P-80 Froedtert Malt Corkscrew & Bottle Opener

I often wondered what Froedtert Malt was and who made it. Thank God for Google. I discovered that Froedtert Malt was a product of the Froedtert Malt and Grain Co. of Milwaukee, WI.

Back in the 1950's it was the largest producer of malt in the world. The president of the company was Kurtis R. Froedtert. When he died in 1951 he left an endowment of 11 million dollars to build the Froedtert medical complex in Milwaukee. It has quite a fine reputation in the upper mid-west.

The corkscrew is somewhat unique in that it incorporates a bottle opener on the lower portion on both sides of the cage. I suspect that it was patented. I believe that it is American but I have yet to find a patent for it.

One side of the cage is marked FROEDTERT and the other side of the cage is marked MALT.

In Bob Roger's newest book on Ice-Reducing tools I noticed on pages 162-163 William F. Paradise's patent for a **mumble peg toy and ice pick**. It is US patent #1,956,875 issued on May 1, 1934. Does anyone remember playing mumbly peg as a kid? I do, but we played it with a jack knife.

After seeing the patent (right) I remembered a similar piece in our corkscrew/bottle opener collections.

The piece pictured at the top was a gift from Vic Keown at the JFO Convention in Frankenmuth, MI, April 22, 1989. Since then, we have acquired another similar piece. Both pieces have advertising for ice.

The photo below shows our second piece. Both of our two mumble peg toy/ice picks have elongated wooden handles which incorporate a Williamson corkscrew/bottle opener in the opposite end.

I had wondered if these two pieces were ever patented. Now I know-- but not as a corkscrew/bottle opener but as a mumble peg toy. I just thought you would like to know.

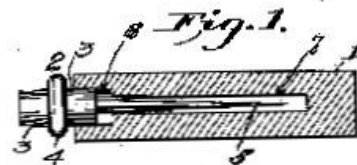
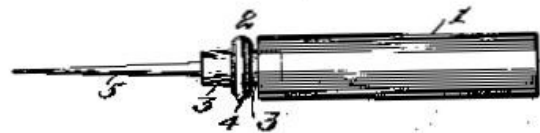

“Opener and eBay Trivia”

In the July results an E-1-25 Lancaster opener's result was shown and it should have been listed as an E-3-25 Wacker.

The July to September quarter on eBay was strong but not as strong as the previous quarter. In an effort to change this column I will just report on the really top sellers as everyone can peruse the results for the general items. Normally I list results that bring at least \$10.00 and I consider somewhat rare. The results also show many common items that bring good price results. I have considered adding a one to five ranking system for “rarity” with one being common and five being rare. It is possible I might add a one to five scale for “desirability” also. If members prefer that I do this please let me know.

Highlights of the last three months included two Coca-Cola “A-4”s (lady shaped) from previously unknown towns from Fort Worth, Tx. and Dayton, Oh. bringing \$263.89 and \$275.00 respectively. The one thing that amazes me is how many unlisted beer and soda openers still turn up. A Coca-Cola opener was the other “A” highlight with an “A-20” (fish spinner) bringing \$504.25. Many examples of this opener have been found over the years and many have been sold on eBay. This example was very good at best and most found are excellent or better. A fair price for this one would have been \$75.00 to \$100.00.

Something I had never noticed before but was caught by the Minnesota collectors was a B-2-6 Hamms with a blue not black logo and it brought \$282.77. Tennessee collectors chased hard after a B-18-102 Gerst Beer from Nashville as it closed at \$162.50. Coca-Cola openers showed their sometime volatility with one B-42 bringing \$75.00 and it was followed by one bringing \$171.38. Timing can be everything on eBay and selling in the summer usually requires more luck than other times during the year.

A nice C-2-4 Silver Top Beer in a lot with a B-23-7 Duquesne and an E-14-63 Duquesne brought \$124.50. One trend you see is that painted openers continue to be very collectible. The one notable “E” was an E-9-UL bought by Larry Moter on a BIN (Buy-It-Now) for \$95.00. Right now a rare and one of a kind opener. Cast Iron Figural openers saw some good sales, a FBOC-034 Beanie Bert bringing \$750.00, but overall prices were moderate witnessed by a FBOC-418 Winking Boy not meeting reserve at \$610.00.

A couple of “H”s are worth noting with a common H-2-71 Queen City bringing \$100.00 and an “H-2” Dr. Pepper

King of Beverages bringing \$280.50. I am not sure what the fuss was about over the Queen City but normally a \$2.00 to \$10.00 opener at best. I sold my H-2 Dr. Pepper last year on a BIN for \$125.00 and it looks like I left a chunk of money on the table. About five examples of this opener have sold on eBay and prices go from \$75.00 to \$300.00 so hard to figure. Someone got a nice buy in a K-12-1 Lone Star for \$183.05 as a few recently had been in the \$300.00 to \$600.00 range. Maybe too many have turned up in the market place?

A couple of “L-1”s (painted cans) sold well. A L-1-3 Coors brought \$102.50 and a foreign one, a L-1 Barclay's Pilsner Lager (English), brought \$159.06. High prices but a lot of collectors like this style. Sliders were so-so this quarter with the one notable being a M-3-36 Piels (two colors) bringing \$169.49. Moving on to the brass muddlers or “M-19”s you will notice I have “Fantasy” in several of the descriptions. Several before now unknown soda brands have been offered on eBay and it is very strange that these had never been seen before. They sure do look to be cousins of the fake M-19 Coca-Cola opener. Buyer Beware!!!

“N” types were highlighted by a Coca-Cola shoehorn from Waterloo, Ia. bringing \$203.73, three Coca-Cola pencils with openers, “N-22”s, bringing \$277.72 and the other two at \$200.00 each on BINs (Buy-It-Now). On the beer front a nice N-43-UL Primo Hawaiian beer brought \$216.49. Finally someone has been selling “N-5” shoe-shaped knives with ads for Shiner Beer. They look to be of recent vintage so be careful and don't pay very much for one of these (\$10.00 to \$20.00 would be fair).

Wall mounts were pretty average this quarter and the one highlight was an O-516 Starr with a corkscrew and just the “Starr” ad bringing \$227.75. Beer corkscrews or “P” types witnessed three good sales in the knife department with a P-26-UL Anheuser-Busch blue steel handles bringing \$1,225.00, a P-26-8 Anheuser-Busch with Red and Blue handles bringing \$798.00 and a P-149-1 Bergner & Engel with a viewable Stanhope bringing \$416.78. One unusual result was a P-48 Nick Williams Whiskey cigar cutter knife bringing \$237.90. Something a couple of bidders wanted real bad and one I would have passed on at \$25.00.

A nice Cast Iron Figural R-6-2 Sprenger wall mount brought \$400.00 in an eBay live auction. Corkscrews saw two examples bring the top prices this quarter. One was an English Henshall with a removable corkscrew that brought \$6,215.00 and the top seller was an 1882 U. S. Pitt Patent

in average condition that brought \$8,270.00. Certainly one of the more desirable U. S. patented corkscrews for collectors. It was another overall good quarter for corkscrews and prices remain strong and especially for rare or top quality pieces.

The first and last of August I attended two national shows. In early August it was NABA Convention in Bay City, Mi. Thanks to a recent collection purchase by Norm Jay I did add a few openers to the collection. Opener traffic was okay but nothing great except for Norm’s room. He will have most of this collection in St. Louis next April. NABA always has lots of JFO members in attendance and Bay City was no exception.

The end of August I attended the BCCA Convention in Denver, Co. Openers were brought by a few collectors but the most by far was brought by John Cartwright. He flew in from Paso Robles, Ca. and had a great selection of beer

and soda openers for sell. As always we managed to do some wheeling and dealing. I got to meet a couple of Jeb Burruss’s trading buddies from Texas, Charlie Staats (see Jay-Cee Bar Mount Article January 2007 JFO) and Jaime Pina. Once again it was nice turnout by the JFO community.

The one theme I heard at these two shows and have for some time now is that most of the “small” collectibles end up on eBay. It is just too easy to sit home and sell that way. I will say it is easy to stay home but selling on eBay takes time and effort. I have been listing 10 items per week for two months it takes about four hours a week by the time I take pictures, write up the listings, send out invoices and package the items that sell after the auction closes. Overall the results are good, sometimes great and sometimes fair. eBay has become the primary market place for openers and corkscrews.
