2011 JFO Convention #33 April 27-May 1 Cedar Rapids Iowa

The 33rd JFO convention at the Marriott Hotel in Cedar Rapids, Iowa is progressing nicely. Cedar Rapids, Ia. is a great central location for the JFO membership. The hotel offers a free shuttle service for anyone flying (just call the hotel when you arrive and they will send a van, about 15 minutes away). The convention schedule is still tentative, but the early planned schedule is as follows. Wednesday and Thursday will be for checking-in and room-to-room trading. Scott Williams wants Friday to be devoted to visiting the Amana Colonies. We could carpool 25 miles through the countryside to the village of Amana, stop at the Heritage Museum for a 20 minute orientation, and turn people loose to explore and shop for an hour or two. They could visit Millstream Brewing, wineries, a woolen mill, furniture shop, meat shop, artists, antiques and so forth. Most of the buildings are from the 1850's. Friday is also the first day of Maifest, but there will not be mobs of people until Saturday. At a designated time, we could regroup at a restaurant for lunch. Following this, Scott & Ursula would host the group at their home 2 miles away in Middle Amana before heading back to Cedar Rapids.

Late Friday afternoon or early that evening we could have our small auction in the hospitality room. This year's hospitality room has a large connecting room that will hold 10 to 12 tables and we will use for the main hospitality room, the Friday auction and for the Saturday show we will have the 10-12 tables set up in this room and then 15-20 will be outside the hospitality room in an atrium area. This was the only way we could afford to have the show as they wanted a show room charge plus a \$25 per table charge to use a dedicated show area. The Saturday show will run from 8AM to 1PM.

Saturday evening we have a group dinner at a place to be determined for anyone staying that night. Please make your plans to attend and make your hotel reservations now. Cedar Rapids will be a great convention, BE THERE!!!

I first checked my copy of Who's Who in Brew. There was not a listing. I then went to the update section and found a listing for the G. Heileman Brewing in the mid 30's.

Next I went looking for a copy of The Pilsner from the Chicagoland Breweriana Society. I remembered reading something about the brand in that publication. I found the Spring 2002 issue. There was a listing for the brand from the Peter Hand Brewery. There were pictured coasters and napkins advertising the brand.

Next I hunted up my copy of Brewed With Style-The Story of The House of Heileman. There the brand was listed as a prohibition brand of G.Heileman. I have a "B" style opener with that brand that I believe to be from Heileman, since King of Clubs was a brand of Peter Hand in the 50's and the opener I would think is more from the 30's era.

Next a little about my escapades the last few months. First off, just before JFO I drove to Green Bay for the Packer Chapter (BCCA) show. I didn't find any openers, but got to see Larry Moter and Pat Stambaugh. And a LOT of beer cans.

Then on June 12 it was a 200 mile drive over to Bloomington, MN for the ABA show. Who else but Pat Stambaugh did I see! (I think it was at NABA I was telling John about how I end up with two of so many openers he

said my nickname should be Noah!) John Mlady was there as well as Don Williams. I had a nice visit with all three. John and I talked about the O-14 Storz opener. I have one in mint shape, but missing the metal opener part. So does John, soooo if anyone has a spare or two we'd like to hear from you. ABA was where I picked up my copy of Who's Who in Brew from the author along with a long list of new additions.

Finally on Aug 4 it was a 67 mile drive to Stevens Point for a visit with John Stanley at NABA. We had talked about a trade on the phone just before the show, well John came thru on his end but it took me several hours over a period of days to find my end of the deal and mail it to him. I added the P-169 Blatz to my collection. I also picked up a nice A-38 Blatz, B-18 Hillsboro and traded two ND's for a nice K-8 Schlitz. I knew I had a K-8 that had a less than mint tag, but when I got home I discovered mine was the black base and the one from John was grey. So I now have the two colors. Friday evening I got to see Norm Jay, Larry Moter and yup, Pat Stambaugh!

I picked up a mint E-4-101 American Brewing from Norm. On Saturday I drove back for the public show and Norm talked me into buying a H-4-2 Drink Prima. Now I have the two H-4 Prima's. From Larry I got an E-4-198 Tacoma, E-4-195 Standard and an E-4-60 Miami Valley.

Marc attended the convention and I had told him about Dale Deckert, a fellow JFO collector from Florida, having some figural openers that might be of interest. Dale had a flat cast iron figural animal that Marc needed to complete his set of six. They worked a deal out and the thing I remember most is both men calling me up and telling how they just made a great trade and they both thanked me for getting the two of them together. You just never know. None of the openers involved in the deal were worth much in my book, but two collectors left a trade with both being extremely happy. It is what collecting is all about. Spouse's Corner

(Note: this was written before our annual trip to San Francisco) By Pat Stanley, the Editor's Spouse

Since going to San Francisco is an annual event for John and myself, I decided to surf some to explore some of the breweries in the City by the Bay. My first search brought me the following stop to spend time with. This pub captured my heart so much that other pubs would "pale" in comparison, so I had to expand my search to other interests.

San Francisco Brewing Company was the first to catch my attention. I like to keep the topics of my quarterly addition to the newsletter secret until finished, so I can't ask John if the JFO group has been to this brewery. I do know one thing after reading about it, I want to see it!!

I am not a history buff as is John, but I found their history to be fascinating. The complete history can be enjoyed at <http://www.sfbrewing.com/history/history.html>.

This company started in 1907 as Andromeda Saloon. The 49'ers, and later Barbary Coast inhabitants that frequented the saloon lacked respect until 1913 when Jack Dempsey gained employment there. Rumor is that in 1939 Baby Face Nelson, was captured here by the FBI.

The Saloon survived prohibition by serving food and changing it's name to the Andromeda Café. Alcohol was served "purely for medicinal purposes".

While opened as a Café, the bar's mahogany woodwork received its first of many coats of paint. Fortunately in 1977 two local restaurateurs completed a major restoration to bring it back to life.

I look forward to seeing all the beautiful mahogany and beveled glass in this showcase. There is one solid mahogany plank that runs the entire length of the bar. Above the bar is a famous fan, run by a tiny motor with leather belts. San Francisco Brewing Company was born in 1985 when the founder and brewmaster, Allan G. Paul opened it as the first brew pub in San Francisco when only three other pubs existed in the nation.

Besides the games guests can play at the pub - darts, chess, backgammon, cards or dice cups, the San Francisco Brewing Company offers a variety of adventures including an annual race and salmon fishing trip.

You must check out their website to learn how their approach to brewing distinguishes them from other breweries. So John, let's go visit the San Francisco Brewing Company near where Chinatown, North Beach and the Financial District all intersect. A romantic lunch there will be a highlight to our next San Francisco Adventure. A t-shirt from there is on my shopping list. (Much to my dismay, it is closed.)

It's a hard act to follow after such a classy pub, so I best switch to something that has at least as much class or more, the topic of wine. And of course, I must continue with my interest in California.

Although I'm not allowed to use corkscrews from John's showcases to open some fine wine, I want to learn more about this sophisticated drink.

Drinking beer at the San Francisco Brewing Company portrays one as full of fun and laughter, someone who enjoys the company of friends. Sipping on wine portrays one as intellectual, enjoying a reflective conversation with scholars.

California should be a perfect place to learn more about the finer things in life as it is the fourth largest wine producer in the world, selling \$18.5 billion in retail wine. 90 percent of American wine comes from this state.

Spouse's Corner (continued)

One website lists 10 Reasons to Love CA Wine. Some of my favorites include the fact that the state offers many choices for wine drinkers because of the diverse growing regions, soils, climates, winemaking styles and people. The wineries provide some beautiful places for tourists to visit (we saw some of them on our last trip to San Francisco and they were indeed beautiful as well as fascinating). And women play a critical role in this industry....well, don't we in "all" industries.

Perhaps I should first google on the Wine Institute for it has more than 1,000 California wineries and affiliated businesses.

The Wine Institute was established in 1934. It is the voice for California wine to serve as an advocate for responsible production, consumption and enjoyment of wine. It provides leadership for sustainable winegrowing and winemaking practices.

Go to this website <http://www.discovercaliforniawine.com/learn/learn> to learn how to read a CA Wine Label and lots of other lessons.

This site gives some fun wine facts. By this year, the United States is expected to become the No.1 wine market in the world. Things have improved since Lucille Ball stomped on grapes!!

More than 20 million people visit California wine country each year. A barrel of wine equals 24.6 (12-bottle) cases of wine. One vine only produces 4-6 bottles of wine. Approximately 2.8 pounds of grapes are used to make one bottle of wine.

We have some upscale places to purchase wine in our area, but I'm too ignorant to attempt to act like I am a connoisseur. But the above website comes to the rescue with information of white, red and rose/blush wines. There is hope!!

White Wines

Vary from bone dry to sweet

Best chilled

Pair beautifully with wide variety of cuisines

Light white wines make delicious appetizer wines

3 California favorites – Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc and Pinot Gris

Chardonnay – dry, appealing balance of fruity, acidity and texture. If aged in oak, carries hints of toast, vanilla and butter. If not aged in oak it has typical aromas and flavors of apple, pear and citrus. Delicious with chicken and turkey stuffing.

Sauvignon Blanc - Aromas and flavors range from assertive and pungently herbal, often grassy to crisp and bright with citrus and green apple characteristics. Often blended with Semillon which adds notes of honey. Usually lively, dry and easy to pair with food. A chilled glass brings out the best in fish, chicken and shellfish dishes.

Pinot Gris – Takes its name from its pinkish-gray grapes. Gris is French for gray. It is fruity, clean citrus and melon character makes it a good pair for fish and chicken.

Spouse's Corner (continued)

Red Wines

Usually dry with intense fruit character, leaves rough, pucker sensation in the mouth
California produces Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Pinot Noir, Syrah and Zinfandel

Rose and Blush Wines

May be anything from sweet to dry
Pink because short period of contact with the grape skins
Good with spicy foods and lighter dishes too
Sweet blushes include White Zinfandel, White Merlot and White Grenache. The California roses are drier, but fresh and fruity

Vic had amassed a great collection of breweriana with a special concentration in items from Wisconsin. Vic was the person who got "Beer" as his eBay ID in the early days of the web site. It was always very interesting to follow what he sold on eBay. He attended many breweriana conventions and one JFO convention (that I know of) in 1999 at Naples, Fl. Vic entered several nice openers in the JFO auction. I got a nice C-3-4 Farmers and Verne Vollrath got a N-22-10 Kurth (at the time a UL). He did not open his room up until late afternoon that Friday. Several of us had been waiting patiently to get in and I noticed the door slightly ajar and went in. Good old Bob Post was just sitting there talking to Vic. Vic's bed was full of boxes with openers. I asked if it was okay to check them out. Vic said go ahead and Bob Post who had been there several minutes remarked that he did not realize the openers could be looked at. I quickly got a nice pile of openers (see JFO July 1999 issue) and within a few minutes several members were in the room. Vic was just smiling and collecting money. Dale Deckert was in there and calling everyone "Jesse James" if they bought something. Bob Post always held a special place in my heart for waiting until I get in the room and look at the openers. Vic was always very gracious and when you bought from him on eBay he would include some miscellaneous extras with each purchase. The breweriana hobby lost a true gentleman with the passing of Vic.

Opener Experts Offer 60 Styles

(No. 16 in a series on West Side industries.)
 (THE GARFIELDIAN June 10, 1948)

Operating on a revised "build a better mousetrap" principle, Harry L. Vaughan began building better can openers in 1911.

Cruising right through the years when solid housewives frowned on the flip young bride with a busy can opener, the Vaughan company grew to become the world's largest producer of can and bottle openers. Some varieties are offered to suit the purpose and the cook.

Still operating on its original site at 3211 Carroll the factory, officially Vaughan Novelty Manufacturing Co., employs 125 persons whose main work is the production and packing of the openers.

Other products made by Vaughans include metal bead key rings, cocktail spoons, pickle forks, kitchen tongs, lime and lemon squeezers and bottle stoppers.

A perennial favorite with the housewife, according to Vaughans, is the be-gadgedet all-in-one opener. (Like the P-23 on first page) An old timer in can opening it is the type which is bopped firmly down to make a hole in the top of the can then waggled up and down to remove the tin cap.

But can opening is the least of the virtues of this kitchen tool. It also offers a cork screw, a bottle opener for coke type bottles, a hook for removing pesky clamp-on lids, and a gadget for holes in fruit juice cans.

Although that ends its traditional functions, ingenious housewives have been known to use the gadget as an ice pick, screw driver, orange peeler, cooking fork, and under duress, as a tack hammer.

New Model Less Colorful

A newer model, the "Safety Roll Jr." is a small, simple gadget which leaves can edges smooth, eliminating the possibility of cuts on small hands and imprisoned cats. Even square meat cans, for which the regular key is always lost, are a cinch with this can opener. However, it has a less colorful career, since its only function is opening cans.

Beverage companies who thoughtfully enclose an opener in each case, are among the main customers of the bottle openers and certain can openers designed to make convenient pouring holes in cans of liquids.

Many of these companies as well as hotels use the openers as an advertising medium.

Punch Press Operation

Manufacture of the openers is mostly a punch press operation. One of the liquid can openers is turned out complete by a punch press at the rate of 100 per minute.

After punching the openers, or parts in some cases are rolled for many hours in drums filled with metal pellets or sand. This rolling action knocks off all sharp edges which may be left by the presses, and polishes the openers to a bright finish.

Completed openers may be stapled on an instruction card or packed in boxes for distribution to stores or beverage companies.

 Leading off the “A” types are three Coca-Cola openers. The A-1 from Grand Island brought an average price for that style. The A-5 is a very thin opener made by Thom Thompson in 1987 to hand out as “his business card”. The price it brought, \$25.37, is high. You may be able to get one free by just writing Thom?

A-033-005, Hamms (w/ 16 Misc Including B-18-95 Century), \$102.51
A-035-007, Home (w/ 43 Misc Including B-25-2 Buckeye), \$102.50

Two different pile of openers yielded a couple of hard to find “A”s, an A-33-5 Hamms and an A-35-7 Home. The A-35 pile had several other decent openers. It really pays to check them out even though they are usually a pile of junk, every now and then a treasure turns up.

A-040-002, Excelsior, \$265.00
 Several JFO guys chased the A-40-2 Excelsior before the “Horn Sounded”. Mike thought he now had both known A-40s but Jeb Burruss has an A-40-3 Home so Mike, Jeb needs your Excelsior to finish his “set”.

A-999-999, Harley Davidson Motorcycle Spinner, \$236.49, \$511.00, \$292.76
 I know a few members are laughing now about my rating a Harley Davidson spinner \$800-\$1000 at the 2007 JFO Convention. A few have turned up since then and then “bam”, three turn up in one quarter including one for \$236.49. Harley collectors seems to pay the most but it is obviously not that rare. If anyone wants mine for \$800, Pat said sell it.

B-001-015, Kauffman, \$312.00
B-002-019, Rising Sun (Good), \$265.00
B-002-049, Philadelphia (Good), \$41.60
B-027-006, Furniture City (w/ Leather Furniture City Brewing Leather Key Case), \$167.50

Brass keys were hot this quarter. An average condition B-1-15 Kauffman brings \$312.00 and to think at one time I owned two examples (at the same time). The B-2s are both very hard to find and Jim Osborn got a steal in the B-2-49 Philadelphia at \$41.60 (Jim I laid off when I saw you were high bidder). I also owned a B-27-6 Furniture City at one time and decided to chase hard for this one and had to pay \$167.50 (it does have a nice leather case attached which is also marked Furniture City Brewing).

B-032-999, Coca-Cola / Charleston SC, \$152.78
 Another thing I have mentioned is thinking you own the only known example of an opener and then a second one shows up. Ben Hoffman traded me the one I had 13 years ago and now this one turns up. It has be a tough one as the B-32 is only two inches long and a really small opener.

B-045-999, Denhalter Bottling Co Salt Lake City, \$167.00

Losing on eBay is never fun but when you bid \$166.99 and get beat by a penny it is crying times again. I have the Lemp beer B-45 and another non-beverage and these B-45s are usually from Salt Lake City no matter what ad is on them.

C-028-UL, Greisedieck Bros St Louis, \$102.59
 There are lots of different Greisedieck openers but this was a new style and the final price of \$102.59 was a lot more than I bid. That being said I am sure a St. Louis collector is the happy owner (not sure who it is). A 1930s opener that is easily found with a Mound City Malt ad but uncommon with any other ads.

CBO-SHM-13, Full Weight Cigar, \$92.00
 Mark this CBO up in my “win column”. A style I had not seen for sale before but Mike Schwimmer had it pictured in his CBO book. As a rule CBOs have seen prices much cheaper than the early days of eBay when many went for good money. The \$92.00 price of this one is on up there for today’s market.

E-004-999, Dr Pepper Good For Life (Screwdriver Tip), \$37.78

Add this one to my list also and I already owned one. If there is one group I can never figure out it is Dr. Pepper collectors. The first few years of eBay it was nothing to see them pay several hundred dollars for an opener if they did not own it. Now you rarely see one go over \$100.00. This is the third example of an E-4 with a screwdriver end I have seen but it barely drew any interest. From my ex-

perience soda wires rarely get soda collectors excited.

E-016-016, White Rock, \$3.25

This is a funny story to tell as I see this E-16-16 is listed and I throw in the starting bid price of \$1.00 with a high bid of \$3.00. I wait all week and no one else bids. I even get home from work the last day of the auction knowing I have placed a healthy snipe bid. I watch the auction tick down and at 5 seconds the price jumps to \$3.25 and it hits me I never placed my snipe bid. None other than Mr. Soda himself, John Patton, has swooped in and grabbed my prize wire opener. Oh well it was the second one known and hopefully I will get a chance at one someday.

F-006-122, Coca-Cola Anheuser-Busch, \$116.49

This tough F-6 is offered for a starting price of \$79.99 and the seller has lots of nice Coca-Cola openers for sale this past quarter. Several do not get bids the first time and I am figuring I might sneak in with my bid of \$113.99. The alarm sounds and I am a bridesmaid again.

K-009-001, Blatz (EX), \$228.02

Darvin Stilwell added this nice condition K-9 as he continued to close in on owning all of the bar mount types. There have been several K-9s sold on eBay over the years and the prices have ranged from \$150.00 to \$500.00, so \$228.02 is not a bad price.

M-025-001, Lemp Bullet (In Original Box-No A Home-made Box), \$86.00

This was a nice sales job as “the original box” looked to be a perfume bottle box that happen to closely fit an M-25. The top of the M-25 stuck out and no way the box material was from the 1900-1910 era. Somebody got sold up the river.

N-029-999, Coca-Cola (Pencil End Smashed), \$103.57 N-029-999, Coca-Cola Starr Bros Ronald Roth Salesman, \$381.88

Certain Coca-Cola openers just make collectors go crazy bidding. N-29 or bullet pencils are fairly hard to find with Coca-Cola ads but not worth \$400.00. Even crazier is a bid of \$103.57 on an N-29 with the pencil end smashed down. Never pay much money for off grade unless it is one-of-a-kind and in those cases be careful. Junk is junk.

N-046-001, Hamms, \$107.50

N-054-001, Blatz, \$200.00

N-054-001, Blatz (EX), \$151.51

“N” types are dominated by the Hamms money clip bringing \$107.50. A high price for this style but then again it is

advertising Hamms and those collectors are not shy. The N-54 Remington bottle shaped knives have seen several examples sold the last couple of years. Prices have stayed steady in the \$150-\$200 range for nice examples.

O-005-006, Jackson (EX), \$202.50

O-005-999, Frigidaire, \$92.00

O-005-999, Frigidaire (Good), \$208.05

Starr opener prices have certainly moderated the last five years on eBay but every now and then some bidders go wild and this quarter saw several openers go for high prices. The most overpriced was an O-5-6 Jackson in nice condition but no way should it bring \$202.50 like this one did. The two O-5 Frigidaire sales represent how prices can really vary for Starr openers. The nicer one bring less than \$100 while the one in decent condition brings \$208.05. Go figure.

O-006-UL, Fitzgerald Beer & Ale, \$89.99

O-006-UL, Hamms, \$105.49

O-006-UL, Red Top Beer Cincinnati OH (EX), \$136.49

Out of the clear blue a seller has found several “UL”s in the O-6 style. This quarter saw a Fitzgerald, Hamms (actually a second example) and a Red Top beer sold with most being in very nice condition. Prices are not for the faint of heart but the Fitzgerald and Red Top but had nice logos on the opener.

O-505-999, Whistle, \$270.00

O-505-999, Whistle (BIN), \$200.00

Once in a while on eBay I will watch an opener sell for what I think is a crazy price and think I have an extra. The O-505 Whistle was one that went through the roof at \$270.00. I listed mine at \$99.99 and a bidder asked if I would take \$200.00 on a buy-it-now. I said sure (he had to recall his \$99.00 bid). And if anyone is desperate I have one more “extra” O-505 Whistle!

P-008-235, Hauenstein, \$223.50

A wood handle corkscrew that had not been on the market before. Hauenstein is a popular brewery for Minnesota collectors and area collectors chased very hard after this one.

P-030-003, Bay City, \$787.99

P-035-003, Minneapolis (Good), \$490.00

The P-30-3 Bay City was one barmount I needed to complete the “P-30 Set”. It was not to be as “fotodeal” (eBay ID) wanted it for his collection. He is a Eastern European collector with very deep pockets and rarely gets beat in any auction.

The P-35-3 Minneapolis barmount had a couple examples known until two years ago. Since that time three off-grade examples have been sold on eBay including this off-grade one. Probably a little high for the price considering the condition.

P-170-001, Pabst (Var C Enamelled Handles) (Fair-Good), \$338.33

P-UL-UL, (2-Tool Folding Bow) Bergner & Engel Philadelphia, \$670.00

P-UL-UL, (Small Folding Bow w/ Flat Printing) P B Ale / Bunker Hill Lager, \$271.99

Mike sounded the horn on the P-170-1 Pabst knife with enamelling. The knife had been repaired with the master blade being a replacement. I have seen three others with enamelling and only one was in nice condition.

Jim Osborn and myself battled for the P-UL-UL Bergner & Engel corkscrew (see this issue’s New Discoveries). It was one of those times I let my bidding get way out of hand. It is a neat piece but \$670.00 is a pretty outrageous price for it.

The same can be said for the little folding bow bought by Greg Loy. With a whiskey ad as usually found, it is a \$30-\$50 corkscrew. The first one ever seen with beer advertising (see New Discoveries). The ending price of \$271.99 is seriously high for a simple folding bow corkscrew.

Above are the highest corkscrew sale results. Amazingly the “Hootch Owl” sells three times for \$2,500.00 each time. Several examples of this corkscrew have sold the last few years but the price remains high as it is considered the hardest to find of the Syroco figural corkscrews. It is a corkscrew that every collector wants in their collection if they can afford it (and no I do not have one or can afford one).

Ebay has made a big effort to get more items listed using lower listing fees and listing specials. Unfortunately for collectors it has encouraged the “junk” sellers to list a lot of common and worthless items hoping to catch unsuspecting bidders. One thing about eBay is you have to be committed to looking, searching and doing it often to find the few good openers and corkscrews being sold. Hopefully the Christmas season will see better items on eBay but even with a sluggish economy there has not been large numbers of good openers in the marketplace.
