Displays (Storage)

Our next stop on the display tour is Art Santen's basement. The famous filing system of all beer openers going into envelopes (preferably used envelopes) alphabetically. Both pictures were taken at the 2002 NABA Convention in St. Louis. It was a very hot August day (over 100 degrees) and Art's house has no air conditioning.

Despite the unpleasant conditions, Pat Stambaugh and Dave Lendy (top picture) and myself braved the "opener hell hole" to check out Art's collection. Keep in mind his beer opener filing system is just one small part of his vast opener collection. Many of his opener and corkscrews are in displays in every room of the house.

One would assume with over 15,000 known U. S. beer listings, Art thought this filing system was the best way for him to keep up with what he has in his collection. It was pretty neat to think of a beer or brewery name, find the box with the first letter of the brand on it and then inside find the envelope with full name on it. For those breweries with large numbers of openers, smaller boxes are used and placed inside of the shelving unit large boxes.

Art Santen has a certain individual way of tracking his openers and I must admit I need to follow suit. The only problem is his way is a "storage" not a "display" method.

January to March is usually the best quarter for eBay and this past quarter saw many good openers and corkscrews sold. Bob Kay, “Mr Beer Label”, had collected over the years two trays of choice openers and corkscrews and at the Blue-Gray Show in February had pictures of the openers and saying they would be sold on eBay. The first of March he started selling and by the first of April will have sold the two trays. Many nice openers and many rare ones from Illinois and the highlights are listed in the results.

“A” types had many excellent ones sold this quarter. They were highlighted by the A-9-33 Rainier ballplayer bringing \$116.49. It is certainly one of the tougher A-9s to find. The Canadian collectors fought over an A-17 Lion Head opener from Vancouver Breweries Cascade Beer as it went very high at \$190.00. Once again good Canadian beer openers see lots of action and with the Canadian Beer Handbook the market will only get better for the more desirable examples and especially any openers that are not listed in the book. An excellent example of an A-33-6 Fauerbach brought \$172.50. Since Mike Krejci and I locked horns at the 2001 JFO Convention over a nice example (remember Mike won out at \$200.00), a few A-33-6s have turned up but this is only the third nice example I have seen sold. A nice Medford dog (A-41) sold for \$102.51 and Jeb Burruss got a good buy in an A-42-UL pearl Beer at \$71.01. Two more tough Canadian openers round out the “A”s with an A-46 Kiewels White Seal Beer bringing \$140.00 and for the second time in six months the “White Cap” baseball cap sold for \$151.55 even though the condition of this one was not that good.

Lots of “B”s sold in all styles. The “brass” ones led the way with a B-1-23 Michel bringing \$180.01, a B-1-28 Reno (no paint) bringing \$119.50 and a B-2-14 San Antonio bringing \$180.00. I know Mike Krejci got the B-1 Michel and Bill Arber got the B-2 San Antonio as he closes in on getting all of the B-1s and B-2s (see my Blue-Gray write-up). A collector unknown to me got the B-1 Reno (it came out of Bob Kay’s collection). It should be noted that some of the “brass b’s” have “repainted” as part of the description. Bob Kay had several of his repainted and noted that in his selling ad. The three I saw looked great so if I had needed one of them it would not have slowed me down but seeing the prices that these three brought, it did lower the final results.

Much to my dismay another B-9-8 Augusta turned up. I thought I had the only one and this one brought a very

good price at \$136.49 considering the gas key had been stripped a little. Mike Krejci lost out on the B-11-1 Rainier (Var A) Potlatch opener (sold by Chris Quimby) to a very deep pocketed Northwest collector. The final price of \$355.51 was somewhat warranted as this was probably the nicest condition B-11 I have seen. Lots of B-18s, 19s, 21s, 22s, 23s, and 24s sold as is the usual case with eBay. The only surprise to me though I had seen this one sell for a large price once before was the B-18 soda opener advertising Ozarka Water from Eureka Ark. It was pretty worn but still brought \$63.98. Craig Green got a new discovery soda “B” (again sold by Chris Quimby) from Star Bottling of Pullman, Wash. I was very happy to get the B-32 “Drink Coca-Cola” for \$61.00 as this gave me four different Coca-Cola B-32s. I have seen a fifth one but never any dupes on the B-32 Coca-Cola. This opener came from Bob Kay’s collection.

Good “C”s were not really sold this past quarter but the usual C-12 Hawaii’s were offered as this pile never seems to bottom out. “D” types were highlighted by the D-3-17 Dixie bringing \$66.98. A couple of JFO members battled for this one with Don Lawhorn beating John Patton. Like the “C”s nothing too exciting sold in the “E” types, but an E-4-370 Wyandotte Malt (from Mich.) saw spirited bidding before closing at \$76.00. This could possibly be a record for a “wire” malt opener. “F”s were highlighted by a F-2 Sherman Coca-Cola Bottling Co. spoon bringing \$92.00 (I would say an average price) and a wood handle ice pick advertising Coca-Cola from Texas bringing \$174.77. Condition was off on this one but some serious bidders chased after it. A F-25 is a hard style to find with any kind of ad on it.

Figural cast iron bottle openers were fairly active this quarter with several of the more desirable examples selling. The FBOC-423 Skull was the highlight and brought \$535.50. The figural opener market seems to be up and down and as always remember when reproductions hit a certain collectible it can drive down prices and scare people out of the marketplace (thank you Dale Deckert and may God rest his soul: Dale was a former JFO member who loved to have reproductions made of figural openers).

“G” thru “K” results were not that exciting, though another nice G-10-3 Moerlbach sold for a reasonable price of \$73.77. Good “L-2”s were out in force as Bob Kay sold his collection of 17 “L-2” bottle corkscrews (both beer and non-beer). Dave Lendy swooped in got several

including the key one, a L-2-8 Standard from Chicago. Dave wanted me to pass along that he is trying to collect all known beer L-2s and if you have any available to let him know (just remember that Norm Jay, Gary Deachman, Jim Osborn and your editor also collect this style). Most of Bob’s “L-2”s were in very nice condition and prices seemed to reflect that as Dave raised the ceiling limit on beer “L-2”s from \$300 to \$450. One side note is that Dave did beat out Jim Kaiser on the L-2-9 Strohs. Jim cannot seem to get a break when trying to get this corkscrew for his collection. If anyone has a L-2-9 Strohs and wants to part with it, please contact Jim.

“M” types saw several nice openers sold and were highlighted by a nice M-2-18 Muehlebach bringing \$202.50, a nice M-3-25 Harrison brought \$182.49 (versus a lesser condition one which sold for \$45.44), a M-73-3 Missoula in near mint condition brought \$187.50 and finally a new discovery “M” type Alexandria Brewing of Alexandria, Mn. brought \$192.19 (just like a P-7 but with no corkscrew). The M-25-1 Lemp bringing \$178.92 had a couple of crazy bidders bumping heads as one of these is always for sale on eBay (more like a \$25-\$50 corkscrew). No one would want a quarter to pass without seeing a fake M-19 Coca-Cola muddler selling and this one brought \$95.56 as has been the case lately, the seller claimed it was the original 1948 model.

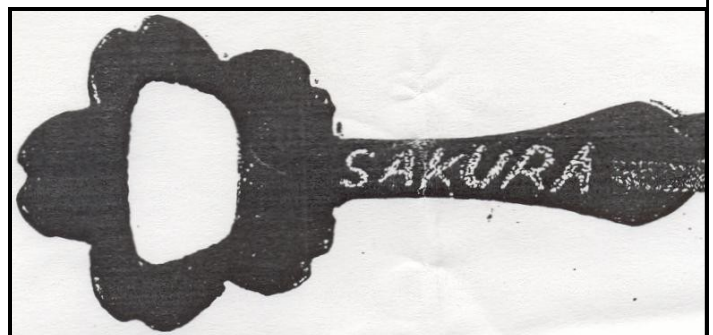
“N”s were a little slow. I did upgrade my N-33-1 Weibel knife at \$90.99 and a couple of new Coca-Cola collectors shot a N-102 Coca-Cola knife up to \$163.50 (worth more in the \$40-\$75 range). Wall mounts were plentiful but nothing too rare sold and highlights were a O-502 Delaware Punch at \$300 (with the Buy-It-Now option), an Icy-O “long neck” Starr at \$258.00, and an O-518 Dr. Pepper at \$178.49. For the most part when it comes to wall mounts, soda openers are king.

To sum up the “P” or corkscrew types in one phrase, it would be “A-B knives”. The Anheuser-Busch boys were obviously never shy about giving these away. Fifteen results are shown for this quarter as long as the handles are not red/black in color or made of steel (the most common handle variations), the highest results are anything but these two styles. Every corkscrew collector must want the P-13-1 Schlitz and from the prices realized, whether the stamping is good or bad, this particular style always brings a good price that is until you get ready to sell yours and instead of \$150-\$250 you are lucky to get \$50. Mike Krejci got a nice twisted wire corkscrew that

is a P-88-UL from the “The Pabst Brewing Co. Washington DC” and at a decent price of \$142.50. Chris Quimby sold another great piece and I was the happy buyer of the “Davis Corkscrew & Knife” advertising “The Pabst Brewing Co. Milwaukee” at \$257.50. The Davis item is fairly hard to find with the knife added and this is the first one I have seen with an ad. It is just like a P-2 but has a single blade knife folding into the handle. Finally a supposedly old P-514 Coca-Cola knife (w/ brass handles) sold for \$500.00. Blades were marked “Kastor” and it looked to be old but the nice condition made me wander.

Sandra Emme is wanting a R-10-1 Sunshine Beer dog figural but must have missed Ray Hanson selling his on eBay for \$100.00. Not a bad price for this pretty rare opener. Once again I thought I had the only R-14 Coca-Cola and Willys Car opener but another one showed up on eBay and brought \$181.39. It is an ugly combination jar, can and bottle opener but it is very unusual to have both Coca-Cola and Willys Car as part of the ad. The opener is from Kissimmee, Fl.

Don Bull conducted three separate corkscrew auctions on eBay of a large collection. Many fine examples were sold and make up several of the corkscrew results. I keep making the same claim each quarter, but if you have a quality corkscrew, it will sell for a good price. For U. S. patents, one can tell when a desirable corkscrew comes on the market as those seem to easily go past the \$2,000 mark. It was a good quarter for any corkscrew collector with deep pockets.



Jack Ford is willing to trade some good US beer openers if anyone has a “Sakura” cast iron opener. Sakura is a Japanese beer. Also Jack is looking for a foreign opener with an ad for “Fiji Bitter”. Jack has a lot of great traders and would appreciate help in getting either of these openers. John Cartwright called a couple of days before the auction started to tell me about the above lot of M-3 Beer sliders. This online auction company (not associated with eBay) required that you register and give two references. That took a day and by then the above lot was closing that night. The rules were unusual but I guess geared towards the midnight owl. The auction closed at 8PM but anyone who had bid on the lot before then could bid on the lot after 8. The auction would end when 30 minutes elapsed with no bids. The other requirement was the high bid had to be raised by 10 percent. I had bid \$1275 on the lot and was high bidder at \$900 and change at 8PM. The other strange rule was before 8PM you raise the lot by 10 or 20 percent but no more. I wasn't going to stay up until midnight and of course lose out as the lot went for \$1,402.00 (plus you had to add a 17.5% buyers premium).

The Sardi's Restaurant, the Alaka Laquer, and a before now unknown The Dark Horse (with a pic of a Horse). Obviously Roger Steckler had an eye for quality. If anyone knows who got the lots, how about letting me know. An ad for the auction ran in the ABA Journal, but as usual I forgot about it until Cartwright called. The auction company did mail a complete catalog a few days after the auction ended. Some nice sliders found a new home!
