if you watch Western PA openers as many do really well price wise. Unfortunately I did not get enough of the wording to make a UL listing. Maybe in my next lifetime I will collect plastic only. A few good “R”s and I wished I had bid on the next R-44 Coors Bat, but \$36.00 is hard to pay for a recently made opener. I did go deep in buying the

R-14 Coca-Cola opener from Kissimmee FL. It also advertised Willys and Overland Cars, but I wanted it pretty bad. An R-14 is an ugly style opener, but with a Coca-Cola and car ad it was too neat to pass up.

We will end with the world of corkscrews. Don Bull auction of one corkscrew collection seem to bring very good results. A lot of tough corkscrew patents were offered this quarter. Prices certainly varied as the English Beau Brummel roundlets had a wide range in end results. The 1892 Columbian figural round had one bring an average price at \$307 as it was in average condition and then one in really great shape brought \$790.00. Several of the results shown (DNMR) “Did Not Meet Reserve”.

My overall sense for the market is that fewer good openers have been available this past year on eBay but it could be due to the fact that unlike the previous years, a good collection was not sold on eBay. Hopefully 2004 will see a lot of nice openers and corkscrews on the market. The JFO Convention in San Francisco can make your year. Please plan on attending.

Finally from the last issue Joe Young found a patent drawing of a 1960s St. Louis Arch opener. Art Santen responded that he actually owns an example and made contact with one of the men who patented the opener. The man visited the Santen Museum and told Art that only three prototypes were made (3 men were involved in the patent). They found out it cost a lot to produce the opener so they never had any made. Art has one, one of the patentees owned one and there is a rare opener circulating out there somewhere. Thanks Art for the follow-up.

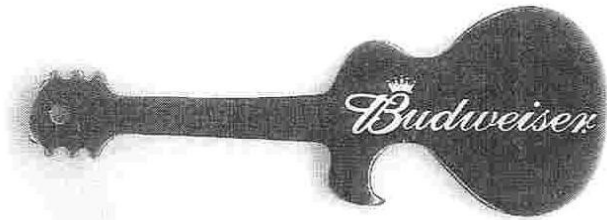

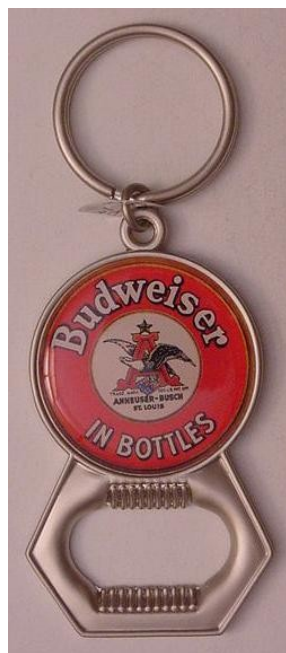

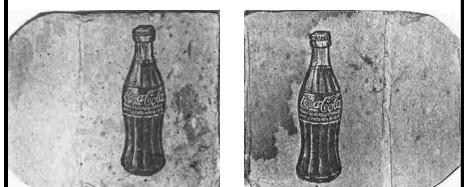
