NABA Convention #52 Chicago (Schaumburg) IL August 1-5, 2023

The first JFO/NABA Convention in Schaumburg (Chicago) was dynamite (to borrow a Gary Deachman description). Pat and the pups would be staying home as the Hyatt Regency only allowed service dogs. The two weeks leading up to the Convention I had gotten Gary's collection ready to sell. A lot of polishing and organizing. I left Durham the Saturday before Convention week and made Indianapolis that night (late as traffic was bad all over being a heavy weekend travel day).

Before arriving in Schaumburg the next afternoon I made a detour to Streator IL to see Bob and Marge Stahly. We had a great two hour visit and just talked as Bob had sold almost all of his good openers. He has a bunch of newer and cheaper openers as he did not want the kids to have to worry about selling an opener collection. They were both doing well. Thankfully after leaving Streator the traffic was not too bad going to Schaumburg.

My room for the JFO/NABA Convention with 350 members attending was right beside the Hospitality Room. It was a tight setup as I told Tommy Campnell he could have two tables in the suite room and I had four for everything I brought. The Expedition was pretty well packed and I made four hotel cart loads to get everything in the room.

Sunday night was pretty slow and spent the time setting up and I had to make my first trip to Shaw's Crab House for supper. The NABA Convention team was setting up the hospitality room and getting Convention envelopes ready and I did pitch in some to get things set up.

Monday saw action pick up and with Gary Deachman's collection I did a lot of business. Besides having a great type collection, Gary had a great "painted opener" collection including many B-1s, B-2s, M-1s and M-2s. By the end of the day most of those openers had been sold. Another trip to Shaw's that night and my first airport run to O'Hare that evening to pick up the Eblens. Airport was about 10 miles away but their flight was late and they were "dumped" at the International Terminal which made the pick-up somewhat challenging.

Monday ended with me finding out my main credit card number had been stolen with someone trying to make bets at Underdog Sports LLC. The credit card company at first let me use the card if unfroze and then froze back the card. The next day the credit card company killed the card after repeated attempted to make fraudulent charges. Just a minor trip issue.

Tuesday was NABA "House Tour" day and I did make it to Dave Lendy's house that morning. Dave is a JFO member and has a basement full of Chicago and Illinois Breweriana. Just an awesome collection. There were two other house tours after Dave's but I had three airport runs to make that afternoon to first pick up John Cartwright, then Rick and Darlene Atwood and lastly Dave Pinney. All three went smoothly. Tommy Campnell checked in Tuesday afternoon. I had crammed six tables into my suite and two were set aside for Tommy. Despite heavy sales on Monday, I still had a lot of good openers and Breweriana smalls to sell. Tommy had two tables full of corkscrews. We were rocking and rolling. The day was capped off with a trip to Shaw's with Tommy and John C. We had my favorite server, Maria, and as always an awesome meal.

Wednesday was busy selling and by then most everyone attending the Convention had registered. Unlike our 2022 JFO Convention with 16 official attendees, NABA Chicago had 363 members in attendance. JFO had about 12 of our core crowd and another 15 attendees who

normally attend NABA are also in JFO. We were mainly on two floors and it was a challenge to navigate the maze on each floor. One of the big Breweriana dealers said he could step out of his room and there would be 10 rooms open in either direction, so lots of action for every-one.

Room-to-room buying and selling is a hallmark of the NABA Convention. Everyone talked about how good the action was. Thursday and Friday continued to be good selling days. Thursday afternoon NABA had the First-Timers get together and I joined in with eight of the JFO members being their first time. NABA had about 50 first-timers in total. Friday would be the first time NABA did not have an onsite or online auction going on so most of the day was dedicated to room-to-room trading. Friday evening is the NABA Banquet and about 450 people were in attendance. NABA President, Ken Quaas, gave an update on how NABA is doing and a few various other speakers on Breweriana topics. That evening some more dealing but most everyone is getting rooms packed for the Saturday Public Show.

Show setup Saturday morning started at 8AM and the public started arriving by 9AM. Close to 200 tables were full of Breweriana and a good walk-in crowd came. I sold very well at the public show and the whole week was awesome for sells since Gary had such a great opener collection.

Saturday afternoon the JFO members were invited to Tommy's condo which was about 30 minutes away in Elgin. We were going to leave at 3PM but left at 2:30PM (my apologies to Darvin Stilwell for not telling him the new time). About a dozen of us went to Tommy's to see his corkscrew collection. He had been working on a couple of months on new displays and getting his good pieces displayed and available for viewing. The group stayed about an hour and it was a lot of fun. A few deals were made and we returned to the hotel.

The Atwoods and Eblens did leave for home that afternoon and the remaining JFO members went to Shaw's that evening for a final meal. We were joined by Pete Magnuson and once again Maria gave us great service. I had started packing after getting back from Tommy's and made a few last minute sales (it helps being beside the Hospitality Room). That evening I loaded most of my stuff.

The next morning a few final good-byes and I was on the road by 7AM. Tommy was suppose to take John Cartwright to the airport and was sleeping in when he realized he had to hustle. A few red lights passed through and he got John to O'Hare and John made it through security with five minutes to spare. If I had driven straight through it was 13 hours of driving plus an hour lost due to a time change. I got within three hours of Durham and decided to stop and rest up. It was one long day.

A much different format for JFO members but NABA always puts on a great Convention. I did make a Convention opener up again (another Starr wall mount) but no mini-JFO Auction and the ladies had to adjust to the NABA Group Hospitality room but pulled it off and the NABA crowd liked the jigsaw puzzle idea. They were a big hit. Hotel rooms for NABA/JFO 2024 in St. Louis are fully booked but get on the wait list (email me and I will connect to the person handling the list) and everyone who got on the list this year got in.
