Please, please do not hesitate in getting your hotel reservation. You can use the 1-800 number but John Mlady recommends you call the hotel direct. If anyone has any problems please let me know. Start planning on bringing a display and sharing your collection with your fellow members. John has a mailing list of 600 breweriana collectors that he will be sending a post card advertising the show. If you have any kind of advertising and want to sale or trade, this will be the show to do so and especially if it is anything from Nebraska.

Right now the schedule is our usual Wednesday and Thursday check-in and room-to-room trading. Friday morning more of the same and then for Friday afternoon, a bus will be rented so anyone wanting to may go to John's house, see his collection, then go downtown for some antiquing, and finally to a local restaurant for a group supper (Bill Baburek, a local breweriana collector, owns the restaurant). Friday night we will have small auction and then Saturday will be the public show 8AM to 1PM.

For you new members, the convention is a "dynamite" (thanks Gary) place to get openers and corkscrews. This convention is in the heartland of America and we always have our largest attendance when the convention is in the Midwest.

Fellow Canadian collector, George Vine (JFO #1055), with over 1,300+ openers in his collection is working on a new book with Larry's help. Larry and George believe there may be up to 800 more unlisted Canadian beer openers and corkscrews that they do not have. —Estate Auction with Openers 10/23 Oquawka Illinois—

Verne and Laverne Vollrath attended this auction and Verne sent the following report. We left Friday morning and took in a number of antique shops along the way. Some openers but nothing worth picking up, not even any over-priced good ones. Spent the night in Mammoth about 15 miles from Oquawka.

Got out to the auction about 8:15AM. They really had a lot of stuff and I say stuff because about 75% was just miscellaneous junk. The lady's husband had been a Zenith radio and TV dealer and had a great collection of old radios, many selling in the \$500-\$1,000 range. I would guess that the radios alone added up to \$10,000. They also had a large collection of old movie posters which did well plus a collection of John Wayne items some of which sold well.

Now onto the openers. As you noted (from the auction ad pictures) there were mostly non-beverage openers. They had them individually bagged and numbered and had printed lists to go by. It was about 1:30PM before they got to the openers. Openers sold from \$1.00-\$37.50 with the whole group totaling about \$350. The A-15 Coca-Cola brought \$35 which I should have bought and didn't. I got the A-4-11 Popel-Giller for \$25 plus a few others, A-15 Cooks \$2.50, B-18 Underwood Water \$2.50, D Zoller \$7.00 and finally a box of Art Santen types for \$2.50.

It was about 220 miles home and we had a nice outing. Laverne sat in the car and read a book all during the auction. Oh yes the top dollar opener was a H-8 Pepsi in about 4 condition and it went for \$37.50.

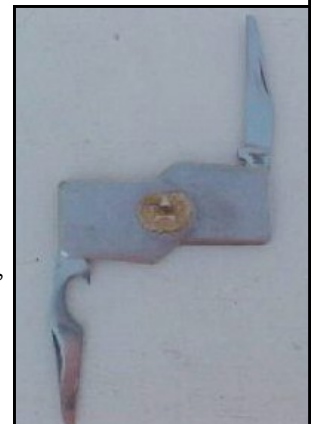

No responses on the B-14-90 Golden Glow, I-19-19 Hamms and I-20-11 Hamms if they do exist. We can assume they don't but I will leave them as listings in the Handbook. John Mlady responded that the “Pacific Ammonia” opener in the last issue with the large gas key was used to open valves on pressurized ammonia bottles.

Don Bull responded to the Crown, Throat & Opener ad in the last issue with, “I wonder if the 1915 invoice for “Handy Crown Throat Interchangeable” might be for a stamping die used in the production of openers?”. John Cartwright found a P-8 with the following inscription, “Equinox Water & Ginger Champagne Genesee Fruit Co., Selling Agents., New York. / Equinox Water & Ginger Champagne Equinox Spring Co., Manchester, Vermont.”. Is it related to the Genesee Brewing Co.?

Cold weather saw many (good?) openers and corkscrews for sale this past quarter on eBay. The listings have about 100 more items than the previous quarter. Many nice beer “A”s were sold with an A-59-1 Providence being bought at a good price at \$112.50. Mike Krejci unfortunately lost out on an A-15-UL Wm Rahr at \$103.59 as condition was fair to good but it was a UL. New members should note that one reason I always say the A-9-4 Leisy baseball player opener is the most common is proven this quarter by being sold four different times. The next two most common A-9s were sold twice each, A-9-12 Ringler and the A-9-17 Schells. I was very happy to get the A-17-UL Boise as it looked very bad in the picture but cleaned up great. Best “A” beer type was the A-22-1 Ballantine and it brought an average price at \$151.49 (I believe the horn honked on this one).

Like the “A”s, lots of good “B”s were sold including beer and soda. I really wanted the B-5-UL Wagener and even though the Mike sounded the horn, I prevailed at \$103.50. The B-14 Coca-Cola Bottling Works from Bloomington, In. set a record for a B-14 Coca-Cola realizing \$87.99. The same ad had sold for \$76 back in April and generally Coca-Cola B-14s go for \$10-\$40 with ones with towns being on the high end. Coca-Cola openers with “Bottling Works” instead of “Bottling Co.” also tend to do better in price. A very nice selection of “B-18”s, “B-19”s and “B-21”s were offered. Obviously “Reisch Beer” openers are very desirable as the B-18-217 brought \$76.00. Openers from this brewery always seems to bring good money. A non-beer B-45 from Salt Lake City had several corkscrew bidding and finally sold for \$121.50. It seems like all

examples of this style, beer and non-beer, have a Salt Lake City ad of some kind. I guess the salesman did not like traveling. Finally the B-42-14 Rubsam & Hormann was in nice condition and saw several bidders before finishing at \$86.00.

“C” and “D” types saw limited action and once again a C-17-37 Largay brought a large price at \$77.00. This is the fourth one I have seen sold on eBay with one other bringing \$43.00 and the top two at \$105.00 each. Lets just say it is a desirable Connecticut beer opener. Cast Iron “D”s saw some desirable English patent openers do well. Most sell for under \$10 but like American openers when the right brand is offered they see some spirited bidding. “CBO”s have slowed down price wise but then outside of the usual common styles not much has been offered lately on eBay that would warrant high bidding.

Prices on “E”s were up and down. Several good ones were bought cheaply and then others such as the E-6-212 Freeland which brought \$53.97, realized good prices. “E-5” sodas still do fairly well, not real high price wise, but they maintain a level in the \$20-50 range. Mr John Patton decided he really wanted the E-14-839 Men-Mar (Menominee-Marquette Brewing Co) and I made him pay well for it at \$47.99. The past couple of quarters had seen the E-14-74 Engesser do well but several sellers this quarter forced the price down going as low as \$9.50 (a fair market price really).

“F”s saw a couple of good F-6 Coca-Cola openers sold. Also two tough beer F-27s, a Travis Beer from Texas and a Rogue Lager from Oregon. A little surprising was the F-507 Coca-Cola spatula only bringing \$89.87 while a “F” type Coca-Cola with a scoop spoon (new type) brought \$150.00. Figural cast iron bottle openers (FBOC types) saw some medium range openers sell but nothing too exciting. Once again a “Skull” did not meet reserve at \$394.89.

A few good “G”s and “H”s were sold and I lost out on two that I wanted, a G-5-48 Evans & Sons at \$116.49 and a H-1-UL Engesser at \$79.99. To add insult to injury I lost the H-2-63 Foss-Schneider at \$29.00 by one penny. Competition on eBay is keen as ever. I did add the G-1-51 Lubeck and the G-1-65 Southern Pacific (sold as a railroad ad piece and could be but also has the bottle outline, anyone know for sure??). Excellent condition H-8s still sell well as most of the H-8s one sees are off grade.

One good “I-7” sold, number 84 Lion from New York City at \$45.44. The usual “K”s sold especially “K-2”s and “K-5”s. Surprisingly two “K-13”s sold bringing only \$31.00 and \$26.99. Real cheap for a fairly tough type to find. “L”s have seen much less action than in previous quarters except for the usual stampede of “L-2” Anheuser-Busch bottle corkscrews. The “L-1” Harp Lager is English but Bob Stahly had to have it for his “L-1” collection. The “L-5-2” Oshkosh is the first one of these I have seen sold and brought a respectable price of \$41.00.

“M” types saw a lot of sales with someone getting a good buy in the M-2-5 Bartholomay at \$64.01 (I believe it was Jim Osborn). It was very good but not great condition. “M-3” saw several of the more common ones sold but no real hard to find ones. The “M-6” Wagner bell is tough but not \$124.72 tough. The “M-6” Dr Miller bell was in great shape and \$81.00 was a good price. Mike Krejci sounded the horn just before he ran me over on the M-57-2 Wiedemann at \$79.99. I have one but this particular one had an end cap with the maker’s name. Finally we get to the “M-73”s and Art Johnson was the lucky bidder on the M-73-7 Kessler (not lucky with the price) at \$331.52. Lucky because that one was an upgrade but the seller had an M-73-9 Kessler Hotel Placer (Green) in great shape and sold it to Art also. This completed Art’s collection of beer “M-73”s. He has all 14 known beer advertising “M-73”s. Congratulations Art (and Eileen)!!! A final note on the “M”s as two people got good buys on the M-63-1 Hamms at \$25.00 and \$11.50. This one usually goes for \$50-75.

N-4-7 Ruppert was one I had to have and I paid \$177.50 (sorry Bill Arber, he was second high bidder). Ben Hoffman had listed this one and the condition of his was off. It was one of those “little old lady” stories as an old woman owned it and someone who worked at the brewery had given it to her. The buyer of the N-6-1 Lembeck & Betz was lucky as the condition of the knife was excellent and \$130.49 was a great price. The N-21-1 Anheuser-Busch Malt can opener saw a lot of bidders before selling for \$131.49. As always a lot of beer belt buckles sell and bring good prices for the most part. I was very surprised no one bid on the N-91-1 Schlitz shovel and I got it real cheap at \$6.50.

Wall Mounts or “O”s saw the one millionth Coca-Cola “O-5” sold. Just kidding it only seems like a million of these have been sold. At any one time 20-25 are offered

on eBay. Lots of “O”s did sell including beer and soda. Starr wall mounts are finally settling down in price. Better ones going in the \$75-\$150 range. One side note and I did not show the result. A collection of over 70 Starr openers was sold for \$3,000 back in October. This was the collection I wrote about back in the January 2003 JFO Newsletter. The collection contained the “Big Boy” and “Big Bill” oblong (O-505) openers and many good \$50-\$100 openers (maybe 10-15) but in today’s market \$3,000 was a lot of money.

Beer “P”s saw a lot of “wood” and knives. John Cartwright has quickly built an awesome collection of wood handle corkscrews. In fact his new nickname is “Woody”. For some reason many of the “P-19”, “P-54” and “P-85” beer advertising corkscrews do not see a lot of bidding and John has become a big happy camper on this category. Beer knives with corkscrews are always headed by the Anheuser-Busch knives. A blue handle A-B knife with broken blades brought \$1,124. I have noticed several A-B distributors and former workers who have entered this market. “R” types did see Mike Krejci get a nice R-10-1 Sunshine for \$127.50. A very hard style to find.

General corkscrews followed a familiar theme. If it is desirable get out your checkbook because it will not be cheap. Like beer openers many desirable corkscrews were sold this past quarter on eBay. Highest price was an English Shrapnel patent bringing \$18,097.78. Many nice European corkscrews were sold and the usual run of American patents were offered though nothing on the real high end. One surprise was a 1880s Haff patent Wood Handle-T with a bell mechanism that brought \$1,636.00

Ebay still offers the best selection of opener and corkscrews in the market place (unless you are lucky enough to buy a collection). I spend an hour to an hour and a half each day checking out listings. If nothing else it is very educational. Out of about 3,600 items in my collection 1,200 have come from eBay. The only other source I know that still competes with eBay is the Just For Openers Convention. As Ollie Hibbeler always says, “**Be There!**”. Don’t miss this year’s convention in Omaha. A good time will be had by all.

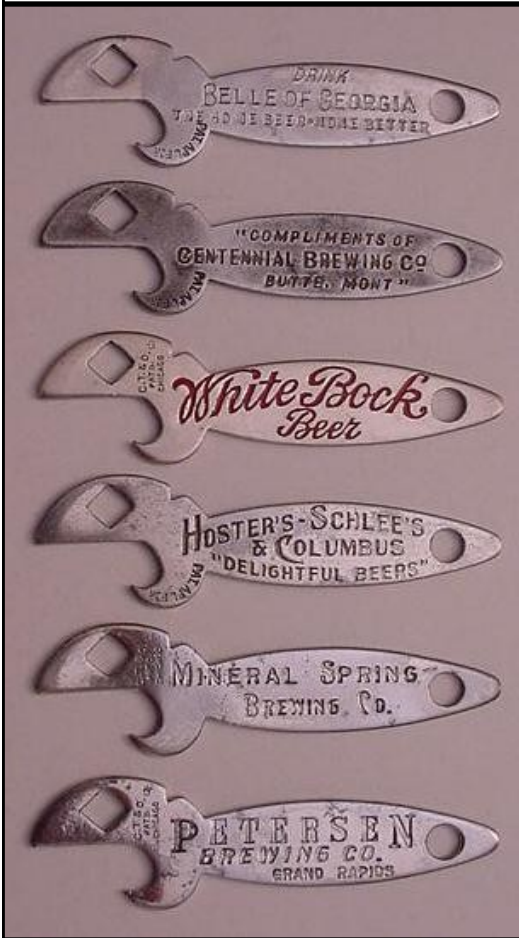

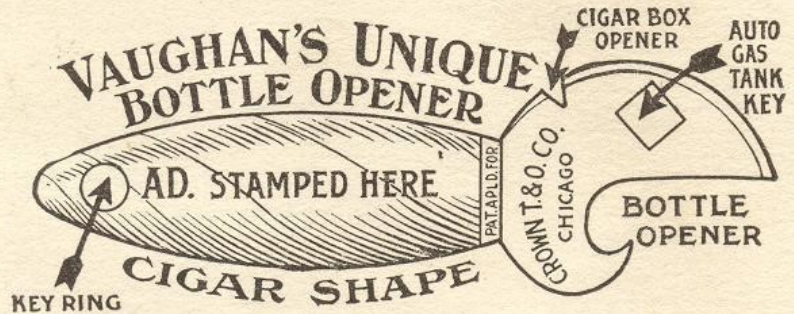

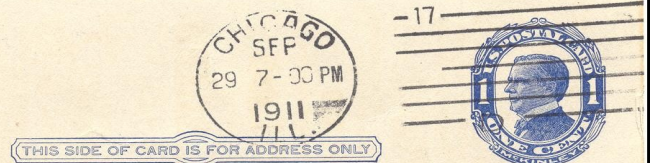
