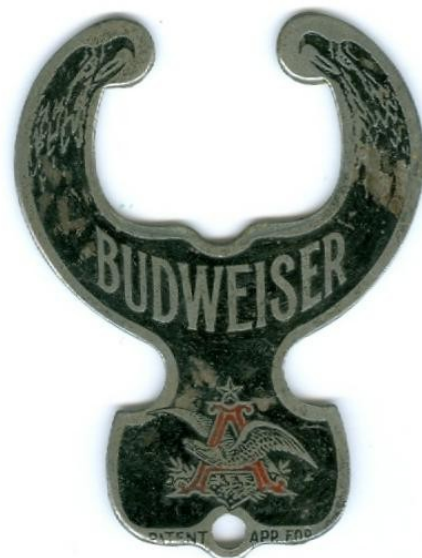

This C-1-7 was bought by me on eBay after some "spirited" bidding with Bob Stahly. I know of two others, one of those coming out of the Ray Braeuner Collection (now owned by Jack Ford) and the other example came out of a Mid-West Collection which was sold by a Florida Coin Dealer in the late 1980s. The dealer sent out a nice typed list with photos copies of the opener styles and priced most "A"s and "B"s \$10-\$30 but for some reason only charged \$10 for the C-1. Rumor had it, it ended up in a West Coast Collection. A very hard C-1 to find! In today's market worth \$150-\$200.

# Spouse's Corner

As April was fast approaching, I really didn't have any ideas for the Spouse's Corner other than the bathroom renovation finally started! And I could bore you with details about my first foot surgery on February 1<sup>st</sup>, which had a recovery period that would bump up against JFO and give me little time to prepare for John going to the Blue-Gray during Valentine's as usual.

Well, suddenly I had lots to tell in Spouse's Corner. John was having trouble with acid reflux, so his doctor scheduled a colonoscopy. I'm not doctor, not even a good nurse as you will see later in this article, but why weren't they doing an upper GI? After much convincing, John asked why and an endoscopy was added. And so they found an ulcer about six inches below his stomach. So he was placed on meds and another endoscopy was set for the middle of the Blue-Gray show. John was doing so poor, he came home for the test, then back to Virginia. John and some of the JFO guys pigged out the night before at a Golden Corral making the exam very difficult for his doctor, but the ulcer was still there and so a liquid diet was ordered and plans for another upper GI, Thursday April 3<sup>rd</sup>.

The weekend before, John who now had lost 40 lbs, had a horrible Friday night. I had been urging him to call the doctor all week, but he only talked to a nurse and did not really tell her how bad off he was. John had resigned himself to the idea we just needed to wait until they did the next upper GI. I saw no logic in that as it would only tell us what we already knew, the ulcer was not healed. So Saturday morning, I took off to get things for the renovation project and secretly called the doctor. She was out of town, but the doctor on call said that nothing was working and we needed to go to the emergency room.

I called John and told him if we waited for the next upper GI on Thursday, he could kiss JFO good bye. If we did something now, we had a chance for him to go to JFO. A few minutes later he called and said he was ready to go.

And so we went. Well, there's not much staff around on weekends, so they decided to just put a horrible scratchy tube down his nose to pump out his stomach and try to heal the ulcer via meds via IV. I'm sure he wasn't happy with me at that point. But I had told him it would be his decision to go, his decision if he wanted a shot at attending JFO or not.

John added this paragraph about a very down time Sunday morning. Two residents came to tell John that surgery was needed due to the scar tissue that was not allowing food to leave his stomach except via a trickle at a time. John told them he had a convention in St. Louis in two weeks, only to hear the dreaded words that they were adamant he would not be traveling, that his health and life were more important. This was like a death sentence to hear. Then one of the residents talked to the surgeon and came back and said if laparoscopy could be used, he might have a slim chance to go on the trip, but still did not advise it. Until the actual surgery, the possibility of laparoscopy would not be known, so no promises would be made.

Word quickly spread to JFO members and their prayers must have been answered as a surgeon who does gastric bypasses came on duty and told the younger doctors that meds were not the answer, surgery was. Poor John had to wait until Tuesday for that to happen as they had to talk to his GI doctor before proceeding. Big relief when I read the surgeon's bio on the internet that his preference was to minimize invasive surgery. The fact that he dealt with surgeries involving stomachs was a comfort too as 40% of John's stomach had to be removed due to the ulcer disease. The surgeon could not remove the ulcer as it was in a bad place, so he bypassed that area with a new connection between the stomach and small intestine. He did this all through 5 small incisions. John added these details: The surgeon cut on both sides of the ulcer, stapled the ends and left it in. He then reconnected the small intestine at the ulcer point, removed 40% of the stomach (lower part), stapled it back and then reconnected the small intestine to the stomach.

John took his first walk the morning after surgery and was nominated by the nurses for the award for the patient who walked more than any patient before. What they didn't know is that this patient wants to go to JFO more than anything in the world.

Those who come to JFO know that John doesn't drink much, but I'm sure he would be a happy drunk as he was a lot of fun on morphine. Wednesday he decided to stop the morphine on his own unknown to me. Dummy here called him before coming back to the hospital that night and suggested that he needed to rest and we should wait before I bring the laptop back. After he snapped at me, I said, "you're off the morphine aren't you?". So the laptop and I arrived to a not so happy camper. Nurse Pat could not make him comfortable no matter what. It wasn't the surgery area causing problems, it was that he had reached his limit with all the tubes, wires and vibrating socks (on his feet to reduce possibility of blood clots). I was sure any nursing students would give up that career after dealing with Mr. Stanley that night.

Thursday was a different scene thankfully. He was pretty much disconnected from all the torture devices and making jokes. Friday we brought him to home sweet home.

John is the morning person, I'm the night owl. I get up ok in the morning, but am not ready to go in fast forward like John, so it's very hard when he isn't here and I have to get the girls outside immediately before my eyes are even focused. And added to my challenge was rain, lots of rain, every day but one that he was in the hospital. I did well I think caring for them, going to the hospital twice a day except for one, coming home and answering calls and emails about John and working some all with my foot still swelling. I cannot tell you how grateful I was when John took them out Saturday morning. I needed that as Friday night after we got him home, the adrenaline that kept me going stopped.

The weekend we took him in was very stressful and I was waiting to hear if I passed a stress test I had that Thursday and Friday. I called my doctor Monday and said my heart must be fine as it certainly was tested worrying about John and so the test did agree with that, my heart is good. I was afraid I would need some procedure that couldn't wait until after JFO. Little did I know what would really be the obstacle to overcome to BE THERE!!

The ride home from the hospital was uncomfortable for our dear patient, so I drove like granny slowly going over the smallest bump. I said that it was a good thing we didn't have to drive to St. Louis that day. John said he would have laid down on the back seat and we would have gone!

Usually John is the one helping others unload cars, the one setting up and moving around tables in the showroom to accommodate everyone. For the next three weeks, 10 lbs is his lifting limit. That means he can pick up Snazzy, but not Jazzy!! So all JFO attendees have my permission to yell "NO" at him if he forgets his limitations because we do plan to be in St. Louis!!

Thanks to everyone for your support and prayers. I have been amazed at all the calls and emails asking about John. I know the concern was sincere even if JFO members might be interested in his collection worse case scenario and all the people at UNC might be concerned that they would never get paid again until someone learned the payroll system programming as well as John has in 24 years. His surgery was done on his 24<sup>th</sup> anniversary!!

But more impressive than that anniversary is the JFO 30<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Thirty years of close friendships made by those who love this hobby. Anxious to see you THERE!

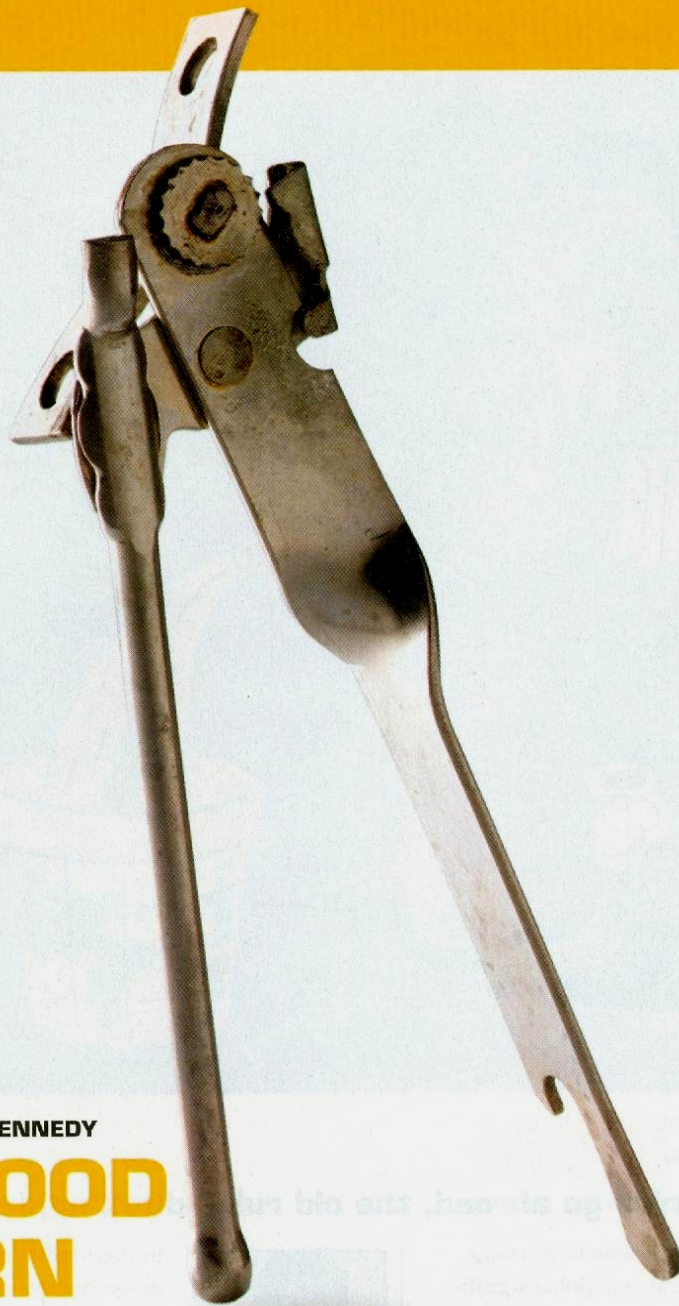

### Ode to the Ordinary

## A GOOD TURN

Canned foods arrived on the scene like a cruel joke. It was the early 1800s, in England, and the first cans contained fruits, vegetables, meat, and fish. But they were made of heavy wrought iron. Opening one usually required the combination of a sharp object and brute force, invariably increasing the ranks of the wounded in the process: a sliced-off fingertip here, a gashed thumb there. Some cans came with instructions to use a

hammer and chisel; as late as the Civil War, soldiers opened cans by shooting at them with rifles. In short, trying to open a can was akin to a slapstick routine.

Less than a century ago, canned foods were the purview of armies, navies, and Arctic-bound explorers. Then came the modern can opener, with its distinctive cutting wheel. Concocted by a U.S. inventor in the 1870s, perfected and mass-produced out of San Francisco in

#### → ORIGINS

The first device designed specifically to open cans debuted in 1858 and included both a pointed, bayonet-type blade that cut into the top of the can and a curved blade that clamped onto the side. It was so difficult and dangerous to use that only grocers had them, and they opened cans for customers on site.

#### → CHIEF PREDATOR

In 1959, Ermal Fraze, a tool manufacturer in Ohio, invented the pull-top can. This changed life for soda drinkers, but those cans were, and remain, expensive to produce — thus ensuring the can opener's indispensability.

#### → BABY BROTHER

An alternative to the kitchen can opener is the short, hooked blade long used by the U.S. Army, similar to the one found on a standard Swiss Army knife. It's known colloquially as the "John Wayne" for its reliability, and officially as model P-38, for reasons no one is sure of.

1925, the opener was the perfect implement for its singular mission. Working the wheel around a can's circumference with that oh-so-familiar wrist motion is such a simple task that not even the electric can opener (born in the 1930s) could displace it. Before long, the phrase "easy as opening a can" entered the lexicon. The opener made canned foods available to everyone, forever changing the way we eat.

## “Opener and eBay Trivia”

From the last issue as far I know, Don Bull did not receive an inquiry for the missing “Israeli” corkscrew he needed to complete his set (page 4). Don Bull and Herb Danziger both said that Norm Jay’s wooden handle corkscrew with an A&J worm were not originally made together but they are a “marriage”. The corkscrew should go with a wooden sleeve market fruit crusher. The Yosemite wooden sleeve is much older than the A&J top. I got one response to how many people have the B-24-75 Becker and which version do they have? John Patton said his B-24 has an “&”. I know several members have this opener so please let me know what yours has on it.

Lots of results again this quarter but the slower summer season is coming. It will be interesting to see if eBay can keep pace. Lets start with the results with one of my favorite openers, an “A” Harley-Davidson Motorcycle spinner selling for \$270.00. As Mike, “the trucker”, pointed out a little less than my value of \$800-\$1000 at last year’s Harrisburg JFO Convention. This one did have a hole drilled in the neck. The usual assortment of soda “A”s saw lots of action this past quarter but I am sure most bidders saw a lot of nice Nebraska “A”s being sold on eBay by former JFO member Tim Payne. The high lot was one that did not meet reserve, an A-47-1 Krug on its original card saw bidding stop at \$274.00. Tim’s highest successfully selling “A” was an A-17-3 Fremont for \$150.00.

Tim’s openers were also the highlights of the “B”s with a B-7-16 Jettors (w/ a broke hook) bringing \$180.10 and a B-5-41 West Point bringing \$125.00. He had lots of other “B”s but not many met the opening price. It was an interesting way to sell on eBay as he started his auction at his top price. One interesting soda “B” was the B-19 My-Coca from Birmingham, Al. selling for \$103.50. The opener states on one side, “made from the original Coca-Cola formula”. “C”s were not too exciting save for Tim selling a C-14-19 Storz on its original card for \$150.00. The card must be worth \$149.00. The opener is not that tough to find. Also a C-13 Pepsi=Cola 5C brought \$140.27, a normally \$20-\$25 opener.

Several nice CBOs sold this quarter and the highlight was a CBO-RND-06 from Montreal selling for \$145.00. It was unusual in that it really is a new style as unlike other RND-06s this one had a hanger hole. Beer “D”s were pretty weak this quarter but the “E”s saw a rare E-4-268 Milan Springs being sold on eBay. The problem was the final price of \$49.88 was well short of the seller’s reserve of \$200.00. That high price would have set an “E” record.

“F” saw nice soda examples sold highlighted by a F-2 Dr Pepper Bottling Co. bringing \$104.01.

Cast iron figurals saw one outstanding example sold, a MIB “Skull” realizing \$685.00. This was an interesting sell as the seller originally listed it with a buy-it-now price of \$39.99 and of course it sold. The seller was selling for a man he knew and when the man was gone he needed a price and the man’s mother came up with \$39.99. When the man found out what it sold for he got real mad so the seller contacted the buyer and the buyer agreed to send it back. How lucky can one get? The buyer interestingly enough was airborne306, the same person selling all of the fake N-5 knives with different brewery names. So go figure.

“G”s and “H”s were fairly plentiful and two highlights stand out. A H-8-10 Narragansett brought \$201.02. “Mind boggling” is all I can say as it was in average condition and normally brings \$10-\$20. A hard to find H-13-1 Fremont brought \$150.00 and again was part of the Tim Payne Collection. Bar Mounts or “K”s saw several fine examples sell and once again they were led by a nice K-12-1 Lone Star selling for \$510.00. Why a K-14-1 Drewrys brought \$280.25 is anybody’s guess as it usually sells in the \$50-\$75 range. Note a K-12-1 Lone Star sold for \$100 but had a different label than what is normally seen on the K-12.

“L”s ran in bunches this quarter as it has become obvious that “L-1”s are very popular to collect. The never ending supply of L-2 Anheuser-Busch bottle corkscrews is still endless. The one notable sale in the “L-2”s was a L-2-7 Schoenhofen bringing \$240.32 and looked to be in real nice condition. “M”s and “N”s saw lots of action and the “M”s were led by an M-3-23 Fuhrmann & Schmidt selling for \$169.16 and was in nice condition and also a M-73 Hotel Gowman Seattle selling for \$201.00. Slider popularity never seems to slow down but the M-73 Hotel Gowman normally brings in the \$100 range.

“N”s jumped the price range for some examples though the fantasy N-5 “Boot” knives have seen prices settle down. A N-9 “Sled” Dr. Pepper Fort Worth brought a new record for any N-9 at \$353.57. A good Dr. Pepper opener can go through the roof at anytime. This was followed by a N-11 Coca-Cola Waterloo, Iowa shoehorn bringing \$305.00. They have sold for that much before so not that unusual. The Coca-Cola 50th Anniversary “Bottle Cap” openers, N-506, highlighted the fact that the example with the 1900

1950 dates is much more desirable and one brought \$510.00. A lot of money for a 1950s opener.

The wall mount opener market saw lots of action this quarter and several examples are worth noting. An “O-2” painted wall mount advertising Pepsi-Cola 5C in nice condition brought \$177.51. This was followed by a tough to find O-5-28 Miller (original make with large letters) bringing \$125.99. (How an O-5 Miller ranks in toughness and desirability: 1) O-5-39 Schlitz, 2) O-5-29 Pabst, 3) O-5-20 Grand Prize Texas Largest Seller & 4) O-5-28 Miller). A nice O-502 Coca-Cola (Star Side Mount) brought \$360.00 while a nice O-505 Lime Cola brought \$320.01 (yes I finally added this one to my collection). A surprising good buy for someone was an O-502 Delaware Punch (Star Side Mount) bringing only \$79.99. That’s why you have to keep an eye on eBay, you never know when those good buys will come along.

Beer corkscrews (“P”s) saw a bunch of nice pieces sell this past quarter. One of the nicest buys was a MIB P-34-2 Schlitz Pearl Handle knife bringing \$500.00 on a BIN (Buy-It-Now). A P-28-2 Pfeiffer Waiter’s Friend brought \$171.28 and a P-51-UL Florida Brewing Tampa brought \$152.50. Good wood brings good prices. A R-6-1 Sprenger Brass Wall Mount brought \$127.50 while its companion painted version, a R-6-2, did not meet reserve at \$270.00. I also got a chance to get another Pan-Pac 1915 multi-tool and almost paid my top bid when buying it at \$262.00.

Corkscrew collectors had to have a field day this quarter as lots of fine worldwide corkscrew were sold. Top lots were an English 19thC Royal Club that did not meet reserve at \$3,824.54 and a German 19thC Single Lever with a Cage bringing \$3,950.00. The assortment includes many patented pieces as they are usually the most desirable for corkscrew collectors. eBay has become like other areas of collectible “the source” for buying and selling corkscrews.

On a side note, eBay made several changes this past quarter and the most annoying is masking bidder ids except for the winning bidder. In the past this was always a good way to find non-mainstream listings and even though eBay claims it helps the buyer it really hurts the buyer and seller. Any avenue that leads me to find an opener that I want to bid on should not be taken away, but eBay did for now anyway. Until the next issue, happy hunting, I hope to see many of you in St. Louis, and remember, “tha good stuff is on eBay”!
