## "Opener and eBay Trivia"

So much for saying eBay has been slow. Especially the past month many good beer openers have been offered for sale. Corkscrews have been slow as far as good quality pieces are concerned. Something that always helps the openers on eBay is when a collection is offered for sale and Bob McNary's collection is being offered along with some select pieces from Bill McKienzie's old collection. Lots of good openers were offered by many different sellers.
Maybe those new eBay rules aren't so bad. Maybe the bad economy is forcing people to sell those "cherry" items. Its looks like a lot of JFO members will have a good Christmas.

Leading the way this quarter for "A" types were an A-17 Dr. Pepper (offered in an eBay Live Auction) and a A-45UL Griesedieck Bros. St. Louis. The A-17 sold with a B24 Dr. Pepper opener and realized $\$ 350.00$ and the A-45 sold for $\$ 324.99$ and bought by Jim Osborn as he closes in on having all of the "A" types with beer advertising. The A-45 came off of Bill McKienzie's 1988 JFO Display from the St. Louis convention that won Bill second place. A nice A-15-UL German-American from Buffalo brought $\$ 120.49$ and a nice A-17-30 Gund from LaCrosse, Wis. brought $\$ 128.05$. Two Medford Lager dogs (A-41s) sold on either end of the price guide range with the first bringing $\$ 128.00$ and the second selling for $\$ 61.02$. Two A-591 Providence "Hand Holding the Bottle" openers did the same thing bringing $\$ 198.05$ and $\$ 103.50$ but the cheaper one was not in that good of shape.

Many "B" s as usual sold but the only good highlights were again an eBay Live Auction of Dr.Pepper openers in one lot with this one having five openers (A-29, B-13, B-14, H$2 \& \mathrm{M}-3$ ) and sold for $\$ 200.00$. Actually a pretty good buy. I have seen the $\mathrm{H}-2$ sell in the $\$ 300.00$ range. I lost the battle for the B-22-94 Haehnle as it sold to a family member for $\$ 136.49$. The first time I had seen one for sale. Nothing of note in the "C" category and the "D"s saw two interesting sales both involving D-3-22 Roessle openers from Boston. One sells for $\$ 123.50$ and the second one closing two days later brings only $\$ 19.49$, go figure. A fair market value is $\$ 15.00-\$ 25.00$ depending on how bad you want one. The two most interesting "E"s were both ULs, an E-6 Crystal Brew from Mid-City Bev. Co. (a couple of us were trying to decide if this was from Michigan or where from?) and an E-9 from Cumberland Brewing Co. from Cumberland, Md. The E-6 sold for $\$ 61.99$ and the E9 for $\$ 56.00$.

Dr. Pepper continued the nice lots being offered with an
"F" lot that included a F-2, F-5 and F-17 with the lot realizing $\$ 150.00$ in another eBay Live Auction. These Dr. Pepper lots had to be someone's collection as they included a lot of hard to find styles. Another Bill McKienzie opener sold, a F-21-1 Walters, and brought $\$ 65.00$ (it went to my collection). I thought I was doing good in the "F"s when I got a nice F-12-3 Diamond Spring for $\$ 8.00$ and tried to follow it up by buying the F-12-1 Cleveland \& Sandusky but someone ran me over in a wheelchair from Bloomington, Il. Oh well maybe next time.

Nothing very exciting sold in the "G"s, "H", "I" or "J"s and the " K "s saw one good sale (for the seller anyway) of a $\mathrm{K}-14-1$ Drewrys at $\$ 150.00$. In the " L " types the first notable was a bottle shaped with the opener dropping out of the bottom and a supposedly legit label advertising Spearman Brewing Co. of Pensacola, Fl. The seller, airborne306, is the same guy who sells the N-5 "Fantasy" knives with decal stickers put on the handle plus several other styles. The person obviously has lots of blank openers and decals. Its "buyer beware". At least 24 L-2-1 Anheuser-Busch bottle corkscrews sold this quarter from a high of $\$ 81.90$ to a low of $\$ 22.75$. Remember it's not a rare opener, worth $\$ 20.00$ to $\$ 25.00$. Also note the non-beer "L-2"s continue to sell well.

A few of the tougher " $\mathrm{M}-3$ "s sold and brought respectable prices. The high selling "M-3" this quarter was a nonbeverage one for Victory Coat, Apron and Linen Supply Co. bringing $\$ 205.02$. Lots of "M-19"s sold and lots of "M -25 " Lemps sold as well. Please note several fake or fantasy soda "M-19"s are still in the market place. The supply seems to be endless. A couple of nice "M-73"s sold with a M-73-13 Heurich leading the way at $\$ 211.08$ (thanks Bob Post for the little boost in price). I thought I might sneak in and get a desirable Coca-Cola " N -11" shoe horn opener selling in a pile with nine other common Coca-Cola openers but it went towards the top end of it's value selling at \$191.48.

The beer "N"s were led by a N-78-1 Gold Top selling for $\$ 107.50$ when the picture on eBay looked better than the opener actually was. Still a hard opener to locate and the condition was better than average. Wall mounts saw an O-4-UL Progress Beer sell for $\$ 86.00$ (Bob Stahly was a strong second place to yours truly). The biggest price spread of the quarter saw an 0-5-6 Jax sell first for $\$ 165.50$, then for $\$ 102.50$ and finally for 99 cents! All three were good condition but eBay proves once again, "it all depends who is watching when something sells." The O
$-5-6$ Jax is fairly common and is worth much closer to 99 cents than the two high prices.

The leading Starr-X "O-5" was a nice condition O-5-39 Schlitz selling for $\$ 460.00$ to Bob Ritter who happens to be selling an opener wall mount book on eBay. Bob Stahly is still looking for this Schlitz Opener to complete his "O-5"s. A non-beer "O-5" Pelco did well selling for $\$ 202.50$. The Coca-Cola "Hoof" wall mount that has been selling for $\$ 50.00$ to $\$ 75.00$ saw two sell this quarter for over $\$ 200.00$ each. Must be some new blood just wanted the style. I felt lucky to get an O-516 Starr X (on the neck) ad opener for $\$ 36.65$. The two previously selling examples both brought over $\$ 200.00$ each on eBay.

Beer "P"s saw many nice examples sell on eBay but of note were two "P-19"s from my home state of North Carolina. One advertised "Pride of North Carolina" whiskey from Hamlet, N. C. and brought $\$ 155.00$ and the other from my hometown of Winston-Salem advertising "The Casper Co." and it brought $\$ 113.00$. Nice prices for some good "wood" pieces. Jeb Burruss got another nice Bill McKienzie St. Louis corkscrew, a P-73-2 Anthony \& Kuhn, for the good price of $\$ 86.21$. A nice type to own, a R-4-1 Iroquois "Lighter", sold for a very reasonable $\$ 87.00$ (from the Bob McNary Collection).

It seems with the ICCA Auctions (see ad next column), not as many nice corkscrews are being offered on eBay. Highlights this quarter were a U. S. Chinnocks 1863 Patent Iron T-Handle selling for $\$ 2,504.79$ and a U. S. $20^{\text {th }}$ Century Syroco Golden Knight selling for $\$ 2,738.00$. Corkscrew selling like openers goes and comes in cycles and with many corkscrew club members going to the CCCC Convention in Chattanooga, Tn . and with the ICCA Convention being the following week in Williamsburg, Va. (hosted by JFO Member, Paul Luchsinger), I would assume they were saving the "good stuff" for these two conventions and not selling on eBay.

Despite its many new rules and policies, eBay is still the best source for openers in general and for the most part corkscrews (unless Don Bull is selling a collection). As we go to press only the second known M-3-42 Seitz "slider" in very nice condition is being offered for sale. It will be interesting to report the results in January. Keep looking, happy bidding and hopefully happy results unless you are going against the "old redhead". Shame on you Bill Hanold for running over me with your wheel chair. Its sure beat getting hit by Krejci's truck!
