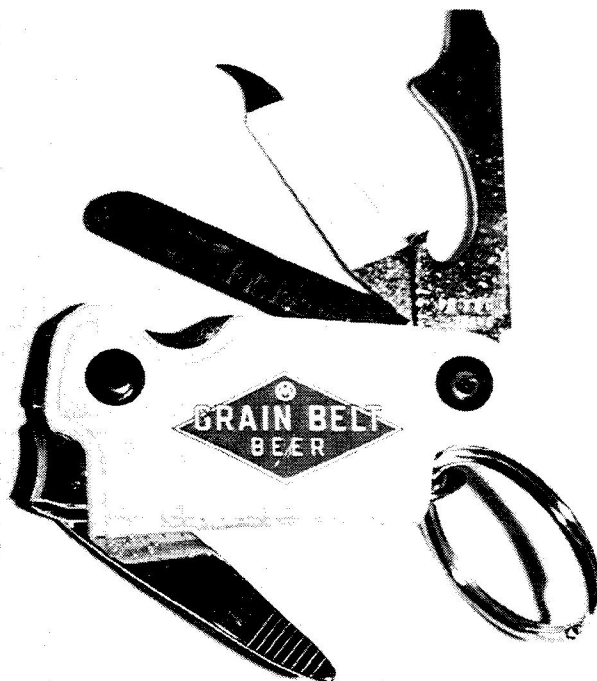

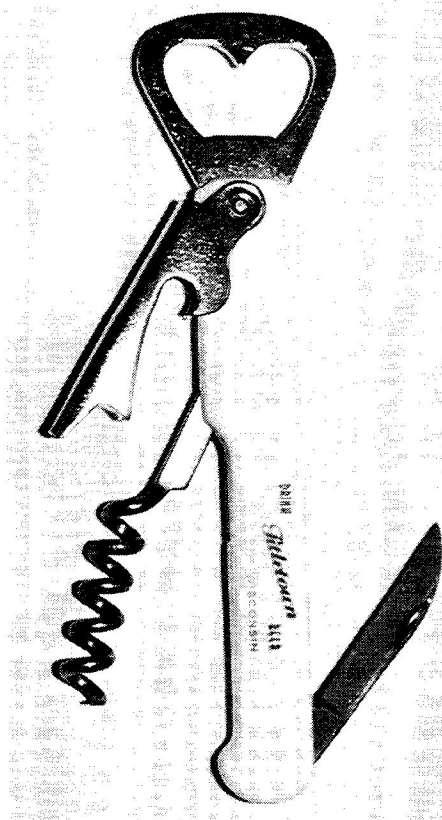

"Hometown Beer" by H. James Maxwell & Bob Sullivan Jr.

Jim Maxwell has co-authored a great book on the brewery history of Kansas City, Mo. The following article appeared in the St. Joseph (Mo.) News-Press newspaper. Please see Jim's ad in the "For Sale" section of the Want Ads. Some very nice openers and corkscrews appear in the book.

Goetz made beer history

The former M.K. Goetz Brewing Co. of St. Joseph gets royal treatment in "Hometown Beer," a history of Kansas City's breweries and of beers sold there.

In the comprehensive and excellently illustrated volume, a Goetz pre-Prohibition delivery wagon is the main illustration on the book's jacket cover and at least 24 pages of text and pictures

are devoted to the one-time St. Joseph brewery and its plant in Kansas City, Mo. The book is published by Omega Innovative Marketing, Kansas City, Mo. Authors of the book are J. James Maxwell, a Kansas collector of breweriana, and Bob Sullivan Jr., vice president of sales and marketing for Boulevard Brewing Co., Kansas City. Mr. Maxwell, an attorney, securities, oil and natural gas expert, even collects Chinese stamps. The authors provide a book that is similar to good beer in that it has a sturdy body and sufficient froth to keep the reader's attention and add flavor to the tasty mix. The history ranges from the 1850s, when St. Joseph had more (12) breweries than Kansas City, up to today when Boulevard Brewery, founded 10 years ago in Kansas City, has proved a success.

The section devoted to Goetz is the best history ever written about the St.

Joseph brewery, which ceased operations in May of 1976, with many of its 240 employees left unemployed. Unfortunately, city officials and community leaders made no effort to induce Pearl Brewing, San Antonio, Texas, the firm that bought the Goetz plant, to continue brewing here. The Kansas City plant, which made beer only for sale in kegs, opened in 1936 and was shut down in 1960.

Goetz was one of the few breweries in the nation that survived Prohibition, switching to production of soda pop, ginger ale and a near beer, Goetz Country Club Special. As the authors explain, this popular "near" product could be brought up to "real" beer standard and taste by needling a bottle with an ounce of grain alcohol.

One story the authors checked but could not verify is that Tom Pendergast, a St. Joseph native who became the Democratic boss of Kansas City and Missouri, was responsible for the building of the Goetz brewery in Kansas City. According to some long-gone Goetz executives and St. Joseph businessmen, Pendergast told the Goetzes, "Unless you build a brewery here, you will not sell any Goetz beer in Kansas City." True? Probably — Goetz did build a new plant in the down-river city. Coincidentally, Tom's son was the nominal head of the Anheuser-Busch Beer distributing company in Kansas City.

In all, "Hometown Beer" provides a sound and colorful history of beer in Kansas City and gives a reasonable basis for the successes and failures of the various enterprises. Separate

chapters cover the various operations, such as Muehlebach, with its distinctive green bottles; Fred Heim Brewing Co, Imperial Brewery; Dick Brothers Brewery, and Anheuser-Busch. This brewery stole the show on the day beer became legal, by sending a six-horse team of Clydesdales to Kansas City to deliver beer — at the request of Jim Pendergast, saloon owner and ward heeler, Tom Pendergast's brother.

The former Royal Brewing Co., born in Weston, Mo., in 1842, and moving later into the Kansas City area, also gets considerable space in the book. Today, one of the brewery's five stone caves at Weston is occupied by the 1842 Irish Pub.

Schlitz Brewing, also sold in Kansas City, advertised its product as "The beer that made Milwaukee famous."

The relatively small Weston brewery is remembered for tweaking Schlitz with its own slogan for its Royal Pilsener, "The beer that made Milwaukee jealous."

If you like beer, you'll like "Hometown Beer."

Spouse's Corner

In the October '99 issue, I reviewed newsletters covering a two year period to have enough information for my article. I'm not sure I'll have room to tell about two issues this time. When I started digging back into the early issues, I didn't seem to have enough information to start on the format of an index, as information was limited. These two issues cry for an index. Now, I must get serious about organizing all this data! A project for 2000.

But for now, let me tell you some of the neat things from articles written many years ago. As always, I have some questions and comments for John, but he has been asleep for 3 hours, dreaming about openers I'm sure, or maybe just one, the one that got away or the one he can't find anywhere, or he's found, but the owner won't trade. Sounds more like a nightmare.

Corkie is beside me, but asleep too. She's had a stressful day, going to the vet early this a.m. for her first bi-weekly weigh in. Diet plan is to lose 1 ounce per week, so we needed a 2 ounce loss today. 2.5 ounces!!!!

January 1981 issue started with a picture of a P-35 bar mounted corkscrew (don't worry Corkie, you are not a bar mount), Bob VanVactor discovered this one marked "M.K. Goetz Brewing Co., Brewers & Bottlers, St. Joseph, Mo., Quick & Easy". Inside the handle is marked: "1827 Style". Now, I just wonder if Don Whelan might own his treasure now. If so, perhaps he will show us when we head out to St. Jo for JFO 2001 (John teels me Don Bull may have ended up with this one as he has one in his collection).

I found out that "Ajax" on the B-35 is not a beer, but a trade name for marketing. Could someone explain what that means (John doesn't know).

Reference to the upcoming 3rd annual opener convention in St. Louis, urged people to make plans to attend by adding that "Life is to be enjoyed". That's exactly what happens when these collectors gather to spend days in opener heaven. Better be in Chicago in 2000. Note too, that in Jan. '81 Bob Chapman, host of the St. Louis convention that year had 22 early registrations from 9 states. To this day, it helps the host to know as soon as possible who is coming so they can plan accordingly. Norm wants to know, as he wants to beat the great attendance he had in 1996!!

Leon Beebe moved to Arizona around January '81. He said he really didn't move there just to reduce the humidity and lessen rust damage to his openers (F-2's). The tradeoff was worrying about protecting glasses and mugs from blowing sand. Now, if we ever move to Arizona to stop rust, I'll sell a lot of Mary Kay to help all that dry skin.

Mary Garatti submitted a copy of No Requiem for the Church Key that she submitted for her English composition course at Sonoma State University in Rohnert Park, California. Her search for a free bottle opener made her so thirsty that she popped open a beer, suddenly understanding why there were no openers as she flipped back the tab. Gene Appel's collection was featured in the October 19, 1980 issue of the Antelope Valley Television News (Palmdale, CA.) The next month the collection was on display at the Palmdale Library. John would have made me keep watch I'm sure if it had been his collection.

Ed Kaye pointed out some corrections to a J-5b opener listing and added other variations. That isn't a baseball player, Ed. He advocated once again that they should stick to variations of significance, otherwise it becomes absurd to carry out the variation search too far and what confusion it would cause. Ditto today!

Joe Cardone's 4th auction averaged \$3.86 per opener. (John spends that on postage and shipping for each opener he gets off of Ebay today).

How to Serve and Open Cans instructions that were included in a brochure introducing Krueger Beer in cans in the early 30's advised to be sure the contents of the can were cold. Good idea!!! Another interesting point was that you should wash glasses in clean cold water and salt, never use soap. Sounds like a marguerita (not in spell check).

In February 1963, the Arcuate can opener came out from Ecko. It was designed to eliminate the distortion of the new aluminum lids by reducing the pressure needed to open a can by 15%.

I certainly have heard enough about Starr since the Blue Gray show in Feb. '99. Well, a copy of their ad from Feb. 1946 was included in the Jan. '81 issue. Their openers did several things, including "Prevent danger to the public". Maybe you couldn't open a bottle with one and could not drink and drive (on our minds around New Years, especially this New Year's Eve.)

A Vaughan ad came out in the same gazette as the Starr ad. It promoted two openers as famous "goodwill" builders.

Are you beginning to see the growth of the hobby as I continue to review the Jan. '81 issue of the JFO newsletter? It had grown so much, that there was a paragraph stating, "as openers become harder and harder to find" (almost 20 years ago, hard to find?), collectors started seeking out openers in special areas of interest, including geographic area, brands or types.

For the April '81 issue, Chapman wrote, "If you were sick, working, broke, in jail" for the first or second convention, you better "take pills, get healthy, quit your job, borrow, have someone post bail for you - get to the convention." All spouses know and accept that they will be frozen and buried after JFO if they should die in late April.

Carolina Griggs, spouse of Clayton accompanied his display of Type E wire openers at the 2nd convention with a poem named "The Bottle Opener". This great poem was shared in the April newsletter for those who were sick, working, broke or in jail during the 2nd convention.

Bull had been in Atlanta on business and spent some time at the U.S. Patent Depository. Along with other information gathered, he found listings for 5 patents by J.L. Sommer Mfg. Co. of Newark, N.J. and Bull had not seen any of those openers with Sommer's name on them (A-7/35, A-9, A-13, A-18, A-28). I bet he made them a priority on his list!

Mention was made of an article Bob Carter had written on "A Collectible "Whatsit"". It covered cigar box openers. That would be fun to read, since I've seen quite a few of those around here.

Joe Cardone's 5th opener auction averaged \$3.32. Since collectors were taking their good ones to the JFO convention to trade, auction results were down.

A collection of M-3 retractable slide-outs were shown in this issue. (Don't try to find that issue, Art Johnson. The picture wasn't great...not like the quality of Just for Openers.) Add pictures of mini-bottles (L-4), mini-can openers (L-1), Pot metal bar mounted can piercer for 12 oz cans (K-2), some openers for lefties and micro-mini openers and you too will be overwhelmed.

In Paris 1878, C.T. Williamson Wire Corkscrew was given a flattering reception for their wire corkscrew. They had shown how to make the best and cheapest corkscrews in the world. (probably not cheap today.)

Three more items and I must think about sleep as 2 a.m. nears.

When we moved into the flip top world, a special Dewey and Almy DAREX sealing compound inside the cap kept the flavor in the can.

Barry Weston, a Australian subscriber, submitted a list of his collection of D type cap lifters he had from all over the world. Just scanning the list sends you on a fascinating tour.

The article ended with some photos of Bonnie Bull's figural collection, as interest in these openers was kindled after the July '79 article by Michael Jordan.

Now, I must think about sleep. Tomorrow, or rather today, I must work on moving John from this computer to a faster one we are giving to each other for Christmas. You know who will then get this old one. I thought the new one is ours??? He bruised his knuckles squeezing the new monitor through the door and wanted me to feel sorry for him. Another thing on my agenda is making banana pudding for his office this week (all those who came to NC in 90 or 91 know that this is a big production, especially for a Canadian to make southern style banana pudding). Instead of the 12 Days of Christmas, I will be separating 12 eggs and wishing that all our dear JFO friends were here!

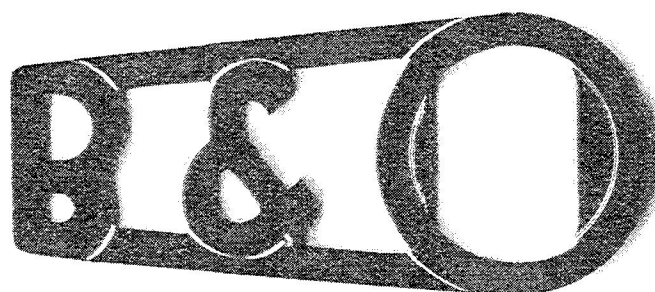
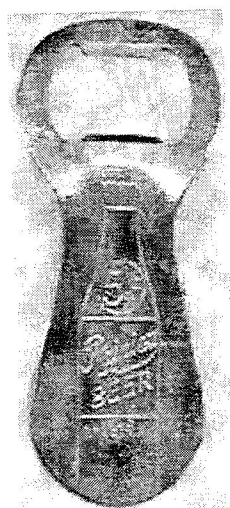
"Opener Trivia"

From the last issue, no one responded to either Jack Ford's question about the true existence of the A-14-2 Schmidt or John Hall's question about the origin of Mayer Company of Milwaukee, WI.

Ebay continues going strong. Among the openers I added to my collection since the last issue were the following: A-4-63 Social Beer, A-15-62 Alliance, A-20-51 Schlitz, A-21-131 Sabinas, A-21-132 Trainers, A-33-1 Ackermans, A-45 Vote Democratic, B-17-9 Standard, B-18-638 Ontario, B-18 Coca-Cola Cumberland MD, B-23-104 Wausau, B-23-145 White Rose, B-24-72 Wausau, C-2-2 Tech (Bottle), E-4 Coca-Cola Syracuse NY, E-14-690 Glacier, E-14-749 Terre Haute, G-11-1 Muessel Silver Edge, K-5-2 Schlitz Grey), K-10-2 Pabst, L-2-4 Buffalo Co-Op, N-5-4 West End, N-27-4 Budweiser, O-10-2 East Side, P-1-11 A-B 1876, P-11-1 Salinas and P-146-1 Hennepin. Just before Christmas Art Johnson was lucky enough to add a nice M-3-43 Queen City to his collection. He now only needs the M-3-36 Piel Bros and M-3-42 Seitz to complete his collection. As I keep saying the prices are usually not cheap but as you can see some nice openers and corkscrews come on the market. I will add that I also added many miscellaneous beer and soda openers in the less than \$20 range.

Another eBay trend continues with the high prices realized for O-5 Starr X and the Starr X "Long Neck" openers. In descending order; O-5 Beaufont Ginger Ale \$611.99, O-Long Neck Lime Cola \$504.00, O-5 Climax Beverages (MIB) 334.76, O-5 Nehi \$297.20, O-5 Pep \$274.88, a 2nd O-5 Pep \$200.00, O-5 Polar \$150, a 2nd O-5 Nehi \$127.55, O-Long Neck Orange Crush \$127.50, and finally an O-5 Climax Beverage \$76.03. Most of the openers were very good to excellent condition. My read is that the word has gotten out and a lot Starr X openers are being offered. The only rare ones not being offered so far are the O-5 Schlitz and the O-5 Grand Prize Texas' Largest Seller. Prices do not match availability. The only, at this time, rare opener sold in the above lots was the Lime Cola "Long Neck". If you collect Starr openers be patient they are out there and can be found.

Other notable sales include a M-19 Coca-Cola for \$255.00 (supposedly only 100 were made for a sales convention) and a M-86 Schlitz for \$75.00. On the figural scene a rare F-429 Coyote sold for \$1,728.99 (not too shabby when the seller was trying to get \$60.00). I will conclude the eBay sales with a N-11-UL Rainier Beer shoehorn opener with a bottle on it (below left). An ardent JFO collector really wanted the opener but unfortunately a Rainier collector who will pay any price won out with a bid of \$132.50. For a collector eBay brings out a lot of crazy bidders.



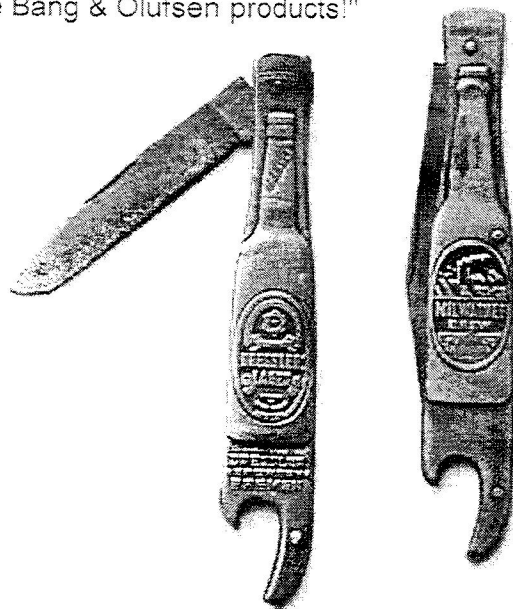

The B&O opener on the previous page right hand side is not a Baltimore & Ohio Railroad Opener. It is a fairly common opener and Art Johnson obtained one in the original card. Many sellers on eBay claim it as a railroad opener but it stands for "Bang & Olufsen". The company tells the story on their card. "From the very beginning 60 years ago, Peter Bang and Svend Olufsen stuck to the principles of functional design, perfect performance and exquisite craftsmanship. This has inspired a great many people, and among these a young man called Holger Krogh. Originally a railway engineer, he was later employed by Bang & Olufsen in Struer where he in his spare time created this eyecatching opener - using the fundamental B&O principles. That was in 1937, and the opener's design is still the same after all of these years. So are the fundamental ideas of Bang & Olufsen. Just goes to show that the good things in life are timeless." They add a PS statement, "We advise you to hang on to your new opener. It is the oldest, the most produced and the most stolen of all of the Bang & Olufsen products!"

Next are two different knives owned by Don Bull.

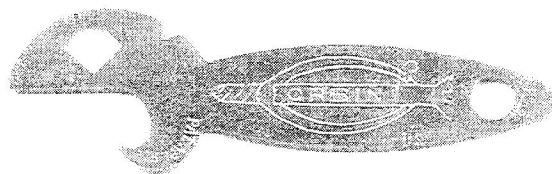

Marc Benjamin bought a knife like the one on the right at the JFO convention. Since it advertised "Milwaukee Brew" he hoped it was American. With Don's second knife and also being stamped "Ges. Gesch", it is safe to assume it is German. Still a very nice knife and worth the \$155.00 Marc paid (I was the person who ran the bid up on him, so I had better say it is nice!). Just because openers and knives are foreign does not mean they are not worth much. In many cases the exact opposite is true, they are worth more than their American counterparts.

Lew Burritt has a B-14 advertising "Bludwine". I also own a G-5 advertising "Bludwine" (below left). Does anyone know the origin of or have any information about "Bludwine"? Doesn't sound very appetizing but who knows?

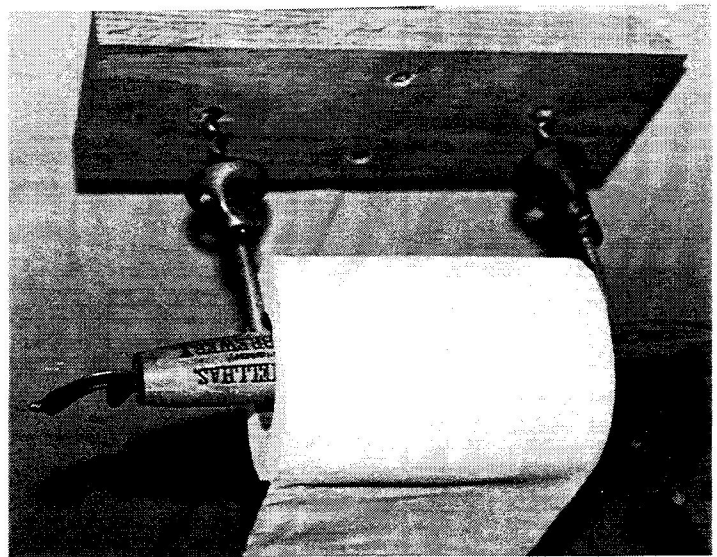
"Opener Trivia" (Continued)

"Had an evening dentist appointment across from Manchester's library tonight. With October's (1998) newsletter fresh in my mind, I decided to investigate the Corbin Screw Opener on page 4. Corbin is a familiar name in Connecticut, and is well-remembered by "older folks" as a maker of top quality brass locks and hardware. The letter "C" reminded me of the stylized "C" used on Corbin locks." Paul attached a page of history from a book about "Industrial History of Connecticut".

At the age of 19 Philp Corbin worked at North & Stanley in New Britain, Ct. in 1844. He learned to make plate locks and started on own. Within four years he had 35 men working for him. In 1851 he was joined by his brother Frank and the company became known as the P & F Corbin. The present site of the P & F Corbin Company (1970) was bought in 1864. The production of screws started in 1876. In 1902, the Corbin Screw and Russwin Screw operations were combined to form the Corbin Screw Division of American Hardware Corp. By 1925 the corporation employed 8,000 in New Britain.

Paul concludes with, "since I have been in the screw business for 20 years, I would like to line up for any pending sale or trade of the opener." Don't worry your name is at the top of the list.

After 21 years of JFO I decided the L-4 listings were a mess. Instead of taking the normal route of trying to list all of the wording on each opener, I decided it would be much easier and less confusing to use the brand name and list the brewery name in parentheses. The brand name is what catches your eye on these openers. Bob Kay of Batavia, IL had written a great book called *Miniature Beer Bottles & Go-Withs*. Even though the book is 20 years old, it is still the bible for bottled shaped beer items with each item shown in a photograph. Bob referenced the L-4s by state and brand name. So JFO collectors would be on the same page, the L-4s have been changed to use Bob's system. You can order copies of the 1980 book with a 1989 update from Bob Kay at 216 N Batavia Ave, Batavia IL 60510. Write Bob for the latest price and shipping costs. A couple of samples are shown below left of the stubby bottle.

Collectors are flocking to online auctions

No question — Bill Rue wanted the toy car, a childhood object that set off memories of 1969, when the Mets won the World Series. But it wasn't until he found himself bidding against an anonymous foe in an Internet auction one evening that he knew he *must* have it.

Rue, a Brooklyn Realtor who has no regrets about paying \$101 for a used toy that opened at \$9, is hardly alone in his embrace of the online auction. It is an Internet phenomenon that in a matter of months has captivated the nation's bargain hunters and spawned a market for nostalgia. Millions of Americans are bidding electronically on things they have never seen, tendered by people they have never met.

While retailers continue to spend furiously to draw more customers online, the Internet is suddenly teeming with buyers and sellers making their own markets. Items range from a 50-gallon fish tank (four goldfish included) to painted plaster hula girls to the 1987 Mercedes 300 turbo diesel that Bill Steinhour of northern Virginia landed with a \$5,800 bid.

Economists say the blossoming of online bidding is no surprise. Auctions theoretically are a very efficient form of commerce, the perfect nexus of the supply-and-demand curves. But they have traditionally been expensive to hold and limited in reach. The Internet solves both of those problems: online, bidders in Florida and California can view the same Civil War-era glass perfume bottle. They are also relieved of the social awkwardness and time-consuming nature of haggling face to face. Many simply automate their bidding, letting the computer take care of negotiation.

It is not all about market efficiency, however. Buyers and sellers might find themselves ex-

changing e-mail about the former teen-age idol Bobby Sherman, long after the transaction was over. On eBay, the most popular auction site, etiquette dictates that buyers and sellers post feedback about each other as a guide to others.

And then there is the adrenaline rush of winning.

"You get the fun of outbidding someone; you get something glorious in the mail, and on top of that someone publicly praises you for doing it," said Robert Pela, 37, a writer in Phoenix, who has acquired several Partridge Family albums via online auction. "It's become my favorite form of procrastination."

If Americans become hooked on cyberspace bargaining, the implications for the retail economy could be as wide-reaching as the introduction of fixed pricing enabled by standardized produc-

tion a century ago.

While 1998 online auction sales were a relatively small \$1.4 billion, some analysts see a future where everything is a negotiation, from heating oil to the chopped meat at the Internet grocery store.

"There is a building mind-set of, 'Hey, I can bid for things,'" said Kate Delhagen, analyst at Forrester Research. "All this has the net effect that people start thinking that they can name their price. This is going to cause a real change in how we do business."

In a report released last week, Forrester predicted that business-to-consumer interactions would account for 66 percent of a \$19 billion online auction market by 2003. Already, several sites like Onsale and First Auction have created a hybrid format of auction retailer. They buy excess merchandise cheaply, particularly computer equipment, and resell it to the highest bidder. Tickets for air travel also are widely up for bid through auction-like vendors like Priceline.

But for now, most Web transactions are person-to-person through third-party auction houses that connect interested parties. And the Web's central bazaar is eBay, a venture started in San Jose, Calif., in 1995, whose audience recently has surged to 6.5 million visitors a month and has a market capitalization of \$23 billion (roughly three times that of Kmart). eBay keeps no inventory and takes no responsibility for authenticity of the wares being showcased on its screens. It does take a variable percentage of each final bid, making it one of the few Internet ventures to be profitable.

EBay's hands-off formula has raised concerns about fraud. In numerous instances, genuinely naive sellers have misrepresented their wares — advertising an 18th-century British sea chest, for example, when they have a 19th-century traveling trunk.

Instances of outright theft where buyers send off their checks and never receive their booty, although far rarer, have also occurred.

While the company insists that 99.9 percent of the transactions on its site go off without a complaint, the federal government is investigating individual allegations of fraud. And eBay reached a settlement last month with the New York City Department of Consumer Affairs in which it agreed to take steps to weed out fraudulent sellers.

The company also recently signed a deal with Collector's Universe, an authentication service to which sellers can pay a fee if they want their items evaluated and vouched for.

Still, as consumers continue to click on eBay, competitors are trying to cut in. Last month, the online bookseller Amazon.com opened its own auction house. Sotheby's and Christie's, the gold standard of traditional practitioners, have said they will soon design to peddle by modem. And a plethora of niche sites like gunbroker.com, planet bike and mobilia.com, for car buffs, are proliferating.

If eBay's diverse population is any indication, the new sites may well find customers. A considerable part of the online auction crowd is made up of longtime collectors who buy and sell off line as well. But the Web seems to be igniting the collecting impulse among those who might otherwise have been content to buy retail or not at all.

Stephanie Cannode, 23, a nurse in Kenton, Ohio, for instance, recently began collecting My Little Ponies, which she remembers fondly from her not-so-distant youth. After showing off her online finds, Cannode must now share computer time with her father, who scours the auction boards for Zippo lighters; her mother, whose passion is Beanie Babies, and her brother, who recently went to a Nascar race with tickets he bought on eBay.

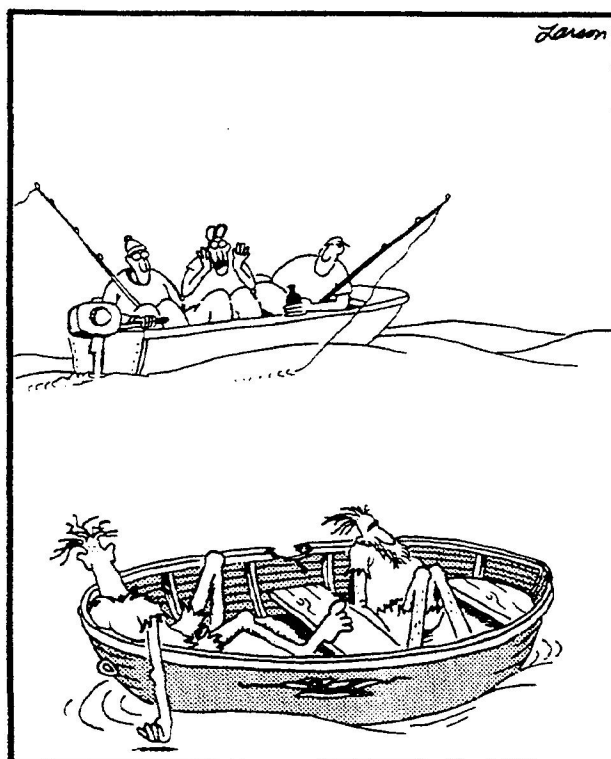

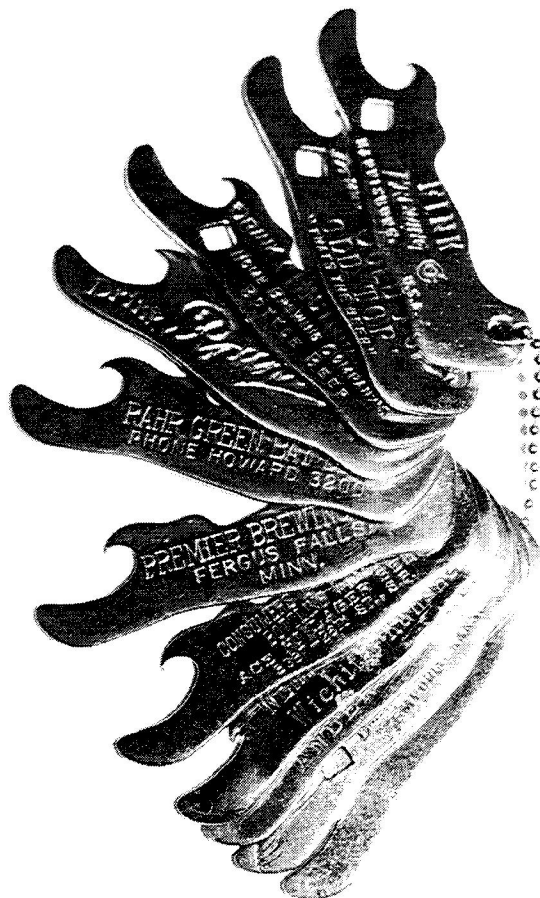

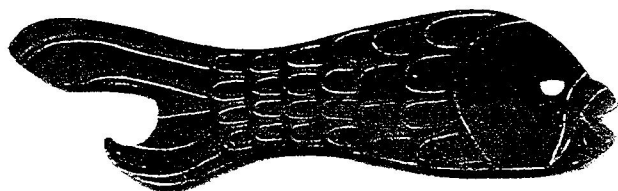

SEBRING — John Hall has never met a bottle he couldn't open!

Hall retired to Sebring in 1981 and brought his unusual hobby with him.

For more than 20 years Hall has collected bottle openers. "I was looking through my tackle box before I moved down here and found three bottle openers that had been in there forever and that kind of got me started," said Hall.

A salesman once gave him a promotional item. "It was a miniature sander and bottle opener and that also stirred my interest in finding different types of bottle openers."

His collection of bottle openers is impressive. He has 2,000 on display in different rooms of his home and another 500 he uses to trade with other collectors.

The oldest bottle opener he owns that he can validate is a Crown Cork and Seal bottle opener from 1896. Hall picked it up at a convention in Baltimore.

Hall said he initially was only going to collect openers with beer company names on them. But Hall soon discovered a

world of different types of openers. According to Hall back in the early 1900s cans of paint came with a lid opener and at the other end was a bottle opener.

There's even a national organization dedicated solely to bottle opener collectors appropriately named "Just for Openers." they publish a catalog full of openers you can purchase.

Hall finds conventions for bottle opener collectors a great way to find new openers. His new bride Anna enjoys the conventions as well. Anna said on their first date "he asked me if I wanted to go back to his place to see his collection." And she did.

Hall has bottle openers from all over the world including Kenya, Switzerland and Greece. "I have a friend who goes overseas and always brings back a bottle opener from the country they've been too."

"With the invention of pull-tab cans, bottle openers aren't used as much these days," said Hall.

Hall's unusual collection is unmatched in Highlands County; at least he thinks. If you share Hall's interest in bottle opener collecting you may contact him at 385-2592.
