2010 JFO Convention #32 April 14-18 San Antonio TX

Three months and counting until JFO 32 starts. The hotel is a little more than usual but San Antonio has much to offer. It is really a great town for a vacation and the La Quinta on Blum Street is at heart of the action. Just about anything you want to do is within walking distance. The Alamo is only three blocks away and the Riverwalk is nearby plus this is a "pet friendly" hotel (Jazzy and Snazzy will be attending). Jeb Burruss, your official Texas host, has most of the local breweriana collectors at least stopping by for a visit and several may stay a night or two (so plan on bringing any good Texas beer items). Most importantly you need to make hotel reservations as you can always cancel and getting in this year at the last minute may be hard to do. I am really thinking a lot of our Northern members need a nice break from all of the snow and cold weather from this winter.

We are sticking to the usual schedule with a couple of new wrinkles. Wednesday and Thursday are for checking in and room-to-room trading. The hospitality room should be available by early afternoon on Wednesday. Sometime Friday afternoon we will have a short auction and this year (one of the changes) have the display contest at that time. Most of the day Friday will also be devoted to room-to-room and visiting in the hospitality room. The other change for this year is the Saturday Public Show will be held in conjunction with the Lone Star Chapter show at the Spoetzl Brewery in Shiner, Texas. Shiner is about two hours from San Antonio and the plan is to bus members with their table wares to Shiner. We are hoping to have everyone loaded and on the road by 7:30AM Saturday morning. Tables will be provided and setup is around a park area in front of the brewery. The Lone Star Chapter usually has 20-25 members setup with a good public crowd so this should be a great venue for JFO. The show should last until about 2PM and then we will bus back to the hotel. The brewery will offer a couple of tours for interested parties and 5 tokens for free beer samples. A new show format for JFO but show space rental being at a premium at many hotels this was our best option for 2010. The local collectors promise us a great time. So make your plans to be there for 2010!!!

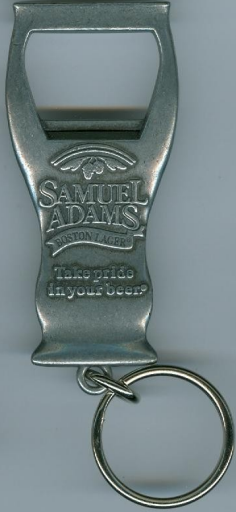

“Opener and eBay Trivia”

On the front page of the October newsletter I asked for members' opinion about the “A-19 alligator” figural bottle opener. Could it actually be something else figural wise. I received no responses so we will leave it as an “Alligator” for now.

Since I am making newsletter changes I might as well switch the format for “Opener and eBay Trivia”. In an effort to simplify the process a little I will list below some of the key results for the quarter and make a few comments.

A-009-999, Coca-Cola In Bottles (Fair), \$256.28

Someone actually sold a “real” A-9 Coca-Cola baseball player opener. It was rusty but readable and brought a good price considering how many fakes are sold.

A-021-8UL, Pioneer Beer Aberdeen WA, \$210.38

Craig Green set a record for an A-21 spinner opener. This opener came from the former Bill MuGrage collection. Now I have to wonder about my big screw-up for 2009. I mailed an A-21-148 Primo to Jack Ford in November. I taped the opener between two pieces of cardboard and sent it in a regular envelope. Jack got the letter but no opener. I do wonder what it would sell for on eBay (Primo collectors pay crazy prices). Jack I promise to never try that stunt again.

A-999-999, Harley-Davidson Motorcycle Spinner, \$777.00

The “Trucker”, Mike Krejci, knew I would comment on this one as he had given me grief at the 2007 JFO Convention in Harrisburg, Pa. for telling a local report this one was worth \$800-\$1000. I was a “little” over but a couple of Harley collectors went crazy over this one.

B-018-8UL, Roslyn Brewing Co Roslyn Wash, \$102.51

Another Craig Green purchase from the Bill MuGrage collection. Bill had the only known example and the first JFO opener of any kind from this brewery. By now you must know that Craig loves Washington beer openers.

B-023-8UL, Joliet Citizens Brewing Co, \$102.59

John Bitterman, “Mr. Joliet”, is now the proud owner of this B-23-UL. Outside of Norm Jay having half of the Joliet openers he needs, John does not get many chances to add to his collection.

E-004-014, Blatz, \$100.99

Larry Moter and I discussed the price realized on this

opener and it defied logic. It is not common but certainly not rare. Just two collectors battling over something they wanted real bad.

F-030-999, Coco-Cola Beaufort SC (Sold as Coca-Cola) (Rusty), \$521.88

An interesting piece to say the least. At first glance you think it is Coca-Cola but no it is “Coco-Cola”. Most likely a competitor to the Coca-Cola brand. This one was sold as Coca-Cola advertising and I know the high bidder returned it because it does not say Coca-Cola. The other interesting thing about this buttonhook piece is the opener end has no frets. With some effort you can open a bottle but it really appears to be for use as a buttonhook only. (I sold my example which until this one appeared I thought was the only one known for \$300 a couple of weeks ago. The buyer was happy but was concerned with the item not having frets).

H-002-999, Coca-Cola Roanoke VA Coca-Cola Bottling Works (Good), \$124.83

One I bought on eBay for Dick Friedman (he is not a PayPal user). It was a little rough condition wise but a very hard to find Virginia soda opener. There is also a nice Pepsi-Cola H-2 from Roanoke that is the mate to this one.

L-002-009, Strohs (EX), \$214.49

L-002-016, Budweiser Schlitz (Good), \$316.77

L-002-020, Texas, \$410.99

L-2 bottle corkscrews were hot this quarter. The Strohs turn up fairly often and is almost always in great shape (a small find was made about 20-25 years ago). The L-2-16 actually saw three examples sold with the other two bringing \$98 and \$116. This one also has seen several examples found but is tough to find in really nice condition. Jeb Burruss is the happy owner of the L-2-20 Texas which I will assume will be on display at the JFO Convention. It is the fourth one I have seen. A very hard L-2 to find.

M-019-999, Dr Pepper Good For Life (Fantasy), \$131.05

I could have listed many M-19s but most of the soda ones are fantasy openers including this Dr. Pepper opener. Its' one thing if you can get these for under \$30 but paying over \$100 is just throwing money away. There seems to be an endless supply of the “fantasy” M-19 soda openers. They are just like the “L” type drop down bottle shapes with labels glued on them. One seller on eBay has all of the make believe “L” U. S. Beer ones. What are the odds of that happening in today's market. Only one person has them for sale. It is always “buyer beware”.

M-073-999, 1934 Chicago WFs, \$181.60

This slider/corkscrew opener has always been considered the easiest ad to find in the M-73 style. A lucky seller got double what this one usually goes for. With all of the publicity on “sliders” they have continued to be a hot collectible area and I am sure the trend will continue for many years to come.

N-063-999, A-B Refrigerators (Pen Blade w/ No Opener), \$406.20

The knife sold was not the N-63 with an opener blade but just a regular blade. Usually this knife without the opener blade sells for \$100-\$150 but two collectors bumped heads and drove the price way up. These are numbered on the back and maybe this one had a low number and I missed seeing that part of the listing.

N-148-8UL, Du Bois Brewing Du Bois PA, \$27.26 N-148-8UL, Du Bois Brewing Du Bois PA Buffalo NY Newark NJ, \$10.52

One thing that continues to amaze me is an Unlisted opener turns up and then shortly thereafter a second example turns up. We did not have a Du Bois N-148 listed before and within a month two different ULs are offered on eBay. I was the winner of both openers (Pat note the small amounts I paid). I would have all of the known N-148s but ended up trading one to Dave Lendy and selling one of the Erie, Pa. beer ones back when I only had a few of them.

O-008-999, Dr Pepper Good For Life, \$136.49

Talk about being lucky. A seller had one of these Dr. Pepper wall mounts and sold it last quarter for \$65. I missed seeing the auction until it had closed. He puts a second example up and yes my \$133.99 bid got beat. Oh well if they made two there has to be more. Well the seller emails me and says he found four and I can have the last two for \$70 each. I felt lucky in one way but did wonder if he had only found four or was it a lot more?

P-026-001, Anheuser-Busch (Pearl Handles) (EX), \$599.00

P-038-001, Anheuser-Busch (Refurbished), \$336.51

Again many A-B knives are selling but I am seeing a few of the “refurbished” knives being sold. They have replaced stanhopes and/or blades. They look nice but not worth some of the premium prices they sell for on eBay. The P-26-1 was a nice knife and \$599 is in the neighborhood for a good buy. The P-38-1 is hard to find nice with both stan-

hopes intact and maybe the selling price of \$336.51 is not bad but still a lot of money for a reconditioned knife.

Z-Corkscrew, US 20thC Syroco Golden Knight, \$2,026.00

Some decent corkscrew results this quarter but the numbers of really good ones being sold on eBay has slowed down (remember to check out the I. C. C. A. auctions). The Syroco “Golden Knight” has seen many examples sell in the \$2,500 to \$3,000 price range and this one sold for \$2,026. Maybe a decrease in price with so many examples being sold over the last few years on eBay. It is one of the corkscrews that most corkscrew collectors want to have in their collection. If you need one be prepared to step up to the plate.

Overall this past quarter was fairly good. Some really good ones but no nice collections and lots of low end openers were sold on eBay. I just keep thinking the bad economy would turn loose a bunch of good openers but so far it is not happening. Maybe everyone is saving then up for San Antonio!



I already owned the top B-1 Electro-Chemical Engraving Co. opener when I recently bought the bottom opener. It is brass and I assumed a “twin” to the top one. The address on the top opener is Suite 511 90 West St. while on the bottom opener it is Suite 1116 90 West St. The office obviously moved down the hallway. Does anyone else have any B-1 Electro-Chemical Engraving openers?

The other noticeable difference is the bottom opener almost looks like “CA.” instead of “GA.”. The “G” is stamped lightly.



A CBO (cigar box opener) Bars & Blade style #15 sold recently by Ben Hoffman on eBay for \$61.99. The unusual part with this fairly common style CBO is the ad which is for the “Coco-Cola Bottling Works Alliance, Ohio”. Does anyone have any information on Coco-Cola (note not Coca-Cola) Company???

As a partner to Ben’s CBO on the previous page is the above F-30 “Coco-Cola Bottling Co. Beaufort, S. C. phone 24 B. / Order a crate to day.” I sold the above “opener” on eBay a couple of weeks ago for \$300.00. A Coca-Cola collector bought it and was happy to get it. The comment he made was the opener has no frets, so could it really open a bottle? I never tried to open one and he was just happy with it being a buttonhook. He made no comment about it being Coco-Cola. A rusty version sold on eBay in early December for \$521.88. But it was sold as a Coca-Cola opener. Does anyone have any information or another F-Style which appears to be an opener but does not have frets???

At the right is a hard to find CBO style (RND-10) with a paper label insert in the handle and ad for “Greenville Cigar Mfg. Co.” It sold last fall for \$181.00 on eBay.

Paper labels on these turn-of-the-century CBOs are hard to find and even harder to find with the label in decent condition. Do any members have examples they would like to share?

Joe Young sent in the photos and write-up below. Does anyone have any information on this unusual corkscrew???

Attached some interesting photos of a most unusual wine bottle holder and corkscrew. I believe it is from the Arts & Crafts period (1875-1920). The piece is not marked anywhere that I can see. I believe it is made of mahogany - it has a unique construction secured with pegs - no nails, screws or other metal devices. The base measures 10 x 6 inches and it is 21 inches high. As you can see, we have disassembled the screw mechanism in a couple of the photos so you can get a better idea of how it is supposed to work. Have you seen anything like it? It was found in the States and I believe it to be American made. The Arts and Crafts movement had its heyday around the turn of the nineteenth century -- William Morris, an Englishman, is credited as a prime mover in England. Roycroft and the Stickley brothers are familiar Arts and Crafts names here in America.
